



Unemployment by Constituency, July 2009

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This paper shows the number of people claiming Jobseeker's Allowance recorded as resident in each constituency in the United Kingdom in July 2009, together with comparisons with the levels in July 2008 and July 1997. This paper also presents residence-based unemployment rates for all 646 constituencies in the United Kingdom.

The paper includes unemployment rates by constituency maps and an annual percentage change map.

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Summary of main points

This Research Paper summarises data for UK parliamentary constituencies from the monthly count of Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) claimants. It includes rates showing the number of JSA claimants as a proportion of the estimated economically active population of working age in each constituency in 2001 (Please see Research Paper 05/08, *Unemployment by constituency: Revised rates*, for details). It also includes changes in the number of JSA claimants compared with one year earlier and with 1997.

Data for the current constituencies are not available before January 1996.

The political parties shown against each seat are as they stand currently.

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I Introduction

This Research Paper provides the latest data on the monthly count of Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) claimants in each parliamentary constituency in the United Kingdom. It includes rates showing the number of claimants as a proportion of the estimated economically active population of working age resident in each constituency in 2001.¹ For the purposes of this paper, unemployment means the number of JSA claimants resident in each constituency.

The Office for National Statistics also publishes unemployment data for parliamentary constituencies. These data may be found on the NOMIS website.² For an explanation of the different measures of unemployment, and for an exposition of the methodology used to calculate the unemployment rates displayed in this paper please see Library Research Paper 05/08.³

This paper displays the latest levels and rates for the resident male, female and total population of each constituency. Section II provides an overview of the latest Labour Market Statistics release. Section III A displays these data alphabetically by constituency. The 25 constituencies with the highest and lowest rates respectively are shown in section III B. Ranked listings of constituencies by country are then provided in section IV. In section V, the latest total claimant levels are compared with levels in the corresponding month of the previous year and of 1997. Data for current constituencies exist back to January 1996⁴, and are available upon request from the Economic Policy & Statistics Section [extension 2883]. This paper also provides maps that show the latest residence-based claimant count rates for each constituency in the United Kingdom, and the annual percentage change in the claimant count for each UK constituency, expressed as quintile groups.

The rates presented in this paper should be regarded more as a social measure of relative deprivation than as an economic measure of the mismatch between the supply of and demand for labour, as they take no account of people's ability to seek work outside the constituency in which they live.

Notes to tables:

1. A comparison of current levels with those in 1997 is not available for the new Westminster Parliamentary Constituencies in Scotland, which have stood since the May 2005 General Election. Figures are only available for these constituencies since February 2004. Unavailable figures are denoted in Tables IV and V by a '..'.
2. The Boundary Commission reviews in 1995 defined 659 constituencies in the United Kingdom. These were defined in terms of electoral wards as they stood at the time of the review. For the purposes of the unemployment statistics however, constituencies represent a best-fit of frozen 1991 wards to the new constituencies.

Boundary alterations between 1991 and 1995 mean that there are inevitably approximations to 1995 boundaries in many constituencies. In some cases, however, the changes to ward boundaries were substantial and some wards are now split between constituencies. These constituencies are indicated with an '(a)' in the following tables.

Four wards with populations below the 1991 Census confidentiality threshold have had their data 'exported' to a ward which is in another constituency. In these cases, the data for the 'exported' ward are included in the constituency to which the ward has been transferred. Constituencies losing data in this way are indicated by '(b)', whereas those gaining data as a result are indicated by '(c)'.⁵

II Monthly Labour Market Statistics

Statistics on JSA claimants are one part of a large selection of labour market data released on a monthly basis.⁶ This page highlights some of the key figures in the latest labour market release, as well as data of relevance to constituencies.

- Claimant count unemployment rose by 24,900 in July 2009 to 1.58 million.⁷ This was the highest level since May 1997.
- The wider ILO based measure of unemployment was 2.44 million in the period April-June 2009, a rise of 750,000 compared to the same period a year ago and 385,000 higher than in the same period in 1997. It is the highest unemployment level since 1995.
- Unemployment in the 25-34 and 50-59/64 age groups have seen the highest rises in percentage terms over the last year, increasing by 63% from 327,000 to 533,000 and by 56% from 216,000 to 336,000 respectively (April-June 2009).
- On a regional basis the highest rates of unemployment (ILO measure) are in the West Midlands (10.6%), North East (9.8%) and London (8.9%) (April-June 2009). Over the last year the ILO unemployment rate has increased across the UK by 2.4 percentage points. The greatest rises have been in the West Midlands (4.2 percentage points), Yorkshire and the Humber (2.8 percentage points) and Scotland (2.7 percentage points).
- The number of people in employment has fallen by 271,000 over the last quarter to 28.93 million (April-June 2009); full-time employment fell by 309,000 while part-time employment rose by 38,000. Compared to same quarter one year ago overall employment fell by 573,000, full-time employment fell by 653,000 over the year while part-time employment rose by 80,000.
- In April-June 2009 21.0% of the working age population were economically inactive (7.96 million), up 127,000 on the previous quarter and up 83,000 compared to the same quarter a year ago.
- It is estimated that there were 427,000 vacancies in the three months to July 2009, 26,000 lower than the previous quarter and 203,000 lower than in the same period a year ago.
- Average earnings including bonuses rose by 2.5% in the latest quarter to June 2009 compared to the same period one year ago; average earnings excluding bonuses also rose by 2.5%.
- Employment of those born in the UK fell by 625,000 to 25.10 million in the year to April-June 2009; employment of those born outside the UK rose by 22,000 to 3.73 million over the same period.
- The claimant count was higher in every constituency in July 2009 compared with July 2008. Between June and July 2009 193 constituencies have seen a fall in the claimant count, 448 have seen a rise. Compared to July 1997 the claimant count is higher in 350 constituencies but lower in 237 constituencies. 1997 data is not available for Scottish constituencies.

The Office for National Statistics published new experimental statistics estimating ILO unemployment by constituency at the end of July 2009. These model-based estimates aim to improve the reliability of the (currently published) Annual Population Survey (APS) based estimates by making use of JSA claimant count data. Data for each constituency from April 2005 up to the end of 2008 as well as detailed information on the estimates are available from the ONS website⁸ or by contacting the Library.

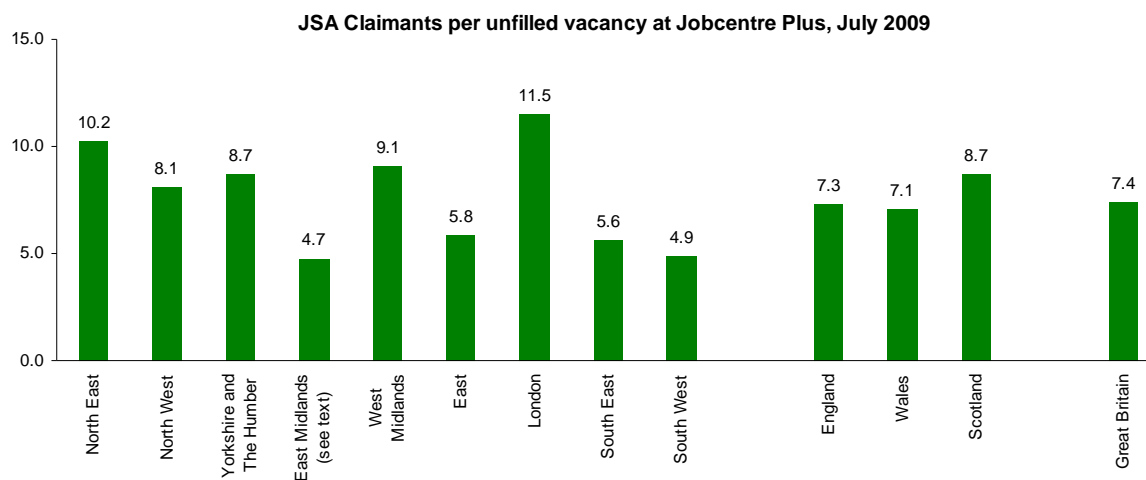

JSA claimants and Jobcentre Plus Vacancies

As unemployment rises, the mismatch between employment opportunities and unemployment at a local and regional level is of greater interest. The chart below shows the ratio of JSA claimants to unfilled vacancies notified to Jobcentre Plus by region. Not all vacancies are notified to Jobcentre Plus and many are advertised through different channels; some vacancies are not advertised. This measure of vacancies is also different (and lower) than the UK estimate mentioned in the bullet points above.

The highest rate of claimants to jobseekers is in London (11.5 jobseekers per vacancy, a rise of 6.7 from July 2008). The North East, North West, Yorkshire and the Humber, West Midlands, London and Scotland have more claimants per vacancy than the Great Britain average of 7.4. Data for the East Midlands is affected by UK armed forces vacancies being counted in Lincoln despite the jobs being available nationally.

Data by constituency for claimants and vacancies is available from the NOMIS website or by contacting the Library.⁹ However it should be noted that constituencies are not isolated labour markets and as such the ratio of claimants per vacancy does not reflect the 'real' availability of vacancies to jobseekers across a wider geographical area as well as those not notified to Jobcentre Plus.



Other developments

It was reported by the *Financial Times* on 11 August that the Government was launching an inquiry into the discrepancy between the ILO measure of unemployment, which has showed significant rises in unemployment in the spring/summer, and the JSA measure, which while rising over the same period, has been doing so at a lower rate. There are a number of possible explanations: a statistical blip due to the ILO being a rolling quarterly figure and JSA data being monthly, people choosing not to claim for JSA when entitled or the impact of Government policy on unemployment levels.¹⁰

The recent quarterly survey of employers by the CIPD found an improvement in employment intentions by employers compared to the previous quarter. The survey, of around 900 CIPD members taken in June and July 2009, found that 24% of employers planned to increase employment in the quarter, 38% expected to maintain current staffing levels and 34% expected a decrease in employment. The balance of employment intentions was therefore -10, an improvement from -19 in spring 2009. Net employment intentions improved in the private sector from -30 to -2, but declined in the public sector from -3 to -28.¹¹

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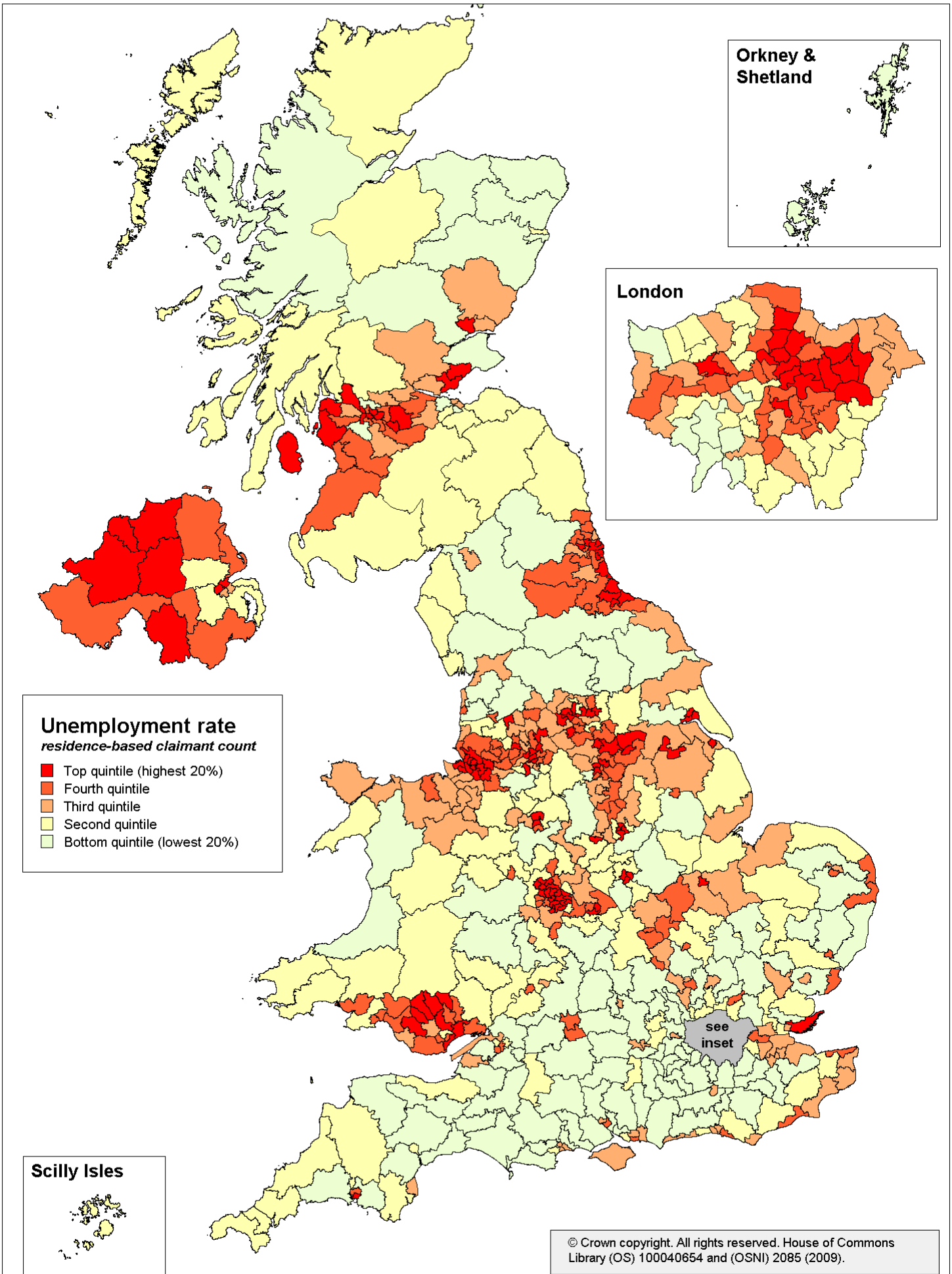
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Unemployment by Constituency, July 2009

residence-based claimant count rate, expressed as quintile groups (20% bands)

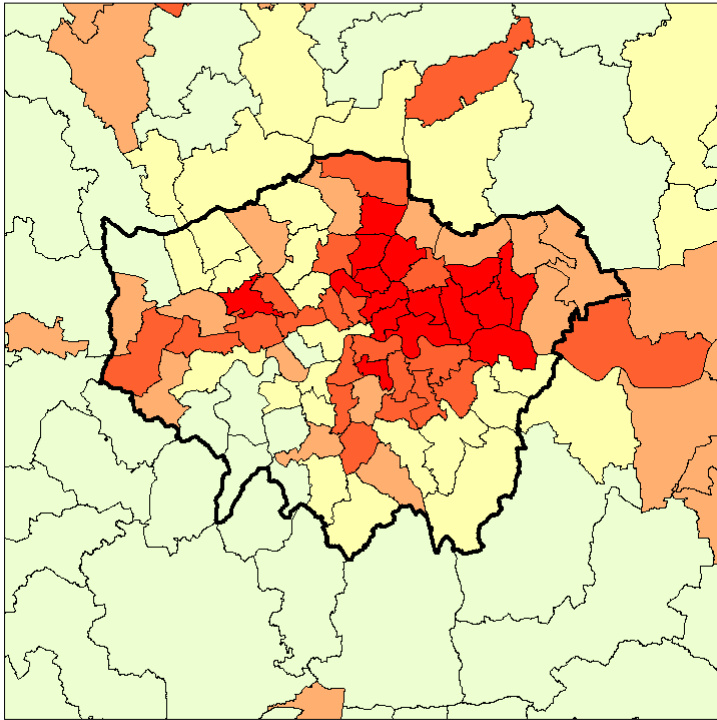

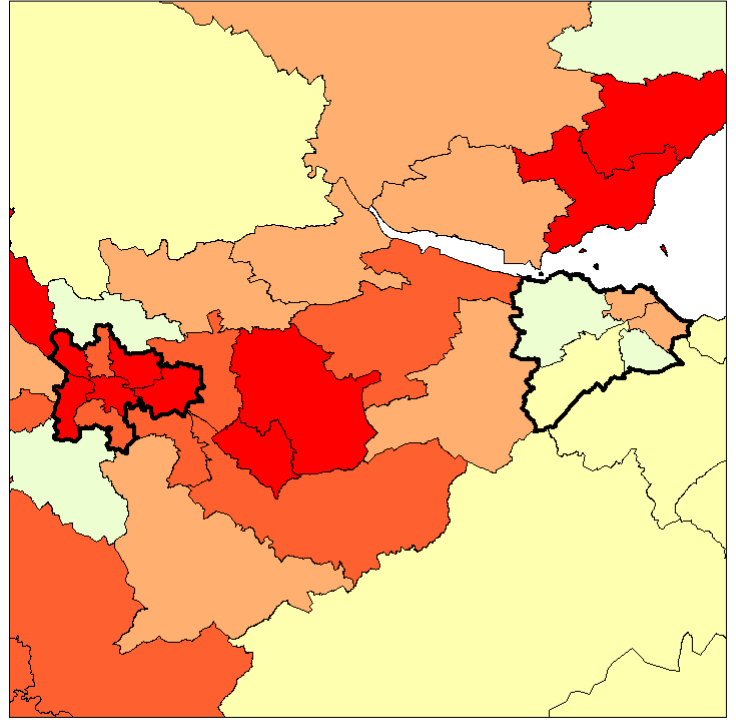

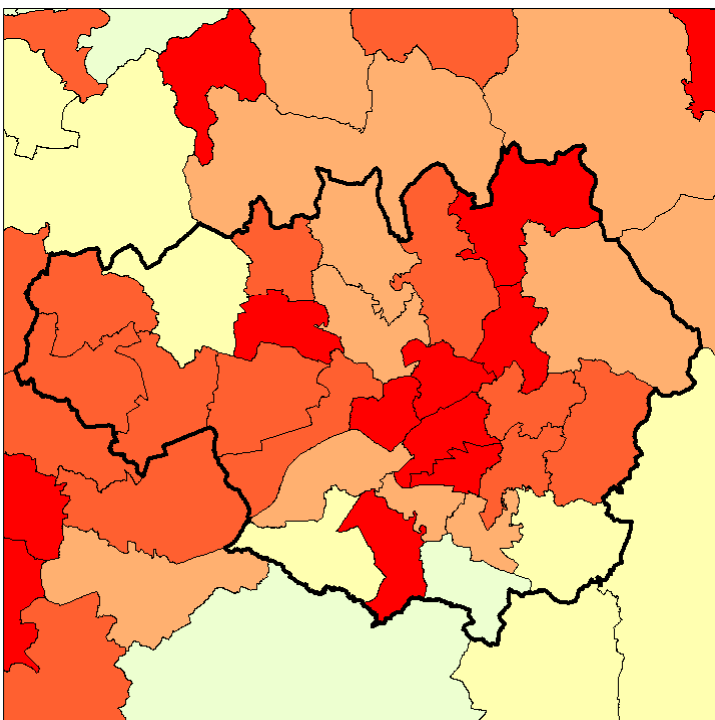

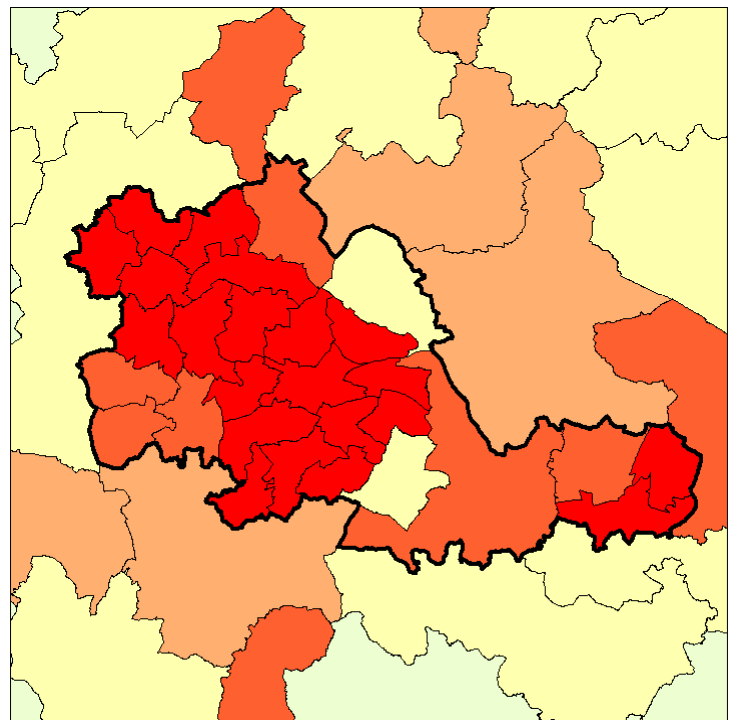

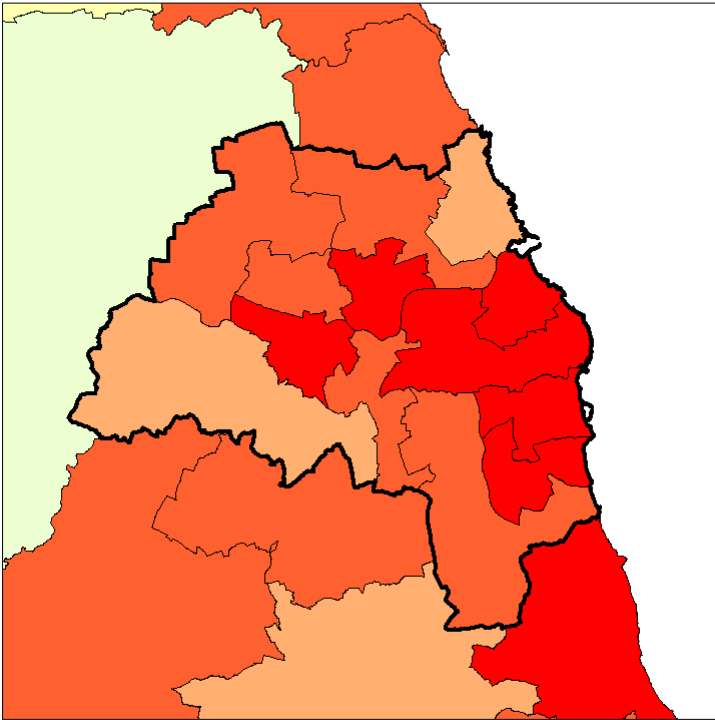


Unemployment by Constituency, July 2009

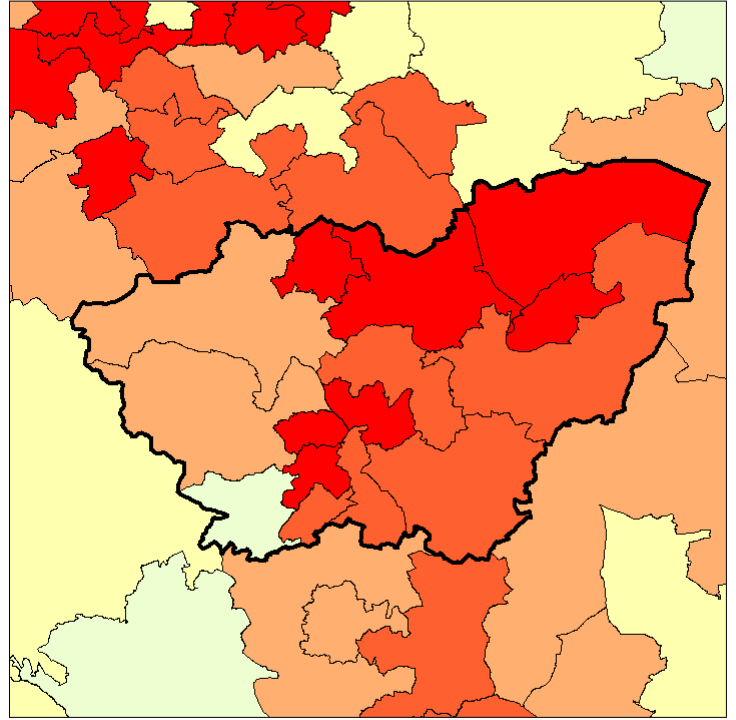

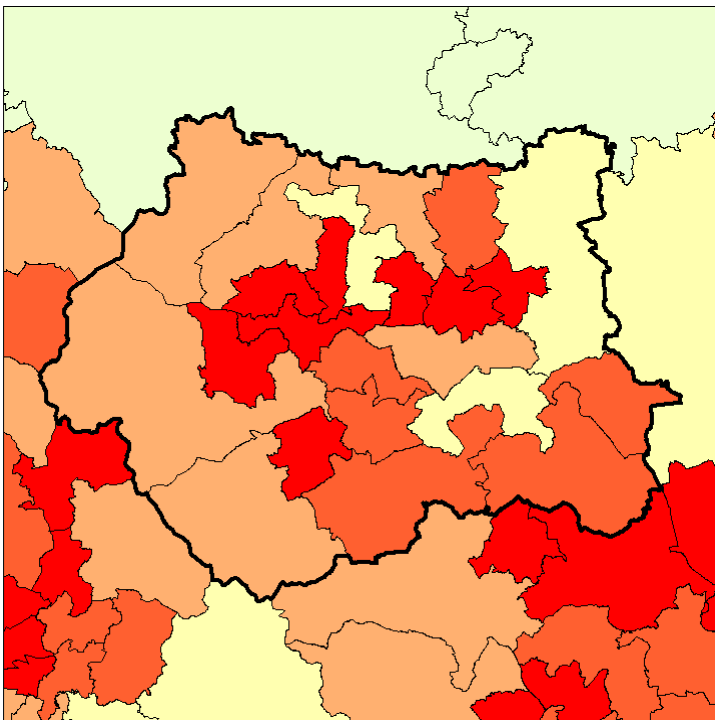

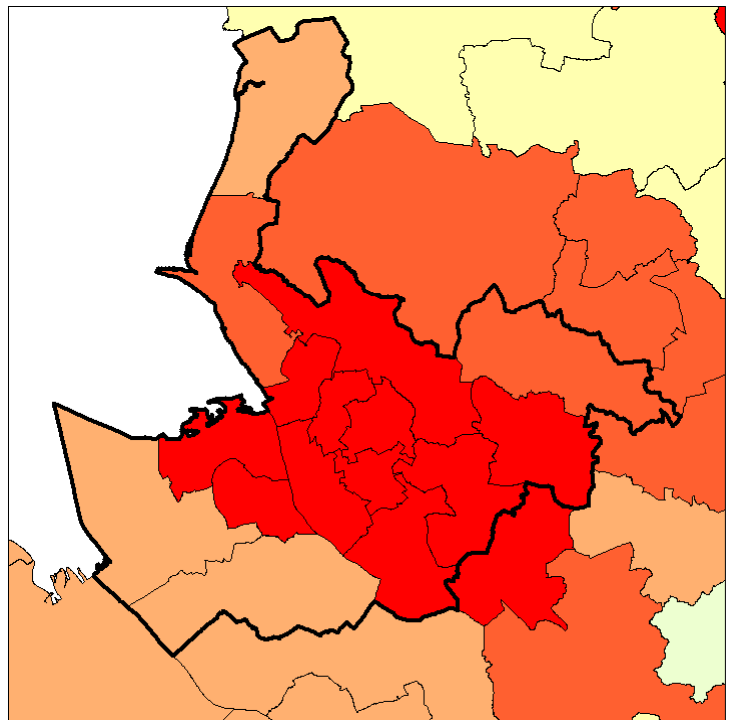

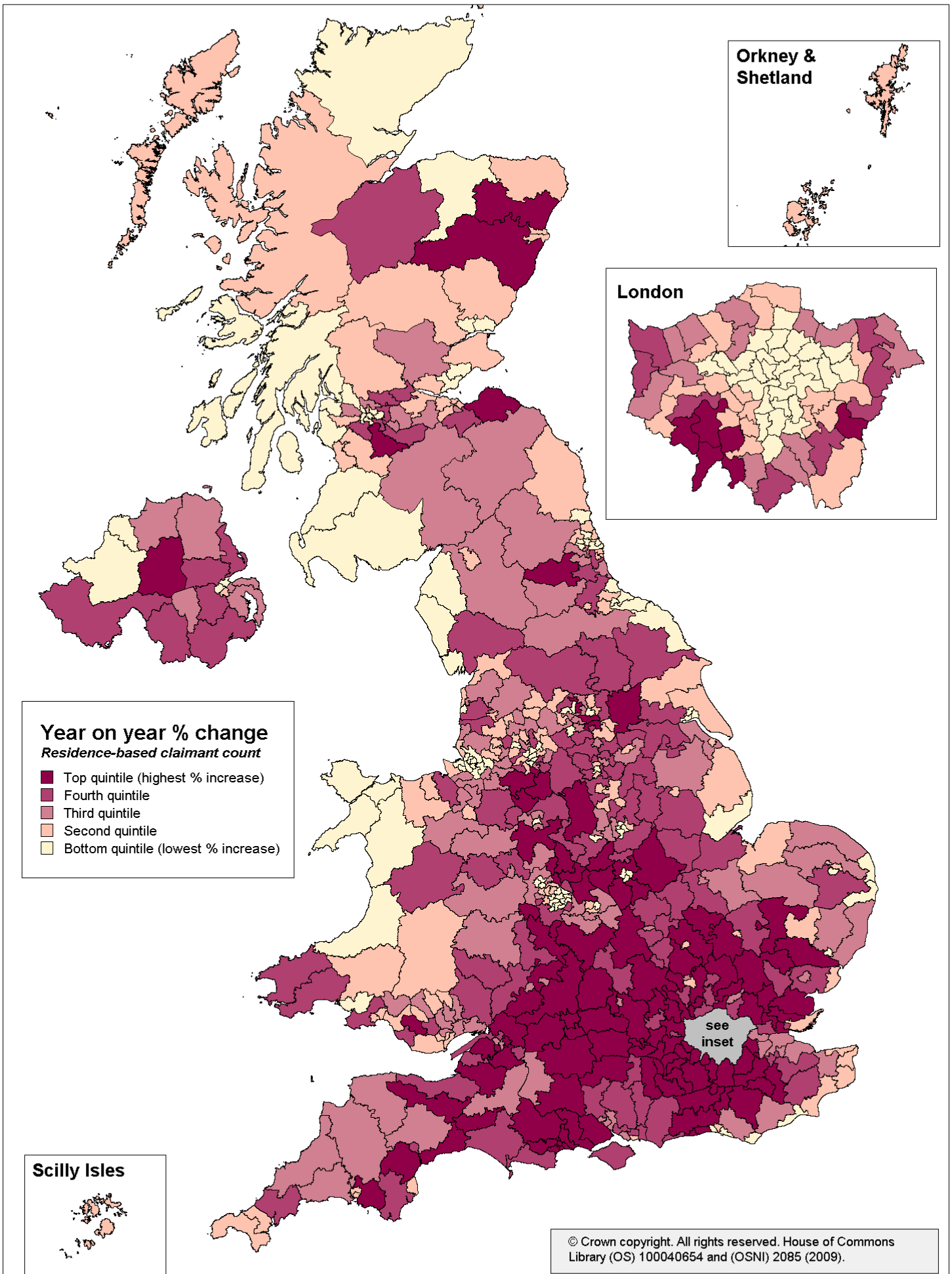

Explanatory notes

The following notes should be borne in mind when drawing conclusions from these maps:

Claimant count rate by constituency, July 2009 (pages 52-54)

- The maps on pages 52-54 show residence-based claimant count rates for July 2009 for constituencies in the United Kingdom, with an expanded view of constituencies in selected major conurbations and surrounding areas.
- The 646 constituencies in the United Kingdom have been divided into five equally sized bands, also known as 'quintile groups', each of which contain approximately 129 constituencies (20% of the total in the United Kingdom).
- These groups have been colour-coded, from red – the 20% of constituencies with the highest unemployment rates – through to yellow/light green – the 20% with the lowest unemployment rates.
- It is important to note that the range of unemployment rates covered by each band is different. For example, in July 2009 the top quintile (coloured red) is made up of constituencies with unemployment rates ranging from 7.9% to 23.2%, while the bottom quintile (coloured yellow/light green) is made up of constituencies with unemployment rates ranging from 1.3% to 3.5% (all rounded).
- Note also that constituencies with rates near the boundaries of these quintiles will be coloured differently even though their unemployment rates may only differ slightly from those in another, neighbouring quintile group.

Percentage change in claimant count levels, July 2008 to July 2009 (page 55)

- The map on page 55 shows the percentage change in residence-based claimant count levels between July 2008 and July 2009 for constituencies in the United Kingdom.
- The 646 constituencies in the United Kingdom have been divided into five equally sized bands, also known as 'quintile groups', each of which contain approximately 129 constituencies (20% of the total in the United Kingdom).
- These groups have been colour-coded, from reddish violet – the 20% of constituencies with the highest percentage increase in unemployment levels – through to pale yellow – the 20% with the lowest increase in unemployment levels.
- It is important to note that the range of percentage changes covered by each band is different. For example, in July 2009 the top quintile (coloured reddish violet) is made up of constituencies with changes in claimant count levels ranging from +122.9% to +217.4%, while the bottom quintile (coloured pale yellow) is made up of constituencies with changes in claimant count levels ranging from +23.8% to +61.7% (all rounded).
- Note also that constituencies with rates near the boundaries of these quintiles will be coloured differently even though their percentage changes in claimant count levels may only differ slightly from those in another, neighbouring quintile group.
- This map is based on the percentage change in the absolute level of claimants by constituency. Constituencies with relatively low absolute numbers of claimants may appear in this map in the higher quintiles and vice versa; for example, the constituency with the second highest percentage rise in claimants (210.9%, 341 claimants to 1,060 claimants), is also one of the constituencies with the lowest unemployment rates (2.4% in July 2009); the constituency with the highest unemployment rate (23.2%) has the lowest percentage change (23.8%, 6,881 claimants to 8,517 claimants).

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
