



Unemployment by Constituency, May 2009

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This paper shows the number of people claiming Jobseeker's Allowance recorded as resident in each constituency in the United Kingdom in May 2009, together with comparisons with the levels in May 2008 and May 1997. This paper also presents residence-based unemployment rates for all 646 constituencies in the United Kingdom.

The paper includes unemployment rates by constituency maps and an annual percentage change map.

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Summary of main points

This Research Paper summarises data for UK parliamentary constituencies from the monthly count of Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) claimants. It includes rates showing the number of JSA claimants as a proportion of the estimated economically active population of working age in each constituency in 2001 (Please see Research Paper 05/08, *Unemployment by constituency: Revised rates*, for details). It also includes changes in the number of JSA claimants compared with one year earlier and with 1997.

Data for the current constituencies are not available before January 1996.

The political parties shown against each seat are as they stand currently.

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I Introduction

This Research Paper provides the latest data on the monthly count of Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) claimants in each parliamentary constituency in the United Kingdom. It includes rates showing the number of claimants as a proportion of the estimated economically active population of working age resident in each constituency in 2001.¹ For the purposes of this paper, unemployment means the number of JSA claimants resident in each constituency.

The Office for National Statistics also publishes unemployment data for parliamentary constituencies. These data may be found on the NOMIS website.² For an explanation of the different measures of unemployment, and for an exposition of the methodology used to calculate the unemployment rates displayed in this paper please see Library Research Paper 05/08.³

This paper displays the latest levels and rates for the resident male, female and total population of each constituency. Section II provides an overview of the latest Labour Market Statistics release. Section III A displays these data alphabetically by constituency. The 25 constituencies with the highest and lowest rates respectively are shown in section III B. Ranked listings of constituencies by country are then provided in section IV. In section V, the latest total claimant levels are compared with levels in the corresponding month of the previous year and of 1997. Data for current constituencies exists back to January 1996⁴, and are available upon request from the Economic Policy & Statistics Section [extension 2883]. This paper also provides maps that show the latest residence-based claimant count rates for each constituency in the United Kingdom, and the annual percentage change in the claimant count for each UK constituency, expressed as quintile groups.

The rates presented in this paper should be regarded more as a social measure of relative deprivation than as an economic measure of the mismatch between the supply of and demand for labour, as they take no account of people's ability to seek work outside the constituency in which they live.

Notes to tables:

1. A comparison of current levels with those in 1997 is not available for the new Westminster Parliamentary Constituencies in Scotland, which have stood since the May 2005 General Election. Figures are only available for these constituencies since February 2004. Unavailable figures are denoted in Table V by a '..'.
2. The Boundary Commission reviews in 1995 defined 659 constituencies in the United Kingdom. These were defined in terms of electoral wards as they stood at the time of the review. For the purposes of the unemployment statistics however, constituencies represent a best-fit of frozen 1991 wards to the new constituencies.

Boundary alterations between 1991 and 1995 mean that there are inevitably approximations to 1995 boundaries in many constituencies. In some cases, however, the changes to ward boundaries were substantial and some wards are now split between constituencies. These constituencies are indicated with an '(a)' in the following tables.

Four wards with populations below the 1991 Census confidentiality threshold have had their data 'exported' to a ward which is in another constituency. In these cases, the data for the 'exported' ward are included in the constituency to which the ward has been transferred. Constituencies losing data in this way are indicated by '(b)', whereas those gaining data as a result are indicated by '(c)'.⁵

II Monthly Labour Market Statistics

Statistics on JSA claimants are one part of a large selection of labour market data released on a monthly basis.⁶ This page highlights some of the key figures in the latest labour market release, as well as data of relevance to constituencies. This page was introduced in April 2009; please contact the authors with any comments.

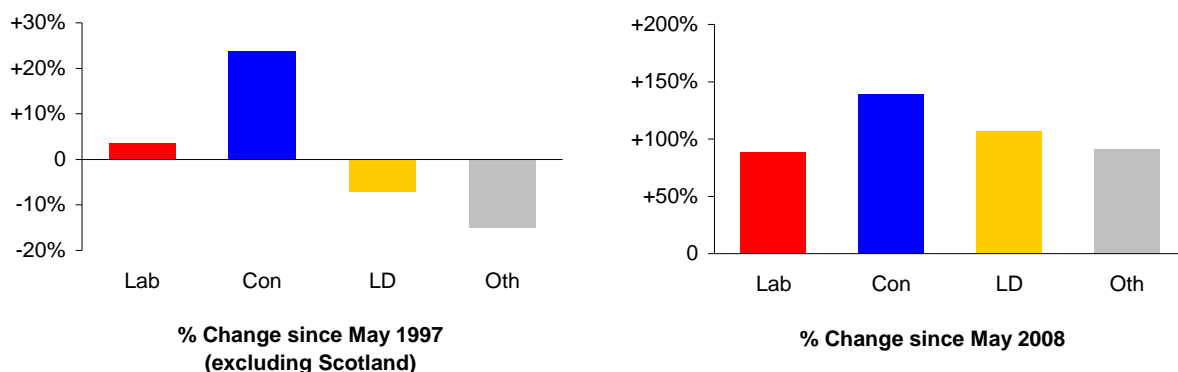
Claimant count unemployment rose by 39,300 in May 2009 to 1.54 million.⁷ The wider ILO based measure of unemployment was 2.26 million in the period February-April 2009, a rise of 605,000 compared to the same period a year ago and 211,000 higher than in April-June 1997. On a regional basis the highest rates of unemployment (ILO measure) are in the West Midlands (9.3%), North East (8.3%) and North West (8.2%) (February-April 2009).

The number of people in employment has fallen by 271,000 over the last quarter to 29.11 million (February-April 2009); full-time employment fell by 224,000 while part-time employment fell by 46,000. However, compared to same quarter one year ago part-time employment is almost unchanged. In February-April 2009 20.8% of the working age population were economically inactive (7.89 million), a rise of 0.2 percentage points on the previous quarter but unchanged from the same quarter one year ago.

It is estimated that there were 444,000 vacancies in the three months to May 2009, 38,000 lower than the previous quarter and 230,000 lower than in the same period a year ago. Average earnings including bonuses rose by 0.8% in the latest quarter to April 2009 compared to the same period one year ago; average earnings excluding bonuses rose by 2.7% over the same period.

The level of claimant count unemployment was higher in every constituency in May 2009 compared with May 2008. The April 2009 paper highlighted that, when parliamentary constituencies are considered on a party basis, seats held by Labour have seen the highest average rise in total JSA claimants over the last year; this is still true. However, as shown in the chart below, when the average percentage change in claimant count in constituencies is considered by incumbent party (also see table V), Conservative constituencies have seen the largest average increase over the year to May 2009, followed by constituencies held by the Liberal Democrats, Other parties and Labour. Compared to May 1997 (excluding Scotland), Conservative-held constituencies have seen on average a 24% rise in claimants, compared to a 3% rise for Labour constituencies, a 7% fall for Liberal Democrat constituencies and a 15% fall on average for constituencies held by other parties. This analysis does not take account of constituency sizes.

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Percentage change in claimant count levels, May 2008 to May 2009

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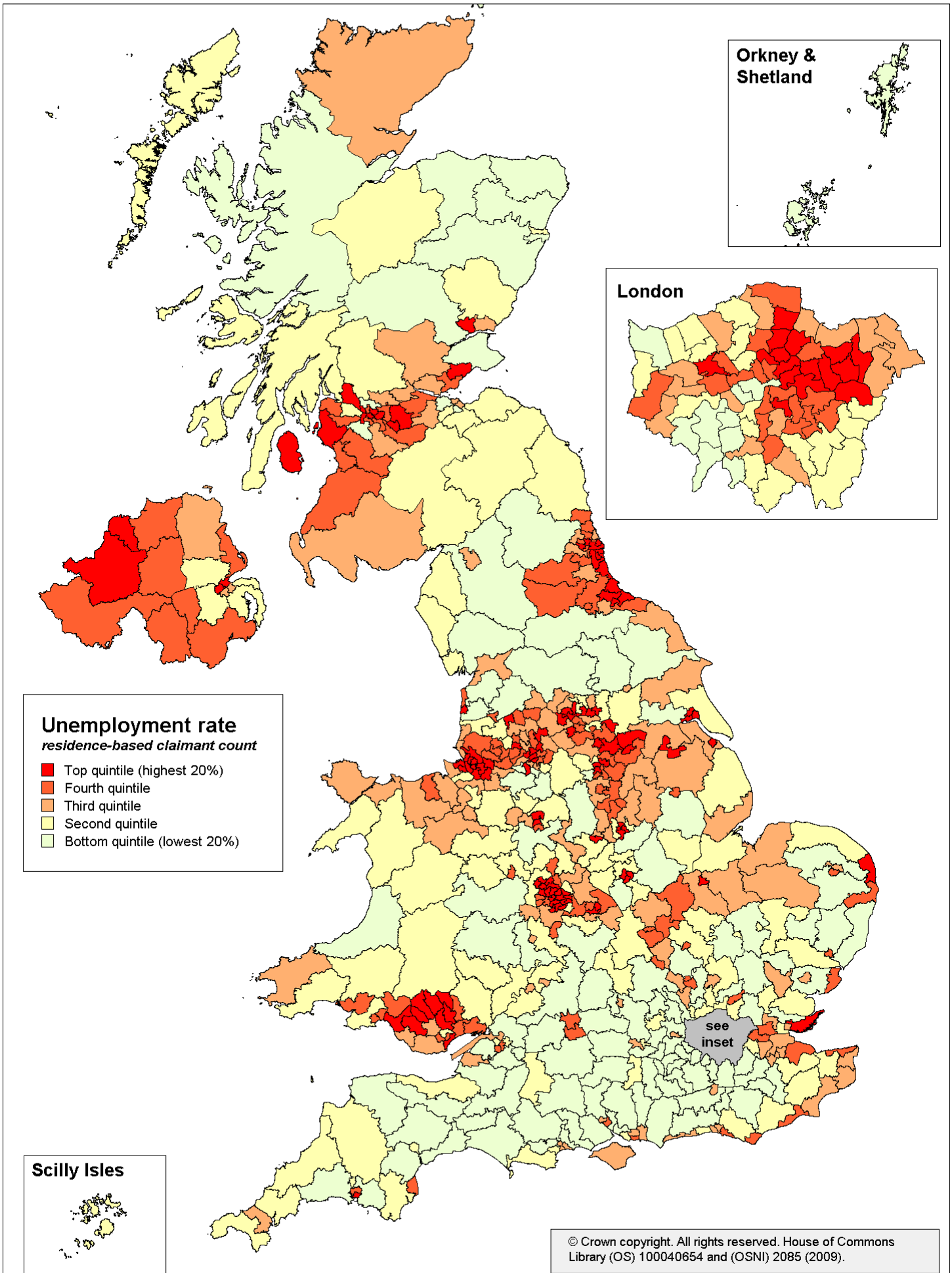
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Unemployment by Constituency, May 2009

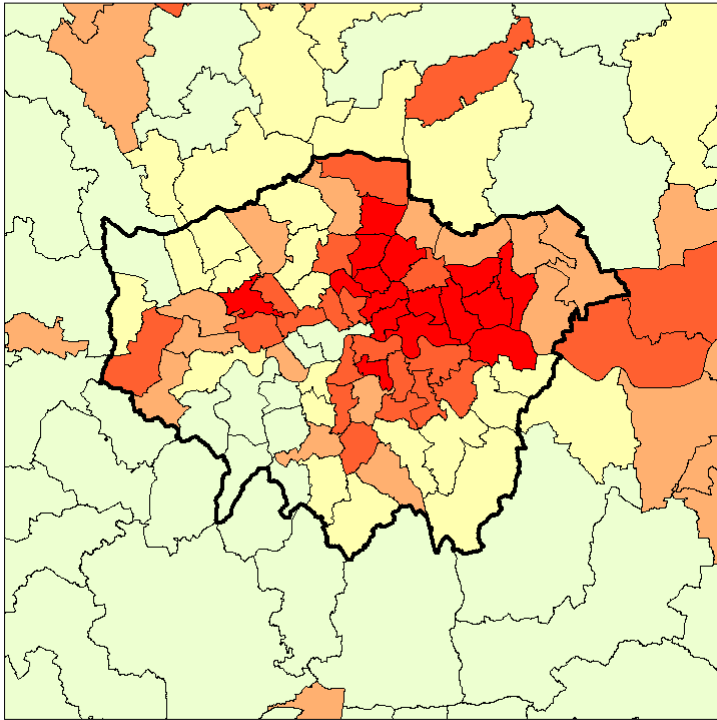

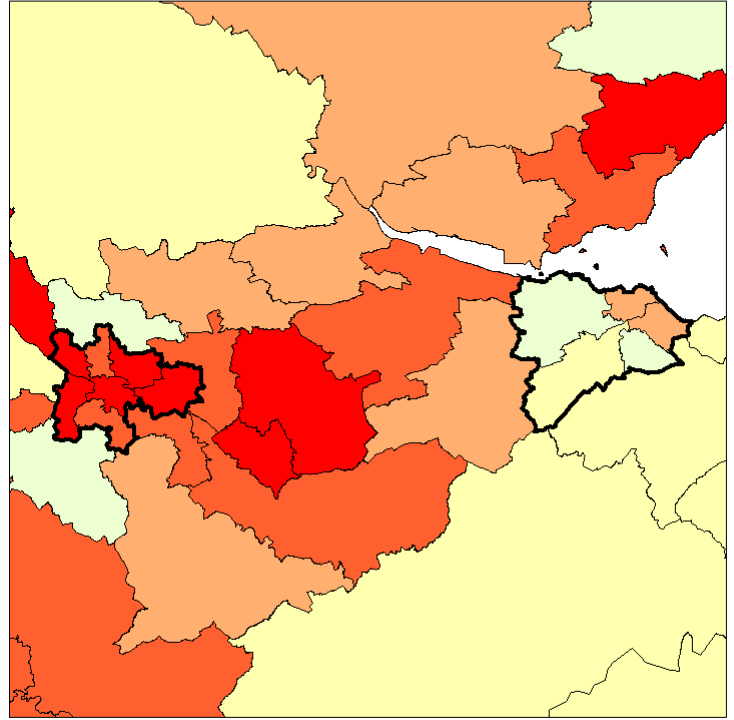

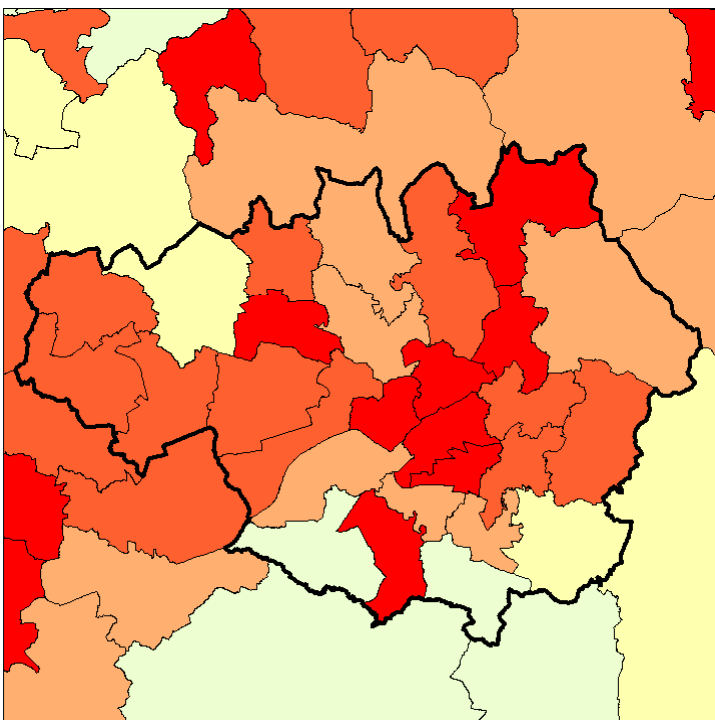

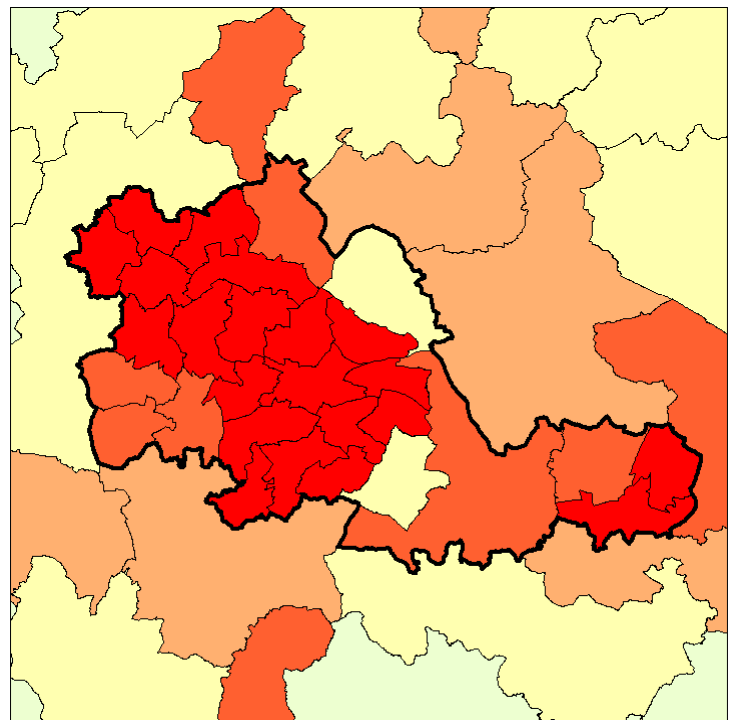

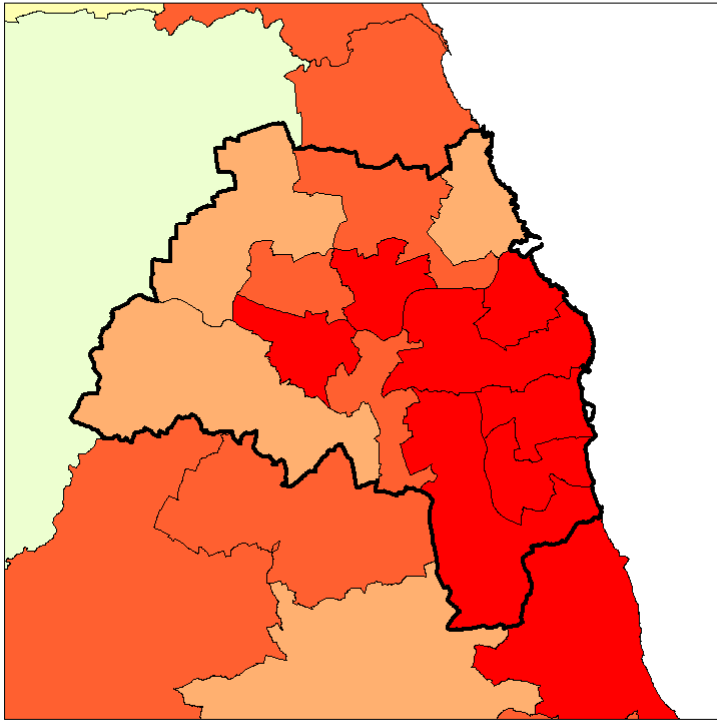


Unemployment by Constituency, May 2009

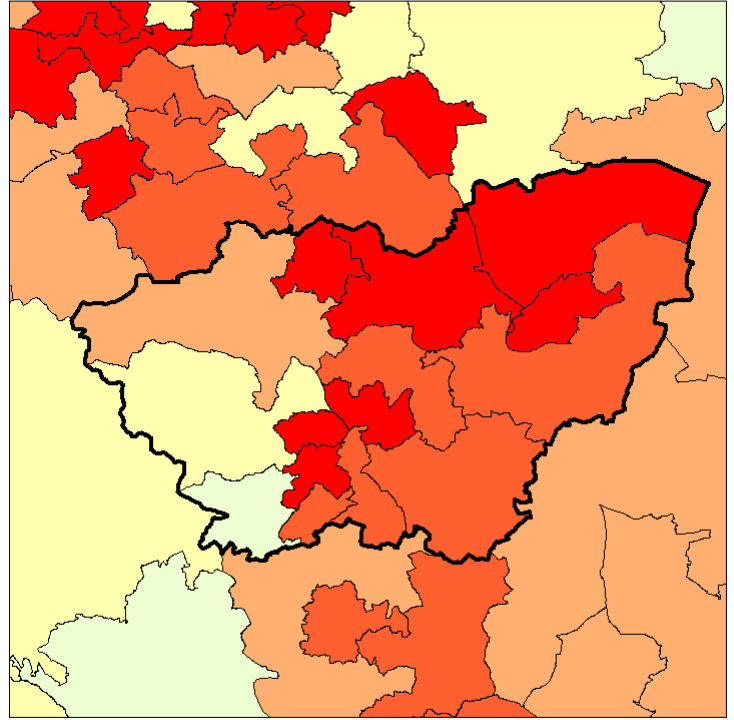

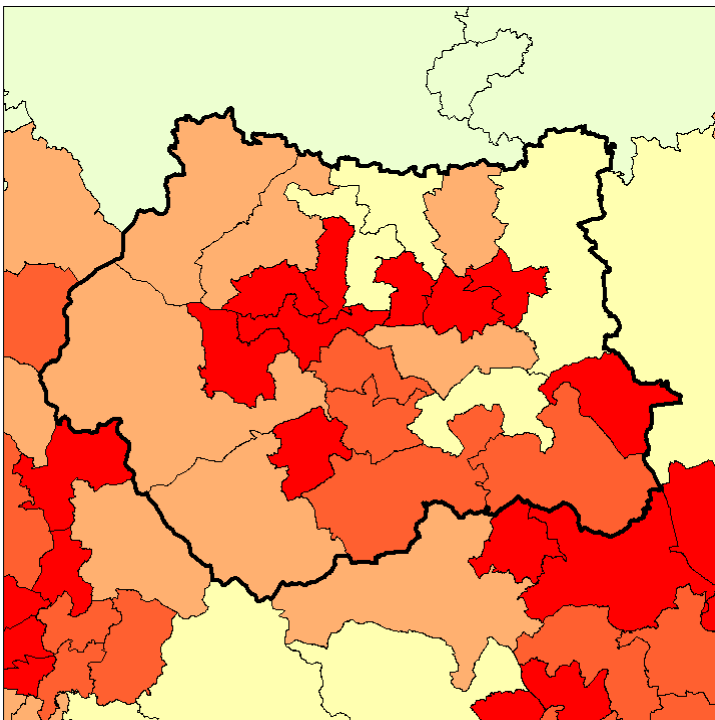

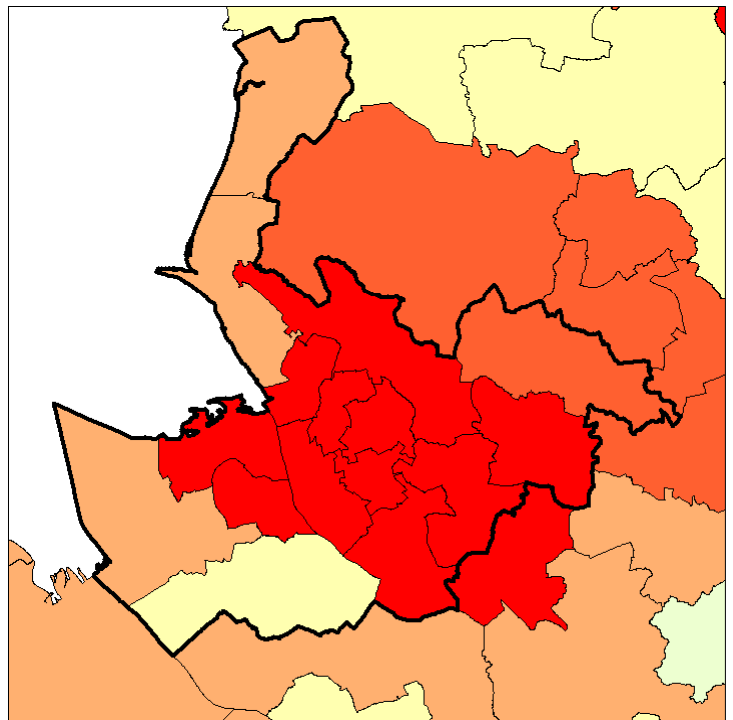

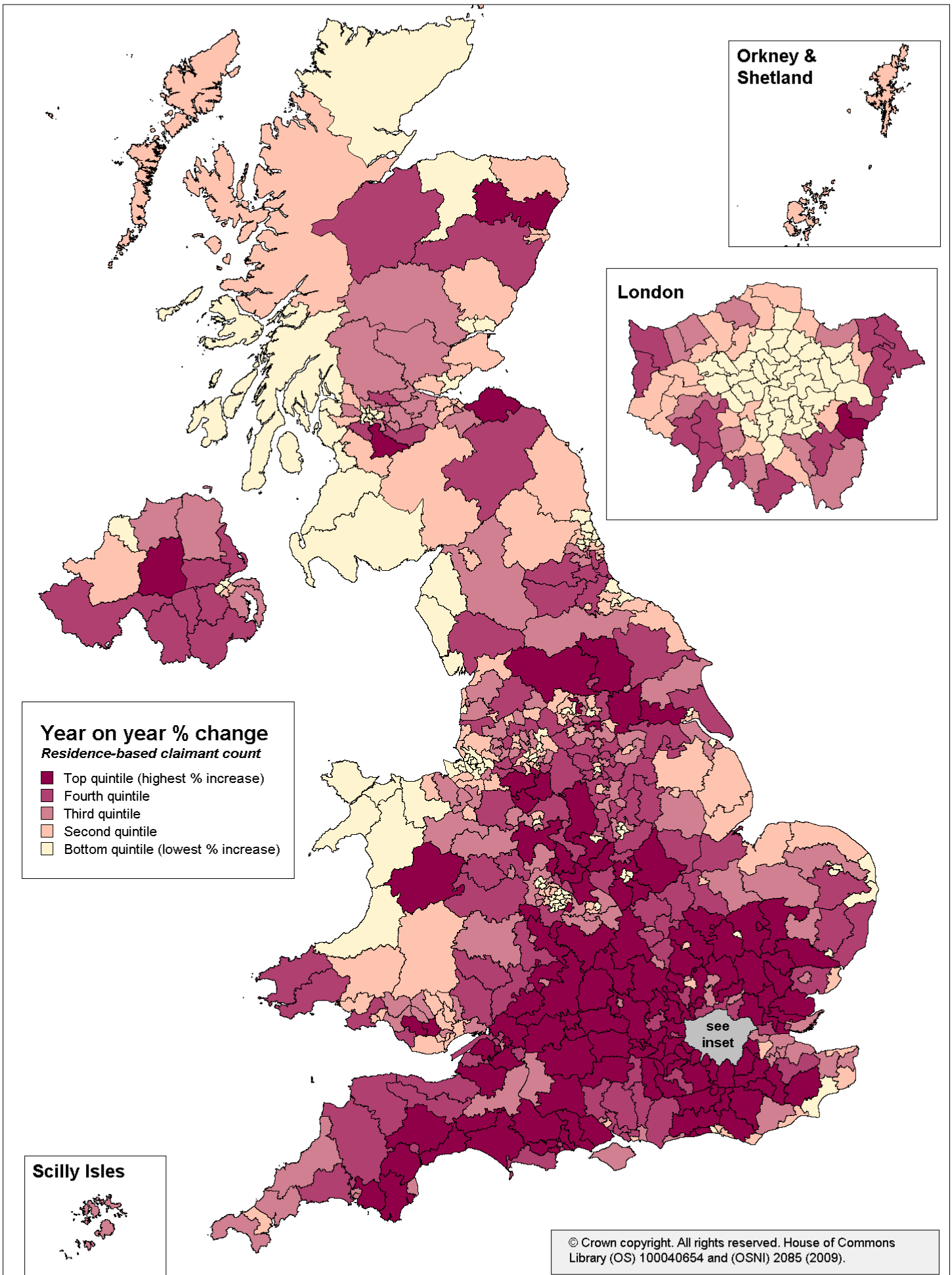

Explanatory notes

The following notes should be borne in mind when drawing conclusions from these maps:

Claimant count rate by constituency, May 2009 (pages 52-54)

- The maps on pages 52-54 show residence-based claimant count rates for May 2009 for constituencies in the United Kingdom, with an expanded view of constituencies in selected major conurbations and surrounding areas.
- The 646 constituencies in the United Kingdom have been divided into five equally sized bands, also known as 'quintile groups', each of which contain approximately 129 constituencies (20% of the total in the United Kingdom).
- These groups have been colour-coded, from red – the 20% of constituencies with the highest unemployment rates – through to yellow/light green – the 20% with the lowest unemployment rates.
- It is important to note that the range of unemployment rates covered by each band is different. For example, in May 2009 the top quintile (coloured red) is made up of constituencies with unemployment rates ranging from 7.7% to 22.9%, while the bottom quintile (coloured yellow/light green) is made up of constituencies with unemployment rates ranging from 1.3% to 3.6% (all rounded).
- Note also that constituencies with rates near the boundaries of these quintiles will be coloured differently even though their unemployment rates may only differ slightly from those in another, neighbouring quintile group.

Percentage change in claimant count levels, May 2008 to May 2009 (page 55)

- The map on page 55 shows the percentage change in residence-based claimant count levels between May 2008 and May 2009 for constituencies in the United Kingdom.
- The 646 constituencies in the United Kingdom have been divided into five equally sized bands, also known as 'quintile groups', each of which contain approximately 129 constituencies (20% of the total in the United Kingdom).
- These groups have been colour-coded, from reddish violet – the 20% of constituencies with the highest percentage increase in unemployment levels – through to pale yellow – the 20% with the lowest increase in unemployment levels.
- It is important to note that the range of percentage changes covered by each band is different. For example, in May 2009 the top quintile (coloured reddish violet) is made up of constituencies with changes in claimant count levels ranging from +138.8% to +289.7%, while the bottom quintile (coloured pale yellow) is made up of constituencies with changes in claimant count levels ranging from +24.1% to +68.0% (all rounded).
- Note also that constituencies with rates near the boundaries of these quintiles will be coloured differently even though their percentage changes in claimant count levels may only differ slightly from those in another, neighbouring quintile group.
- This map is based on the percentage change in the absolute level of claimants by constituency. Constituencies with relatively low absolute numbers of claimants may appear in this map in the higher quintiles and vice versa; for example, the constituency with the highest percentage rise in claimants (289.7%, 281 claimants to 1,095 claimants), is also one of the constituencies with the lowest unemployment rates (2.5% in May 2009); the constituency with the highest unemployment rate (22.9%) has the lowest percentage change (24.1%, 6,779 claimants to 8,415 claimants).

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
