



Unemployment by Constituency, November 2009

RESEARCH PAPER 09/94 16 December 2009

This paper shows the number of people claiming Jobseeker's Allowance recorded as resident in each constituency in the United Kingdom in November 2009, together with comparisons with the levels in November 2008 and November 1997. Residence-based unemployment rates are given for all 646 constituencies in the United Kingdom. A summary of the latest labour market data is given, along with a selection of other relevant constituency-level indicators.

The paper includes unemployment rates by constituency maps and an annual percentage change map.

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I Monthly labour market statistics

Statistics on JSA claimants are one part of a large selection of labour market data released on a monthly basis.¹ This section highlights some of the key figures in the latest labour market release, as well as data of relevance to constituencies.

- Claimant count unemployment fell by 6,300 in November 2009 to 1.63 million.² This was the first monthly fall in claimants since February 2008.
- The wider ILO based measure of unemployment was 2.49 million in the period August-October 2009, a rise of 21,000 in the last quarter, a rise of 608,000 compared to the same period a year ago and 584,000 higher than in the same period in 1997. The rise in ILO unemployment has slowed in the last five months, with the level remaining between 2.4 and 2.5 million in each month.
- The number of people who have been unemployed (ILO measure) for longer than six months increased by 118,000 over the last quarter to 1.18 million (in August-October 2009). This was 457,000 higher than in the same quarter a year ago.
- On a regional basis the highest rates of unemployment (ILO measure) are in the West Midlands (10.1%), North East (9.9%) and London (9.2%) (August-October 2009). Over the last year the ILO unemployment rate has increased across the UK by 1.9 percentage points. The greatest rises have been in the West Midlands (3.1 percentage points), the South West (2.3 percentage points) and Northern Ireland (2.2 percentage points).
- In August-October 2009 757,000 people aged 18-24 were unemployed (ILO measure), a rise of 26,000 on the previous quarter and a rise of 161,000 on the same quarter a year ago. The unemployment rate for those aged 18-24 is now 18.4%. This is the highest rate since comparable records began in 1992. Following the last recession this figure peaked at 17.8% in Spring 1993.
- A total of 952,000 people aged 24 and under were unemployed in August-October 2009.
- The number of people in employment (16 and over) has risen by 53,000 over the last quarter to 28.93 million (August-October 2009); the number of people of working age and in employment has risen by 30,000 to 27.52 million in the same period. The employment rate for the working age population is 72.5%, no change on the last quarter and a fall of 1.7 percentage points compared to the same quarter a year ago.
- Over the last quarter, full-time employment fell by 69,000 while part-time employment rose by 122,000. Compared to same quarter one year ago overall employment fell by 432,000, full-time employment fell by 641,000 over the year while part-time employment rose by 209,000.
- Employment in the public sector rose by 23,000 over the last quarter to 6.09 million (September 2009), while employment in the private sector rose by 29,000 to 22.83 million.
- In August-October 2009 21.0% of the working age population were economically inactive (7.99 million), a fall of 1,000 on the previous quarter and up 96,000 compared to the same quarter a year ago. The number of people inactive due to being a student has risen by 75,000 over the last quarter and by 195,000 over the last year (a rise of 9.6% over the last year).
- It is estimated that there were 432,000 vacancies in the three months to November 2009, a rise of 1,000 on the previous quarter and 124,000 lower than in the same period a year ago.³

- Average earnings including bonuses rose by 1.5% in the latest quarter to October 2009 compared to the same period a year ago; average earnings excluding bonuses also rose by 1.7%.

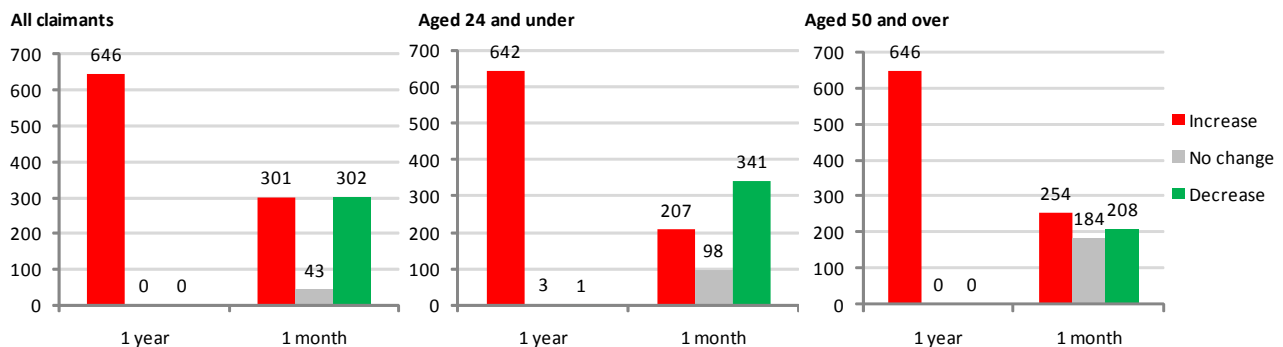
Long term unemployment

Data is available on a constituency basis for the duration of JSA claims and the age profile of claimants.⁴ The chart below shows a count of Parliamentary Constituencies based on whether the number of JSA claims of six months or more has increased, stayed the same or decreased over the last year and month for three measures: total claimants, those aged 24 and under, and those aged 50 and over.

The general trend is that over the year in almost all constituencies is that the number of claimants in each of the groups has risen, however the trend for the last month is quite different, with a more equal balance in each group between increases and decreases. However, please note that this data is not seasonally adjusted, and particularly as we near Christmas, these results include the effect of seasonal employment.

II JSA Claimant Count by Constituency

A Introduction

This section of the Research Paper provides the latest data on the monthly count of Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) claimants in each parliamentary constituency in the United Kingdom. For the purposes of this paper, unemployment means the number of JSA claimants resident in each constituency.

The methodology for calculating the rates was updated in the August 2009 edition⁵ (published 16 September 2009) in order to improve their accuracy. The rates included in this section show the number of claimants as a proportion of the estimated economically active population of working age resident in each constituency in 2006.⁶ Further detail on the methodology is given in a Library Standard Note.⁷ Prior to the August 2009 edition of the paper the rates were based on the 2001 population estimates.⁸ Comparisons of rates should not be made between those published by the Library prior to September 2009 and those in the current edition.

The Office for National Statistics also publishes unemployment data for parliamentary constituencies. These data may be found on the NOMIS website⁹ and on the ONS website.¹⁰ JSA claimant count rates published by the ONS use the resident working age population and are therefore different from the rates published in this section. Rates included in PQ answers from ONS will also differ from the rates in this section. For an explanation of the different measures of unemployment, and for an exposition of the methodology used to calculate the unemployment rates displayed in this paper please see Library Research Paper 05/08¹¹ and Standard Note SN/EP/5217.¹²

Data for current constituencies exist back to January 1996¹³, and are available upon request from the Economic Policy & Statistics Section [extension 2883].

Part B provides maps that show the latest residence-based claimant count rates for each constituency in the United Kingdom, and the annual percentage change in the claimant count for each UK constituency, expressed as quintile groups. Part E of this section provides some notes on the tables and details the copyright restrictions which apply to the data and the maps.

The rates presented in this part of the paper should be regarded more as a social measure of relative deprivation than as an economic measure of the mismatch between the supply of and demand for labour, as they take no account of people's ability to seek work outside the constituency in which they live. While the rates are based on the latest population estimates at a constituency level, they are constrained by the use of the proportion of the population economically active in 2001. Where constituencies have seen significant socio-economic change or population growth since 2001 the methodology used to calculate the rates may be less accurate in fully reflecting current unemployment rates.

⁶ The denominator for the rate is calculated using the proportion of the economically active working age population in the 2001 census and the estimated resident working age population in 2006. This means the rates take account of recent population change but not any changes in the economically active population. Between 2001 and 2006 the Labour Force Survey estimates that economic activity rose by around 0.4 percentage points for the UK overall.

⁸ Rates published prior to September 2009 were based on the 2001 economically active and 2001 population. Rates published before January 2005 calculated rates using 1997-based economically active population denominators. See Library Research Paper 05/08 for further details.

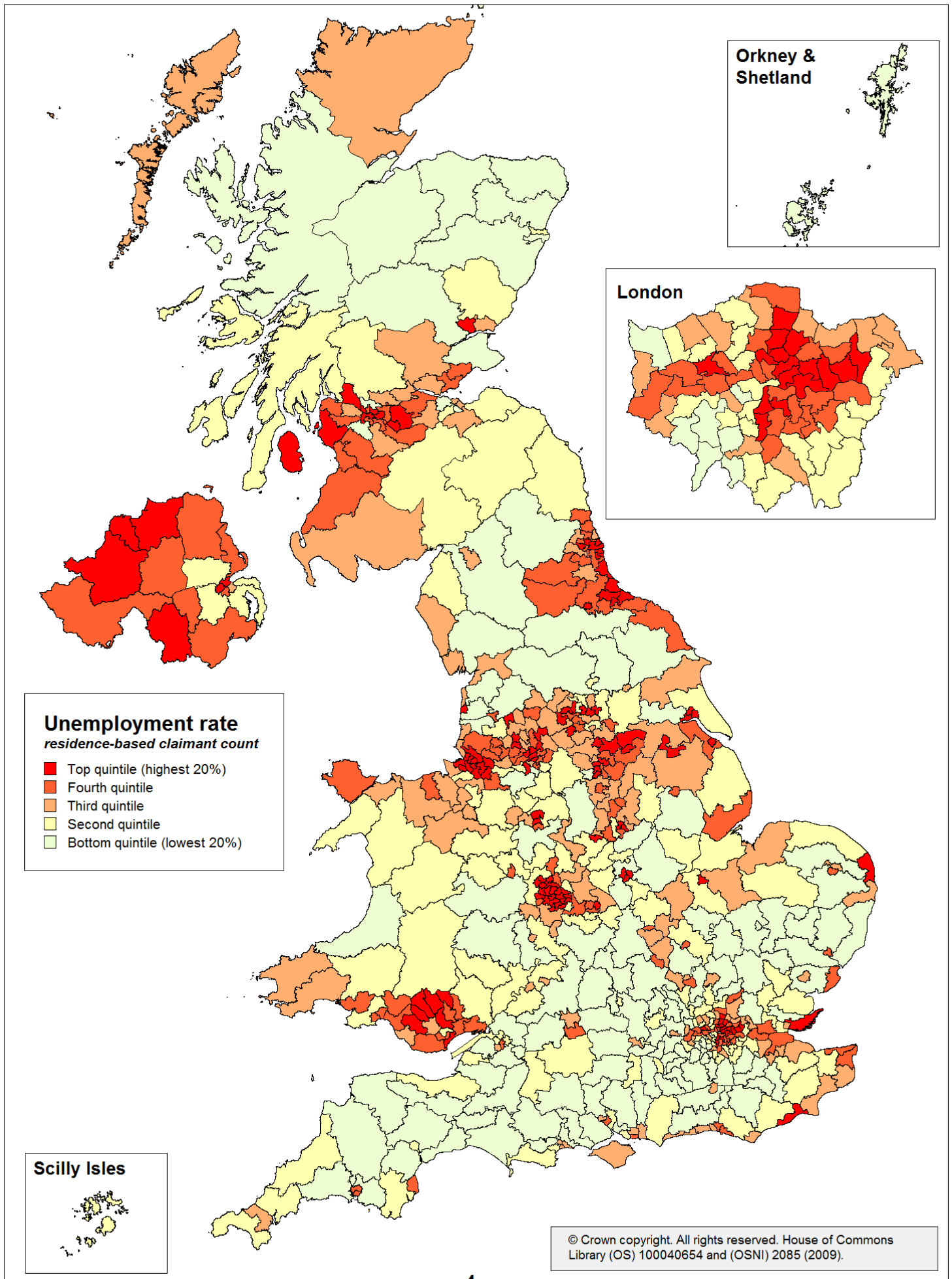

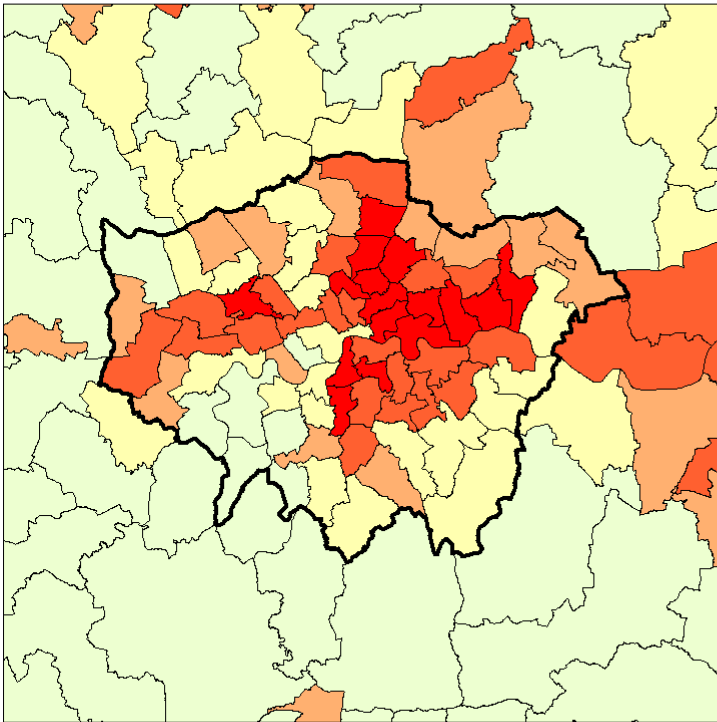

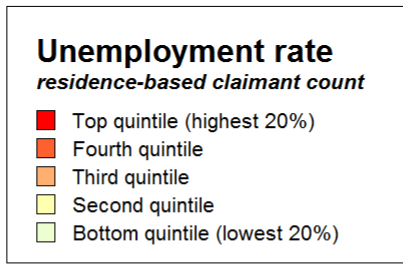
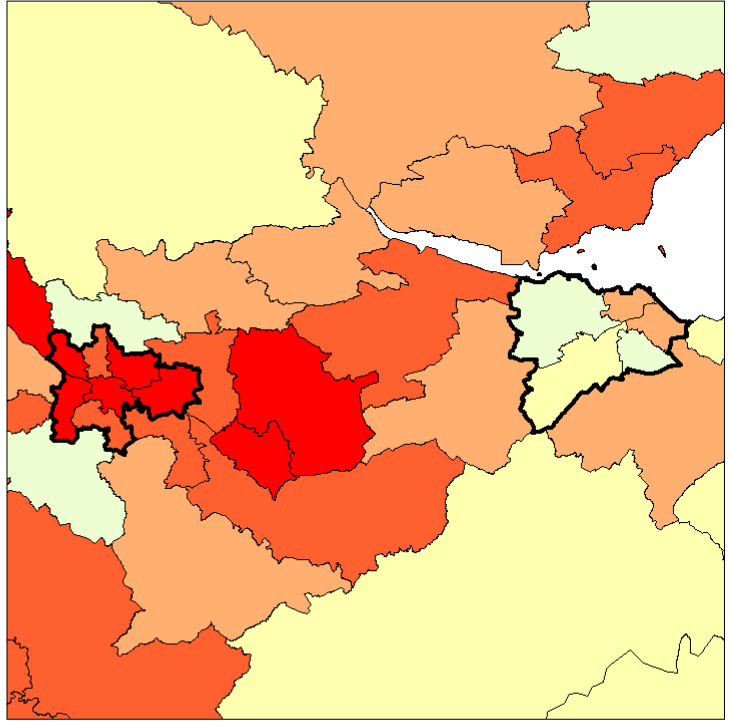

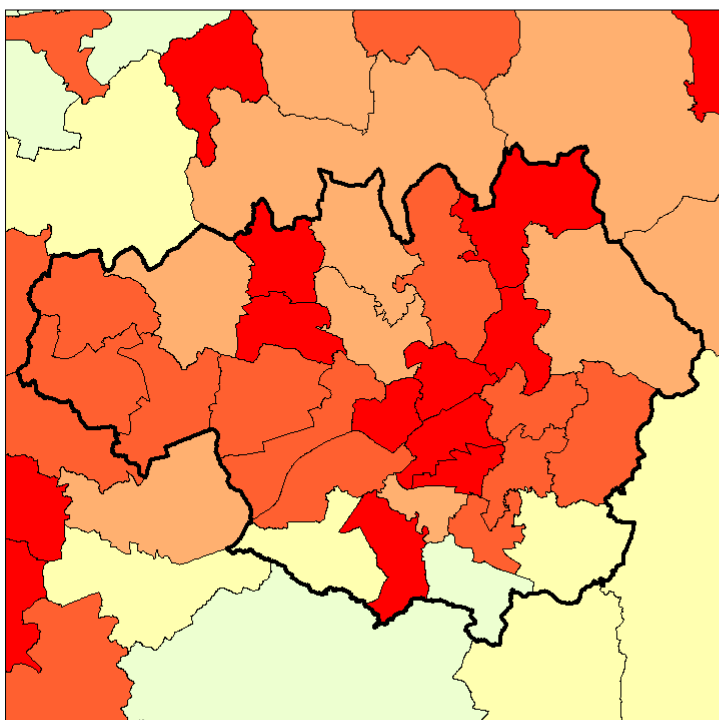

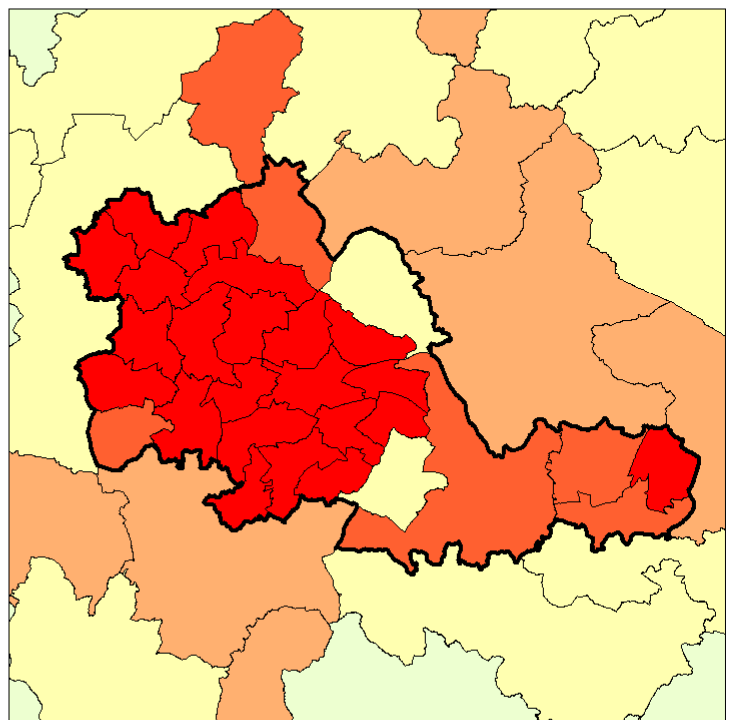

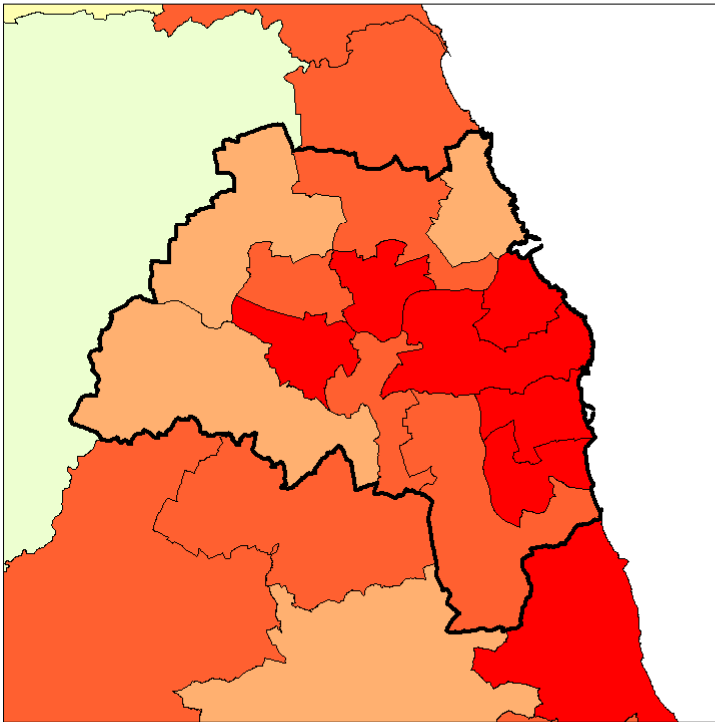

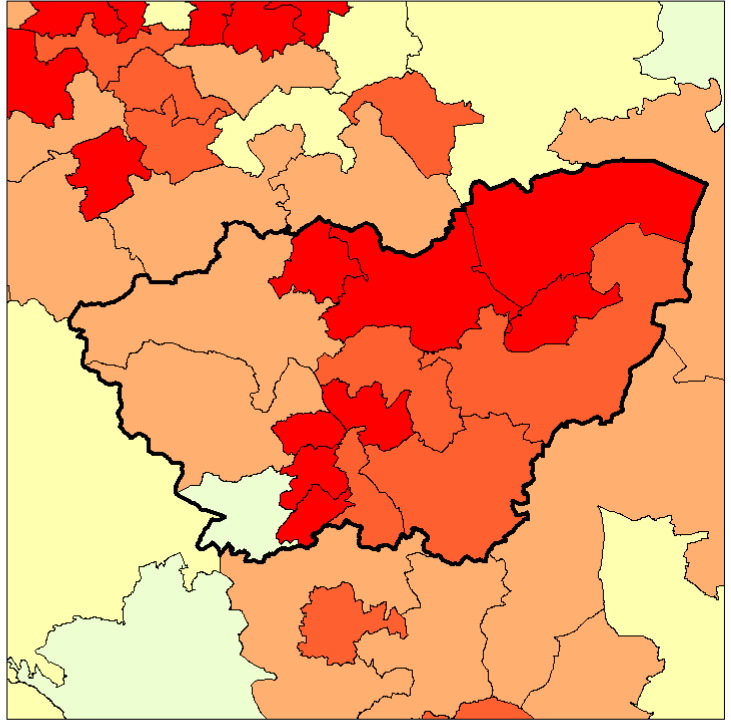

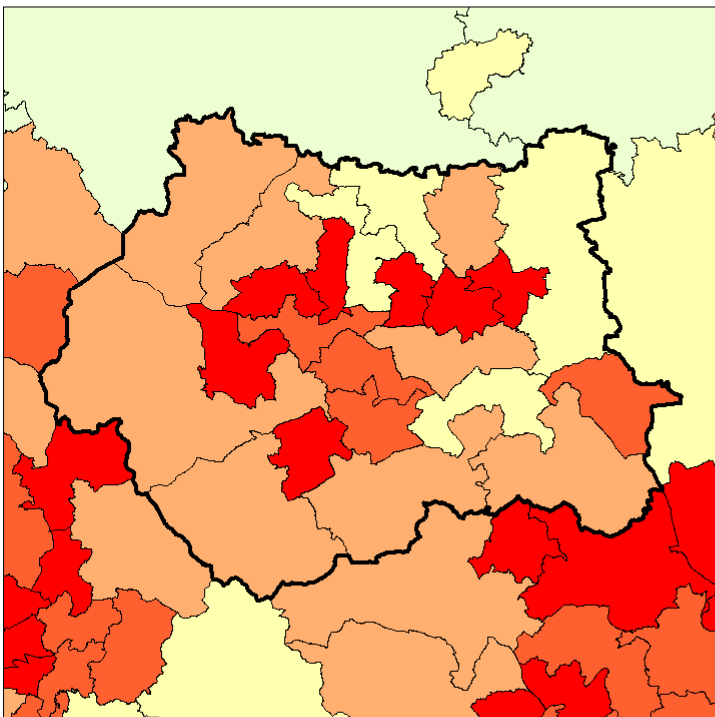

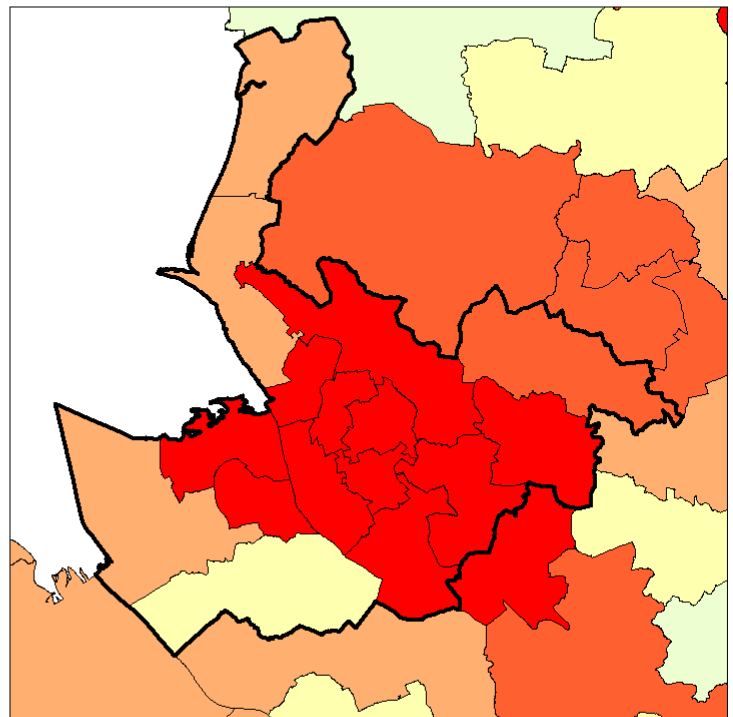

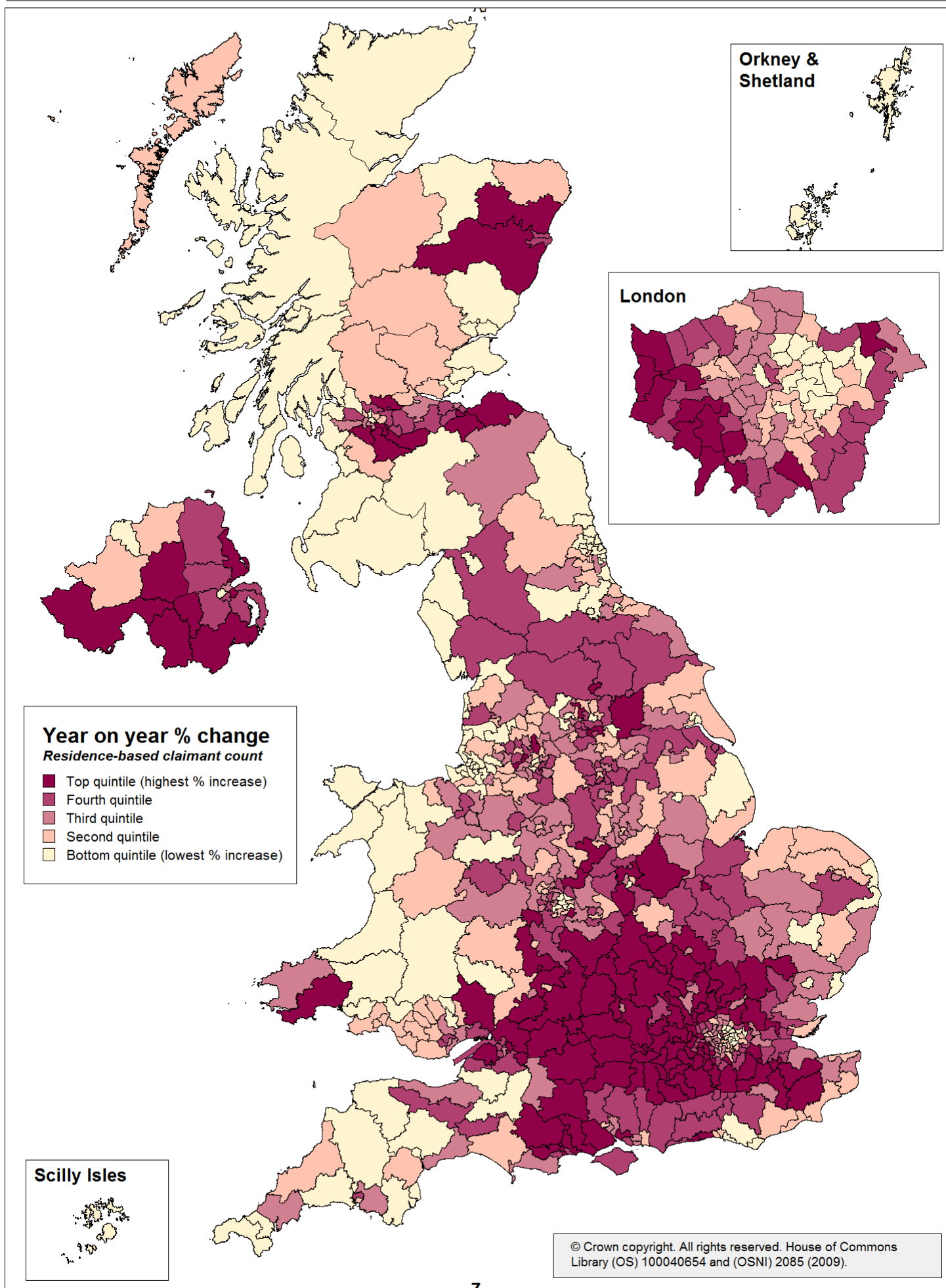

Explanatory notes

The following notes should be borne in mind when drawing conclusions from these maps:

Claimant count rate by constituency, November 2009 (pages 4-6)

- The maps on pages 4-6 show residence-based claimant count rates for November 2009 for constituencies in the United Kingdom, with an expanded view of constituencies in selected major conurbations and surrounding areas.
- The 646 constituencies in the United Kingdom have been divided into five equally sized bands, also known as 'quintile groups', each of which contain approximately 129 constituencies (20% of the total in the United Kingdom).
- These groups have been colour-coded, from red – the 20% of constituencies with the highest unemployment rates – through to yellow/light green – the 20% with the lowest unemployment rates.
- It is important to note that the range of unemployment rates covered by each band is different. For example, in November 2009 the top quintile (coloured red) is made up of constituencies with unemployment rates ranging from 7.5% to 20.7%, while the bottom quintile (coloured yellow/light green) is made up of constituencies with unemployment rates ranging from 1.2% to 3.3% (all rounded).
- Note also that constituencies with rates near the boundaries of these quintiles will be coloured differently even though their unemployment rates may only differ slightly from those in another, neighbouring quintile group.

Percentage change in claimant count levels, November 2008 to November 2009 (page 7)

- The map on page 7 shows the percentage change in residence-based claimant count levels between November 2008 and November 2009 for constituencies in the United Kingdom.
- The 646 constituencies in the United Kingdom have been divided into five equally sized bands, also known as 'quintile groups', each of which contain approximately 129 constituencies (20% of the total in the United Kingdom).
- These groups have been colour-coded, from reddish violet – the 20% of constituencies with the highest percentage increase in unemployment levels – through to pale yellow – the 20% with the lowest increase in unemployment levels.
- It is important to note that the range of percentage changes covered by each band is different. For example, in November 2009 the top quintile (coloured reddish violet) is made up of constituencies with changes in claimant count levels ranging from +64.5% to +111.4%, while the bottom quintile (coloured pale yellow) is made up of constituencies with changes in claimant count levels ranging from +11.9% to +39.2% (all rounded).
- Note also that constituencies with rates near the boundaries of these quintiles will be coloured differently even though their percentage changes in claimant count levels may only differ slightly from those in another, neighbouring quintile group.
- This map is based on the percentage change in the absolute level of claimants by constituency. Constituencies with relatively low absolute numbers of claimants may appear in this map in the higher quintiles and vice versa; for example, the constituency with the fifth highest percentage rise in claimants (97.1%, 341 claimants to 672 claimants), is also one of the constituencies with the lowest unemployment rates (1.3% in November 2009); the constituency with the highest unemployment rate (20.7%) has one of the lowest percentage changes (23.2%, 7,177 claimants to 8,841 claimants).

E Table notes

1. A comparison of current levels with those in 1997 is not available for the new Westminster Parliamentary Constituencies in Scotland, which have stood since the May 2005 General Election. Figures are only available for these constituencies since February 2004. Unavailable figures are denoted in the tables by a ‘.’.
2. The Boundary Commission reviews in 1995 defined 659 constituencies in the United Kingdom. These were defined in terms of electoral wards as they stood at the time of the review. For the purposes of the unemployment statistics however, constituencies represent a best-fit of frozen 1991 wards to the new constituencies.

Boundary alterations between 1991 and 1995 mean that there are inevitably approximations to 1995 boundaries in many constituencies. In some cases, however, the changes to ward boundaries were substantial and some wards are now split between constituencies. These constituencies are indicated with an ‘(a)’ in the following tables.

Four wards with populations below the 1991 Census confidentiality threshold have had their data ‘exported’ to a ward which is in another constituency. In these cases, the data for the ‘exported’ ward are included in the constituency to which the ward has been transferred. Constituencies losing data in this way are indicated by ‘(b)’, whereas those gaining data as a result are indicated by ‘(c)’.¹⁴

III Other constituency indicators

Data on the JSA claimant count is the most timely labour market indicator available at a constituency level. However a wider selection of data is available from the Office for National Statistics (ONS). Almost all data available at a constituency level is published, with longer time series, in constituency profiles on the NOMIS website.¹⁵ The Library is available to provide assistance in accessing this data and advice on interpreting it. The NOMIS website also makes data available at a local authority and ward level.

In this edition of *Unemployment by Constituency* we have introduced an additional table of other constituency level data that is likely to be of current interest to Members of Parliament and their staff. The content is not fixed and may vary between months. We would welcome any comments on both the introduction of the table and the contents.

The tables show the following:

- New estimates of ILO unemployment at a constituency level as published in October 2009. **Please note these are experimental statistics and not yet 'official' statistics.** The current Annual Population Survey-based estimates produced by ONS are subject to a high level of sampling variability at a constituency level and these model-based estimates seek to reduce the sampling error by taking account of JSA claimant count movements in the same period. The data is published quarterly and the latest available is for the year to March 2009. These rates are higher than claimant-based rates as they include those people who indicate they would like to work, and are available for work, but are not claiming (or eligible for) Job Seekers Allowance. Further information on the estimates and a time series is available on the ONS website.¹⁶ However, this data is still subject to sampling variability and excludes Northern Ireland.
- The estimated employment rate in the year to March 2009. This figure is not experimental, is from the Annual Population Survey, and is based on a different methodology than the ILO unemployment estimates. Please note this is sample-based data and subject to sampling variability and excludes Northern Ireland.¹⁷
- The number of available unfilled vacancies notified to Jobcentre Plus. Please note that this is a snapshot taken at a single point during the month. Vacancies do not need to be notified to Jobcentre Plus (and many are not). Constituencies are not isolated labour markets and therefore any jobsearch is likely to extend beyond the boundaries of the constituency.¹⁸
- The final three columns show the number of JSA claimants broken down into three age groups. Section II presents the simple claimant total for November of 1997, 2008 and 2009, as well as a gender split for November 2009. However greater detail is available on this measure such as a breakdown by age bands and duration.¹⁹
