



# Unemployment by Constituency: July 2010

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This paper presents labour market data for Parliamentary Constituencies. A summary of the latest national and regional labour market data is given, along with a selection of relevant constituency-level indicators including the latest Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) claimant count data.

The latest data show:

- Claimant count unemployment fell by 20,800 to 1.46 million in June 2010 (seasonally adjusted). The claimant count rose between May and June 2010 in 29 constituencies and fell in 621 constituencies. Compared to June 2009, JSA claimant levels are now higher in 124 constituencies and lower in 526 constituencies.
- ILO unemployment fell by 34,000 over the last three months to 2.47 million (March-May 2010). The unemployment rate is 7.8% compared with 7.6% in the same period a year ago.
- Employment rose by 160,000 over the last three months to 28.98 million (March-May 2010). 72.3% of the working age population is in employment.
- Economic inactivity fell by 62,000 over the last three months to 8.10 million (March-May 2010). 21.3% of the working age population is economically inactive.

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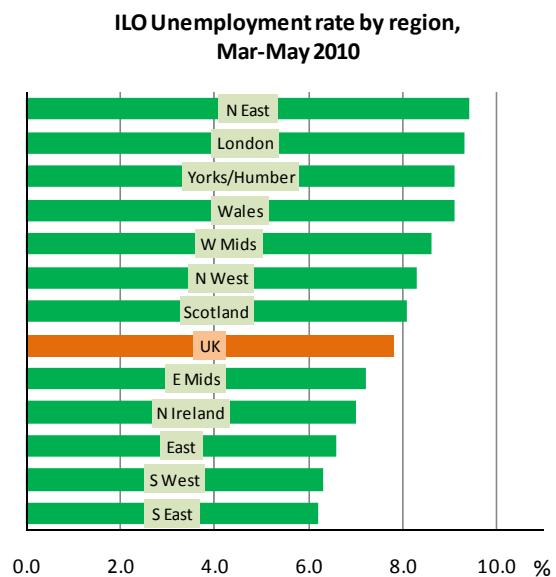
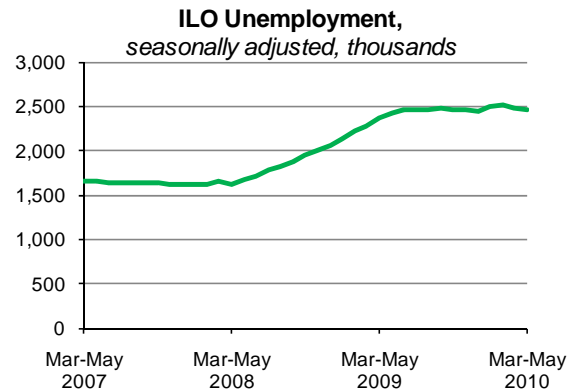


## 1 Monthly labour market statistics

Statistics on Jobseekers Allowance (JSA) claimants are one part of a large selection of labour market data released on a monthly basis.<sup>1</sup> This section highlights some of the key figures in the latest labour market release and also looks in more detail at changes in JSA claimants at a constituency level.

### Unemployment

- JSA claimant count unemployment fell by 20,800 in June 2010 to 1.46 million.<sup>2</sup> It is 100,100 lower than in June 2009.
- The wider ILO based measure of unemployment was 2.47 million in the period March-May 2010, a fall of 34,000 from the last quarter, an increase of 92,000 compared with the same period a year ago and 418,000 higher than in April-June 1997. The unemployment rate is 7.8%, 0.1 percentage points lower than in the last quarter, and 0.3 percentage points higher than the same period a year ago.
- The number of people who have been unemployed (ILO measure) for longer than six months increased by 20,000 over the last quarter to 1.31 million (March-May 2010). This was 333,000 higher than in the same quarter a year ago.
- On a regional basis the highest rates of unemployment (ILO measure) were in the North East (9.4%), London (9.3%), Wales and Yorkshire and the Humber (both 9.1%) (March-May 2010, see chart). Over the last year the ILO unemployment rate has increased across the UK by 0.3 percentage points. The greatest rises were in Wales (1.5 percentage points) and Scotland (1.4 percentage points), while the West Midlands was the only region to see a year-on-year fall (-1.6 percentage points).
- In March-May 2010 707,000 people aged 18-24 were unemployed (ILO measure), a fall of 19,000 on the previous quarter and a fall of 16,000 on the same quarter a year ago. The unemployment rate for those aged 18-24 is now 17.1%.
- 923,000 people aged 24 and under were (ILO) unemployed in March-May 2010, a rate of 19.5%.

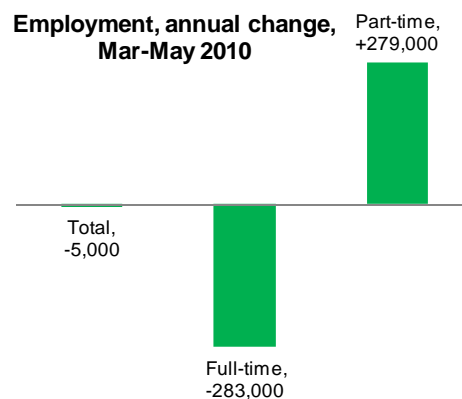

### Employment

- The number of people in employment (16 and over) rose by 160,000 over the last quarter to 28.98 million (March-May 2010); the number of working-age people in employment rose by 132,000 to 27.54 million in the same period. The working-age employment rate was 72.3%, 0.3 percentage points higher than the last quarter and a fall of 0.6 percentage points compared to the same quarter a year ago.
- Over the last quarter, full-time employment rose by 12,000 while part-time employment rose by 148,000 to stand at 7,819,000. Part-time workers now account for 27% of all in employment, the highest proportion since comparable records began in 1992. Since the same quarter last year overall employment fell by 5,000, full-time fell by 283,000 while part-time rose by 279,000.
- Public sector employment fell by 7,000 over the last quarter to 6.1 million (March 2010), while private sector employment rose by 12,000 to 22.78 million. Over the last year public sector employment has risen by 28,000 while private sector employment has fallen by 241,000.

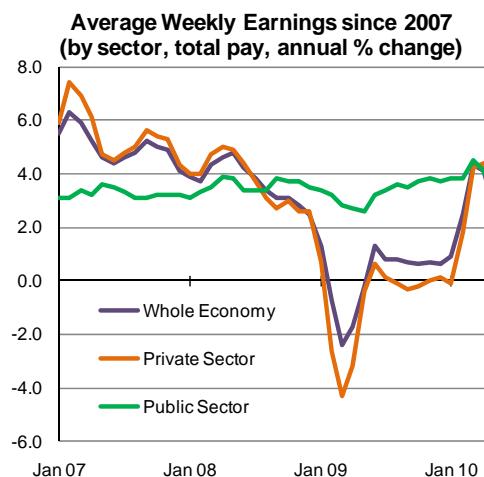


### Inactivity

- In March-May 2010 21.3% of working-age people were economically inactive (8.10 million), a fall of 62,000 on the previous quarter and up 180,000 since the same quarter last year. The number of people inactive due to being a student has fallen by 44,000 over the last quarter but has increased by 143,000 over the last year (a rise of 6.8% over the last year).

### Earnings and vacancies

- Average weekly total pay rose by 2.7% in March to May 2010 compared to the same period a year ago; bonus pay was up 4.5% over the same period and regular pay increased by 1.8% over the same period.
- There were an estimated 486,000 vacancies in the UK in the three months to June 2010, a rise of 10,000 on the previous quarter and 52,000 higher than in the same period a year ago.<sup>3</sup>



### Data for new constituencies

The majority of constituencies used in the General Election had undergone boundary changes. The current availability of labour market data for these new constituencies is outlined below:

- JSA claimant count data and rates are available back to 2004.
- ILO unemployment, Employment and Inactivity based on the Annual Population Survey are available. Model-based estimates of ILO unemployment are being developed.
- Earnings data based on the Annual Survey of Hours and Earnings (ASHE) will not be available until the next release in November 2010.
- Annual Business Inquiry (ABI) data is available (Employee jobs).

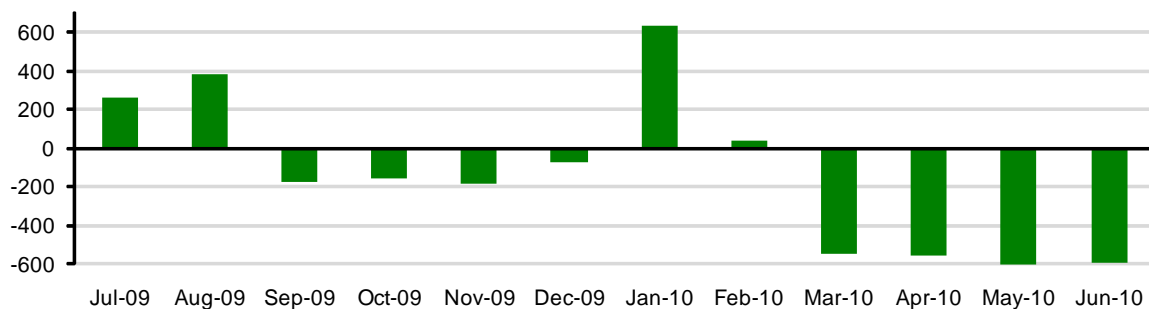
### ***Change in claimant count in constituencies***

Between June 2009 and June 2010 81% of constituencies saw a fall in the claimant count level (526 constituencies), while 19% recorded a rise (124 constituencies). Between May 2010 and June 2010 an even greater proportion of constituencies saw a fall in the claimant count: 96% (621 constituencies) have recorded a fall; only 4% (29 constituencies) saw a rise.

The chart below shows the balance of constituencies that have experienced a monthly increase or decrease in the claimant count for the past year. This shows that in each of the last four months the vast majority of constituencies saw falls in their claimant count. Note that these data are not seasonally adjusted and therefore do not take account of seasonal affects which can sometimes cause significant movements in the claimant count. For example, the seasonal effect associated with Christmas contributed to rises in the claimant count in almost all constituencies in January 2010.

### ***Public sector employment by constituency***

The current political and economic climate means that employment in public sector activities is of particular interest. Data on public sector employment by constituency is not available, but an indication can be gained from considering the industrial sectors where the public sector is predominant. A recent Library Standard Note does this for all constituencies.<sup>4</sup>

The table below presents the 20 constituencies with the highest and lowest levels of employment in sectors where the public sector is main employer, ranked both by level and as a percentage of all jobs. These data are based on the Annual Business Inquiry (ABI), which is a survey of employers and counts jobs rather than the number of people in employment. The data are therefore an estimate of the number of jobs in the constituency not the industries in which residents are employed.

Overall, the industries included (public administration, health, social work and education) are an overestimate of the public sector. They account for 7.2 million employees across the UK, while the ONS estimate total public sector employment was around 5.8 million in 2008.<sup>5</sup>

These categories will include some jobs that are not public sector and exclude some jobs that are public sector. Private sector employment such as private schools and hospitals, private residential care, driving schools and day nurseries are included. Public sector broadcasters and librarians are among the groups not included by this measure. Universities, higher and further education and sixth form colleges are not considered to be in the public sector in National Accounts terms but are included here.

These are sample-based estimates and have considerable margins of error. They should be used with caution.

## 2 Constituency data

The remainder of this paper is made up of two tables and a series of maps presenting labour market data for the current Parliamentary Constituencies. The latest available data is shown, as well as comparisons with previous years and calculations of change and rankings. Section 4 of this paper provides a detailed overview of the sources used, methodology and copyrights; notes on using the data are also included here. Users should refer to these notes when using the tables; all data and maps are covered by Crown Copyright or Ordnance Survey Copyright.

### ***Definitions of Unemployment***

Two sources of data are used to describe ‘unemployment’ in the UK: the claimant count and ILO unemployment. The claimant count is an administrative count of those claiming Jobseeker’s Allowance (JSA). It has the benefit of being timely, accurate, available since 2004 and for low-level geographies. The main problem with the count is that some of those looking for work and ‘unemployed’ do not, or cannot, claim JSA. The JSA claimant count is therefore an indicator of unemployment rather than a perfect measure of unemployment. The standard international measure of unemployment is ILO unemployment, a survey-based measure which captures the number of people looking for and available for work within a standard definition.<sup>6</sup> The main problem with this measure is that at a local authority and constituency level it has a time lag and is subject to sampling variability.

### ***Unemployment Rates***

Two ‘unemployment rates’ are shown in this paper:

- The ‘Library’ rate is calculated by the Library and shows the number of JSA claimants as a proportion of the estimated economically active population of working age resident in each constituency in 2008. This calculation attempts to capture the effect of differences in economic activity in constituencies and is not an official unemployment rate. It is not currently available for Northern Ireland.
- The ‘ONS’ rate shows the number of JSA claimants as a proportion of the resident working age population in 2008. It is not currently available for Northern Ireland. Rates included in PQ answers will be based on this rate.

Also shown in this paper are:

- Employment rates (based on the working age population)
- JSA claimants by age
- Jobcentre Plus vacancies.

The parties shown in the tables relate to incumbents after the General Election.

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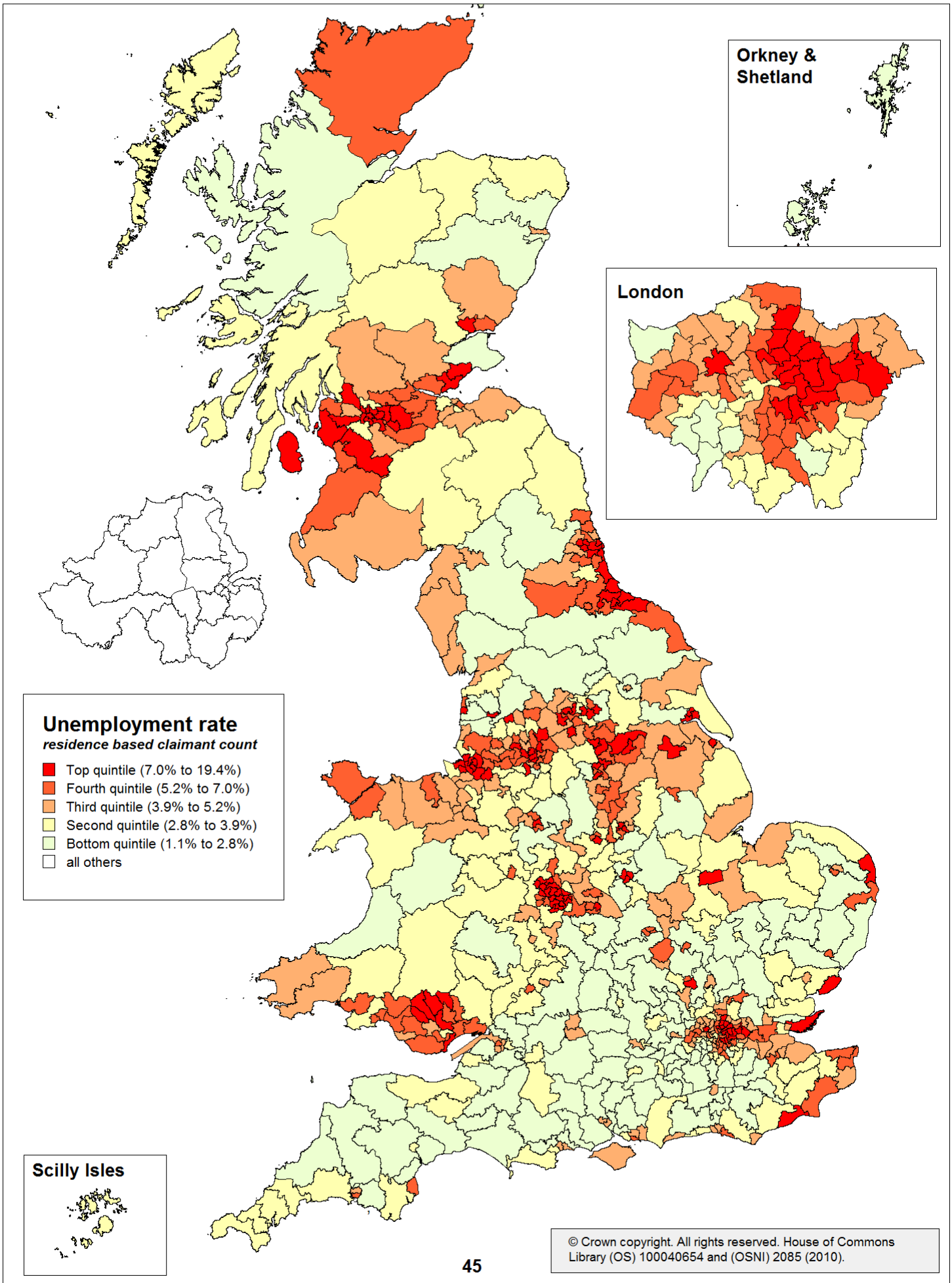

Library residence-based claimant rate, expressed as quintile groups (20% bands)

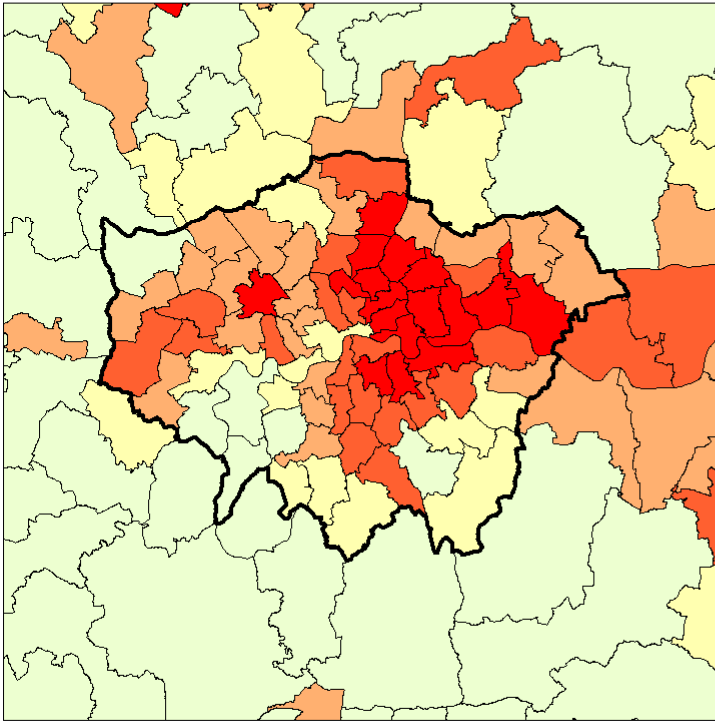

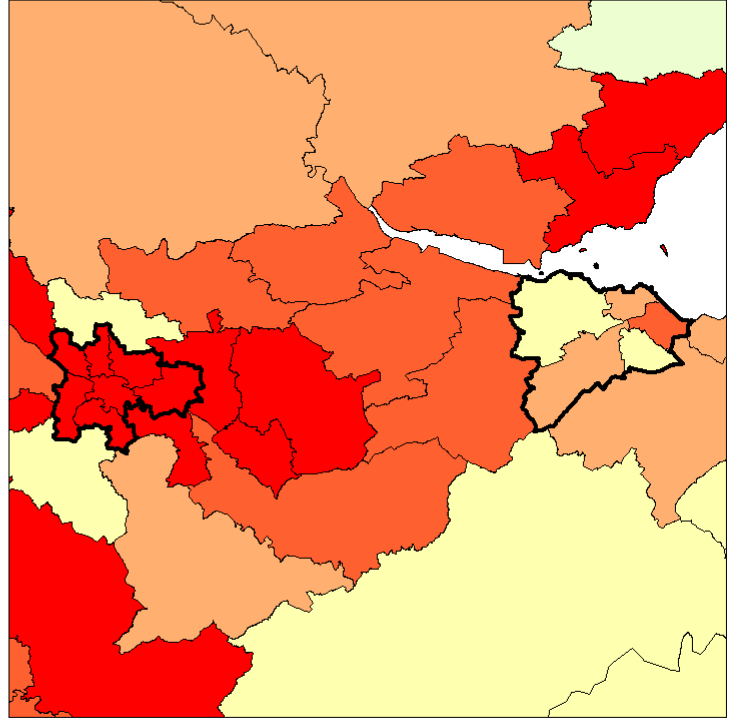

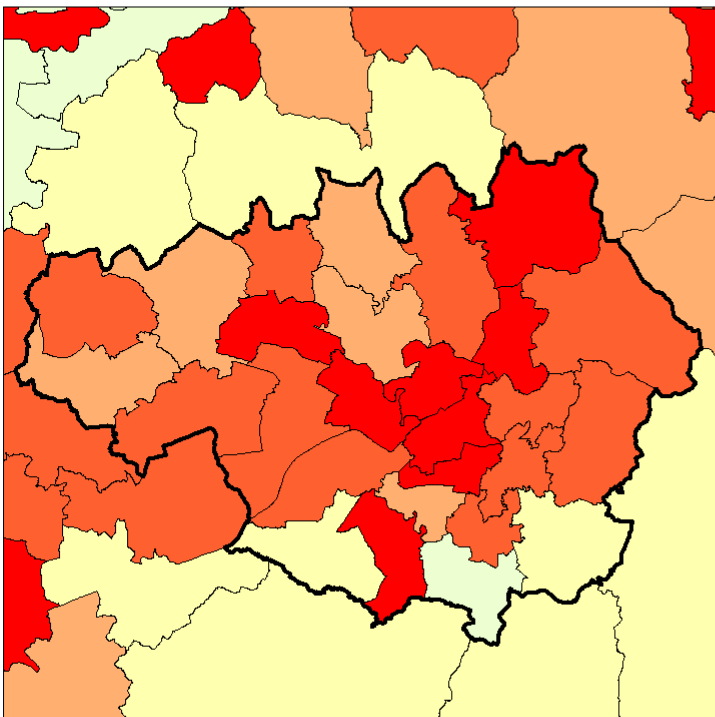

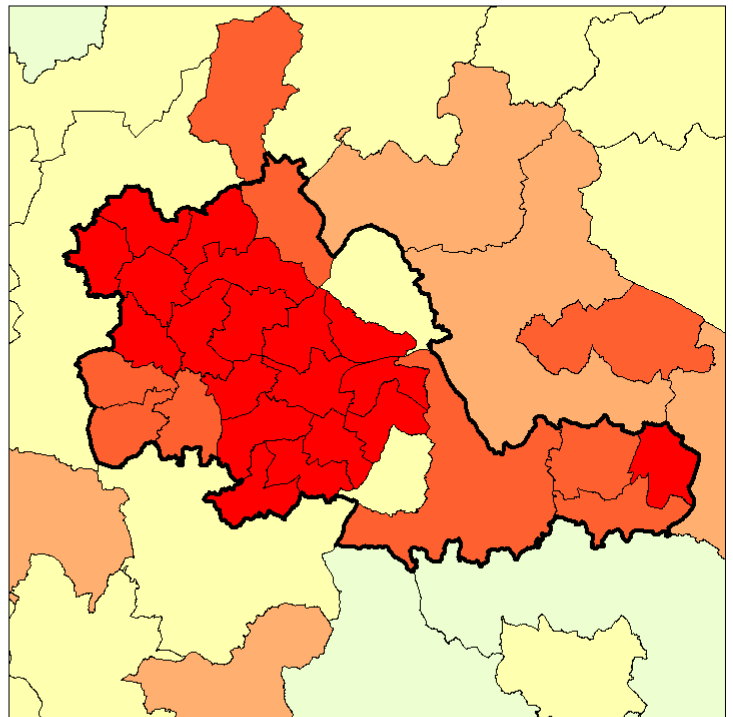

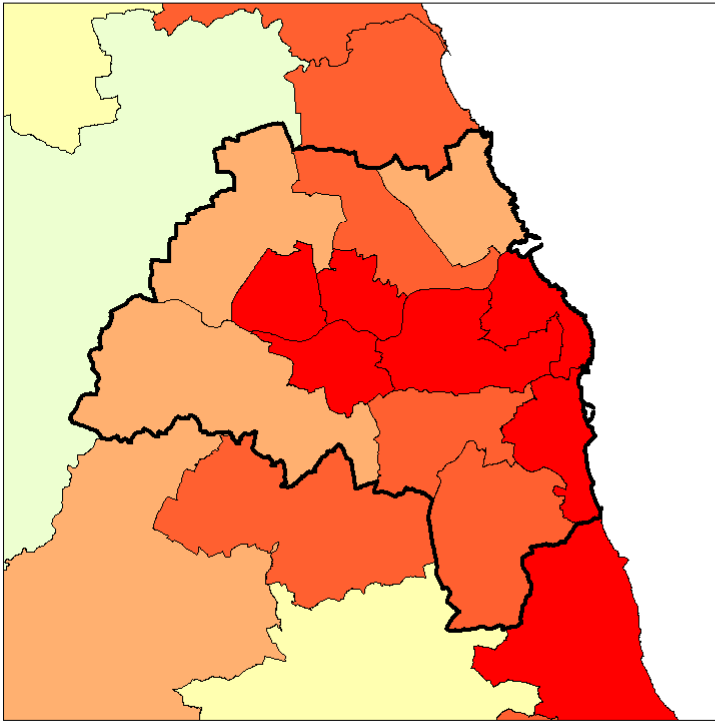

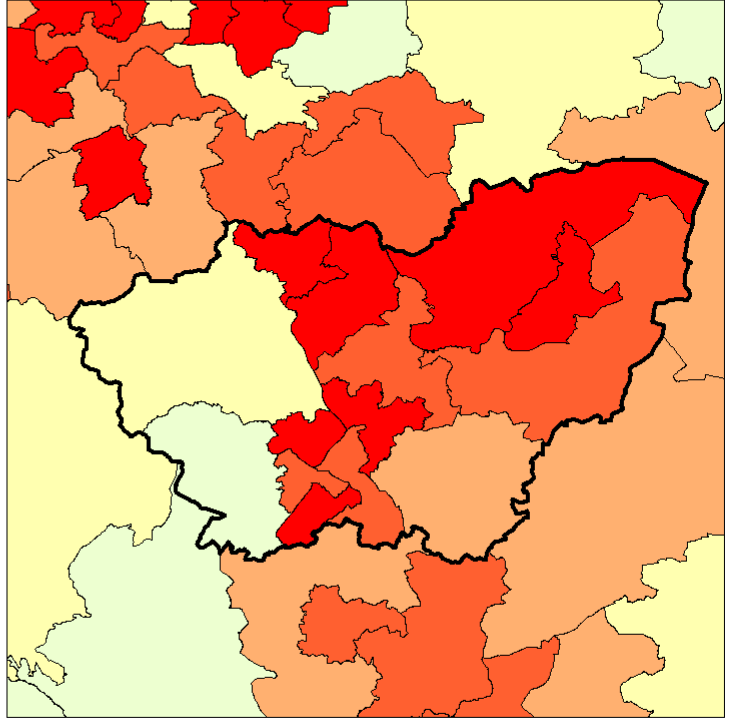

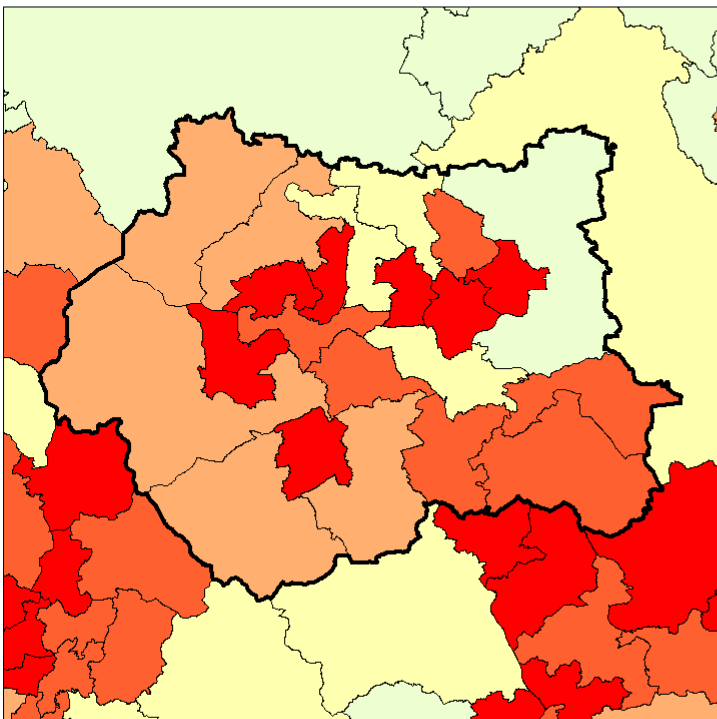

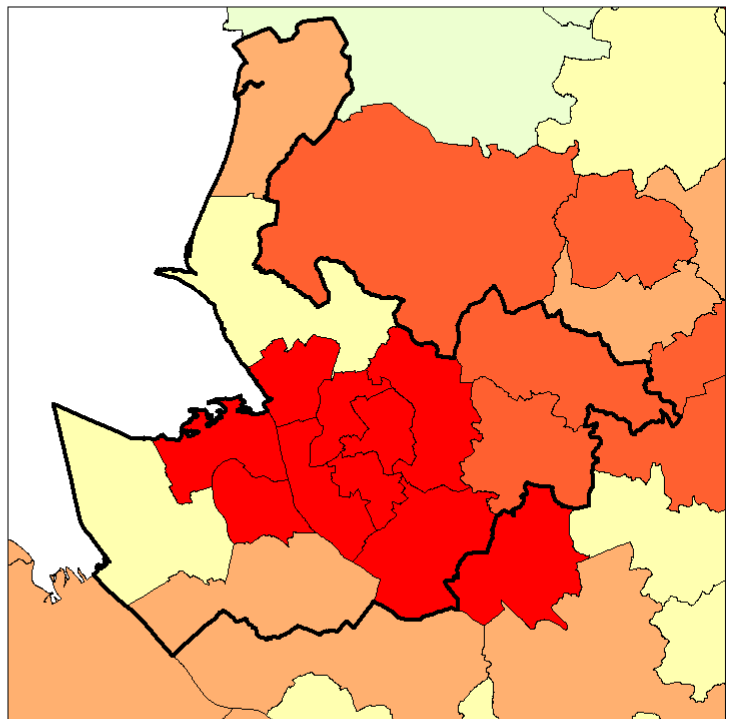

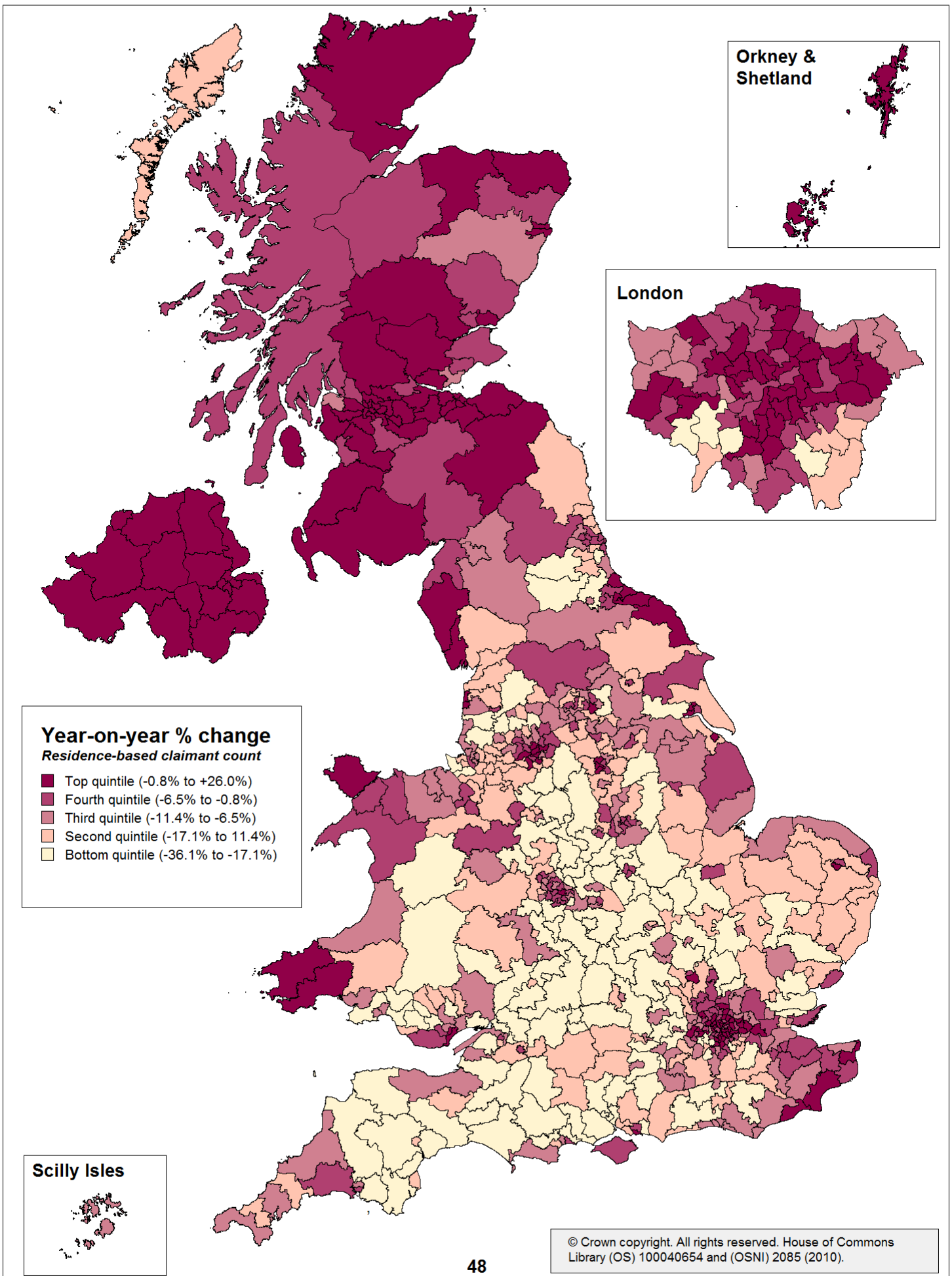

## 4 Sources, copyright and methodology

### 4.1 Sources and copyright

The original source for all data in this paper is the Office for National Statistics (ONS). Changes over time, rankings, the ratio of JSA claimants to vacancies and the 'Library rate' have been calculated by the Library. The specific source for data is shown below:

- *JSA claimant count*: non-seasonally adjusted data, downloaded from NOMIS: <https://www.nomisweb.co.uk/>. As unemployment has a seasonal pattern, comparisons should be made using the same month in each year. Data for constituencies is available from 2004 onwards.
- *Library rate* is based on the Library's estimate of the resident economically active working age population, as outlined in section 4.2. These rates are higher than the ONS rates because they are percentages of the economically active working age population rather than the whole working-age population (as used by ONS).
- *ONS Rate* is based on the resident working age population and published alongside JSA claimant count data on NOMIS.
- *Age and duration breakdowns for JSA claimants* are also available from NOMIS.
- *Employment Rate* is based on the Annual Population Survey (APS) by ONS and is available from their website.<sup>7</sup> This is a survey-based estimate and subject to sampling variability.
- *Jobcentre Plus vacancies* are available from the NOMIS website. They relate to 'live unfilled vacancies', which are vacancies notified to Jobcentre Plus and currently thought to be unfilled. A large number of vacancies are not notified to Jobcentre Plus, and the rate of notification can depend on location, occupation and industry. Data for Lincoln is affected by armed forces recruitment.

Unavailable figures are denoted in the tables by a '..'.

Claimant rates and figures on JSA claimants per vacancy are rounded to one decimal place.

The denominators used in this paper are partly derived from the 2001 Census. Census data for England and Wales are published by the Office for National Statistics. Census data for Scotland are published by the General Register Office for Scotland. Census data for Northern Ireland are published by the Northern Ireland Statistics and Research Agency. Census data are © Crown copyright.

The source of the data on claimant count and population levels contained in this publication is National Statistics (NOMIS database) © Crown copyright.

### 4.2 Unemployment rate methodology

Two 'unemployment rates' are shown in this paper. The 'ONS' rate is that published by ONS with the data and is calculated using the resident working age population in 2008 for England, Wales and Scotland. Rates included in PQ answers will be based on this rate. The

'Library' rate is calculated by the Library and shows the number of claimants as a proportion of the estimated economically active population of working age resident in each constituency in 2008.<sup>8</sup> For an exposition of the methodology used to calculate the unemployment rates displayed in this paper see Library Standard Note *Unemployment by Constituency: change in methodology*.<sup>9</sup> Rates are not currently available for Northern Ireland.

This methodology will be updated when ONS changes the definition of working age in August 2010 to take account of the change in the state pension age for women. The population estimates used will also be updated when new data is used in ONS labour market releases.

The rates presented in this paper should be regarded more as a social measure of relative deprivation than as an economic measure of the mismatch between the supply of and demand for labour, as they take no account of people's ability to seek work outside the constituency in which they live.

While the Library rates are based on the latest population estimates at a constituency level, they are constrained by the use of the proportion of the population economically active in 2001. Where constituencies have seen major demographic shifts or socio-economic change since 2001 the methodology used to calculate the rates may be less accurate in fully reflecting current unemployment rates.

### 4.3 Map notes

The following notes should be borne in mind when drawing conclusions from these maps:

- The maps on pages 45-47 show residence-based claimant count rates for June 2010 for constituencies in the United Kingdom, with an expanded view of constituencies in selected major conurbations and surrounding areas.
- The map on page 48 shows the percentage change in residence-based claimant count levels between June 2009 and June 2010 for constituencies in the United Kingdom.
- In both maps the constituencies in the United Kingdom have been divided into five equally sized bands, also known as 'quintile groups', each of which contain a fifth of the 632 GB constituencies (maps on pages 45-47) or of the 650 UK constituencies (page 48). The range in each group is shown on the map, but these ranges are not equal.
- Note also that constituencies with rates near the boundaries of these quintiles will be coloured differently even though their unemployment rates may only differ slightly from those in another, neighbouring quintile group.
- The percentage change does not take account of the absolute level of claimants by constituency. Constituencies with relatively low absolute numbers of claimants could see high percentage changes and vice versa.

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<sup>8</sup> The denominator for the rate is calculated using the proportion of the economically active working age population in the 2001 census and the estimated resident working age population in 2008. This means the rates take account of recent population change but not any changes in the economically active population. Between the first quarter of 2001 and the same period in 2008 the Labour Force Survey estimates that economic activity rose by around 0.5 percentage points for the UK overall.
