



Claimant Count Unemployment in the new (2010) Parliamentary Constituencies

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New parliamentary constituency boundaries will be used at the General Election on 6 May 2010. This paper presents data from the labour market statistics currently available for these constituencies, including:

- JSA claimant levels in 2005, 2009 and 2010
- JSA claimant rates
- Long-term claimants and claimants aged 24 and under
- Vacancies recorded at Jobcentre Plus.

These data are not seasonally adjusted. They are available on a monthly basis from 2004.

These data are different from those published every month in the Library Research Paper Unemployment by Constituency.

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1 Introduction

This paper is made up of two tables presenting claimant count and vacancy data for the new Parliamentary Constituencies to be used at the General Election (2010 constituencies).

Boundary changes mean that the majority of constituencies in England, Wales and Northern Ireland have had some changes, although 73 are unchanged in England and Wales.¹ Constituency boundaries in Scotland were changed prior to the 2005 General Election and these are unchanged in 2010.²

Two sources of data are used to describe 'unemployment': the claimant count and ILO unemployment. Claimant count data covers an administrative count of those claiming Job Seeker's Allowance (JSA). It has the benefit of being timely, accurate, available over long time periods and available for low level geographies. The main problem with the count is that some of those looking for work and 'unemployed' do not, or cannot, claim JSA. The standard international measure of unemployment is ILO unemployment, a survey-based measure which captures the number of people looking for and available for work within a standard definition.³ The main problem with this measure is that at a local authority and constituency level it has a time lag and is subject to sampling variability.⁴ ILO unemployment is not currently available for 2010 constituencies.

The tables in this paper present levels, rates and changes over time using February 2005, February 2009 and February 2010. It is intended to provide answers to frequently requested data; for further analysis or to comment on the content, Members of Parliament and their staff can contact the authors.

These data are different from those published every month in the Library Research Paper *Unemployment by Constituency*, which are based on the constituency boundaries used at the 2005 election.

The levels and some rates included in this paper are available to download from the NOMIS website.⁵ Changes, rankings and some rates have been calculated by the Library.

1.1 Availability of data and methodology

This paper is based on data published by ONS through the NOMIS website. At the time of writing, data on JSA claimants and Jobcentre Plus vacancies are available for the 2010 constituencies on a monthly non-seasonally adjusted basis from 2004 onwards.

These data are not seasonally adjusted. As unemployment has a seasonal pattern, comparisons should be made using the same month in each year. Data for the current parliamentary constituencies (used in 2005 for England, Wales and Northern Ireland) are available back to 1996. Due to the number of boundary changes in 2010, users are advised not to compare data from the two geographies.

In the tables the latest month of data available at the time of publication is used and compared to levels in 2009 and 2005. 2005 has been used due to its relevance as the year

of the last general election; however, readers should note that the numbers of JSA claimants in 2004-05 were at their lowest level since 1975.

All changes over time and rankings have been calculated by the Library, as has the ratio of JSA claimants per vacancy.

Two 'unemployment rates' are shown. The 'ONS' rate is that published by ONS with the data and is calculated using the resident working age population in 2007 for Scotland and 2008 for England and Wales. Rates included in PQ answers will be based on this rate. The 'Library' rate is calculated by the Library and shows the number of claimants as a proportion of the estimated economically active population of working age resident in each constituency in 2008.⁶ For an exposition of the methodology used to calculate the unemployment rates displayed in this paper see Library Standard Note *Unemployment by Constituency: change in methodology*.⁷ Rates are not currently available for Northern Ireland.

The rates presented in this paper should be regarded more as a social measure of relative deprivation than as an economic measure of the mismatch between the supply of and demand for labour, as they take no account of people's ability to seek work outside the constituency in which they live.

While the Library rates are based on the latest population estimates at a constituency level, they are constrained by the use of the proportion of the population economically active in 2001. Where constituencies have seen major demographic shifts or socio-economic change since 2001 the methodology used to calculate the rates may be less accurate in fully reflecting current unemployment rates.

1.2 Overview of table 1

The first part of this table, labelled *Total JSA Claimants* presents the non-seasonally adjusted count of JSA claimants in each 2010 constituency in February 2005, February 2009 and February 2010. It also shows the change in level between each of the dates.

The next five columns, *ONS Claimant Rate*, provide rates based on the resident working age population in the constituency and are as published by ONS. The percentage point change in the rate over the last year and the rank of the constituency compared to the 632 seats in Great Britain in February 2010 is also shown (where 1=highest claimant rate).

The final part of the table, *Library rate*, shows rates based on the Library's estimate of the resident working age economically active population, as outlined in section 1.1. These rates are higher than the ONS rates because they are percentages of a smaller population (the economically active working-age population rather than the whole working-age population). A ranking for the 632 seats in Great Britain in February 2010 (where 1=highest unemployment rate) is also shown. Please note that the methodology used for Scotland is slightly different to that used for England and Wales.

⁶ The denominator for the rate is calculated using the proportion of the economically active working age population in the 2001 census and the estimated resident working age population in 2008 (except in Scotland where the 2007 population is used). This means the rates take account of recent population change but not any changes in the economically active population. Between the first quarter of 2001 and the same period in 2008 the Labour Force Survey estimates that economic activity rose by around 0.5 percentage points for the UK overall.

1.3 Overview of table 2

This table contains four sets of data:

- the number of JSA claimants aged 24 and under in February 2009 and 2010, and the change between the two periods. Data is also available from NOMIS for other age breakdowns;
- the number of people who have been claiming JSA for 12 months or more in February 2009 and 2010, and the change between the two periods;
- the number of Jobcentre Plus vacancies in the constituency in February 2009 and 2010; and,
- the number of JSA claimants per vacancy in February 2009 and 2010, the change between the two periods and a ranking by constituency of the number of JSA claimants per vacancy in February 2010 (where 1=highest number of claimants per vacancy).

The vacancy figures relate to 'live unfilled vacancies', which are vacancies notified to Jobcentre Plus and currently thought to be unfilled. A large number of vacancies are not notified to Jobcentre Plus, and the rate of notification can depend on location, occupation and industry. Data for Lincoln is affected by armed forces recruitment.

1.4 Notes and copyright

Unavailable figures are denoted in the tables by a '..'.

Claimant rates and figures on JSA claimants per vacancy are rounded to one decimal place.

The denominators used in this paper are partly derived from the 2001 Census. Census data for England and Wales are published by the Office for National Statistics. Census data for Scotland are published by the General Register Office for Scotland. Census data for Northern Ireland are published by the Northern Ireland Statistics and Research Agency. Census data are © Crown copyright.
