



Unemployment by Constituency, February 2012

RESEARCH PAPER 12/10 15 February 2012

This paper contains labour market figures for parliamentary constituencies, as well as a summary of the latest national and regional statistics.

The latest data show:

- The number of people claiming Jobseekers Allowance increased by 6,900 between December 2011 and January 2012 to 1.60 million people aged 18 or over.
- The wider ILO measure of unemployment was 2.67 million in October-December 2011, a rise of 48,000 from the last quarter. This total includes 1.04 million people aged 16-24.
- The number of people who are working in part-time jobs because they could not find a full-time job was 1.35 million in October-December 2011 – equal to 17.4% of all part-time workers. This is the highest level since the ONS's current series began in 1992.

1 Employment and unemployment – national

Statistics on Jobseekers Allowance (JSA) claimants are one part of a large selection of labour market data released on a monthly basis.¹ This section highlights some of the key national figures in the latest labour market release.

Unemployment

- The **number of people claiming Jobseekers Allowance** increased by 6,900 between December 2011 and January 2012 to 1.60 million people aged 18 or over.² It is 146,300 higher than in January 2011.
- The number of **men claiming Jobseekers Allowance** increased by 5,400 between December 2011 and January 2012 to reach 1.07 million and the number of **women** claimants increased by 1,500 to reach 531,700, the highest figure since 1995. Increases over the last year are in part due to an increase in the number of lone parents receiving Jobseekers Allowance, following the introduction of restrictions to income support for lone parents with older children.



- The wider **ILO measure of unemployment** was 2.67 million in the period October to December 2011, a rise of 48,000 from the last quarter. Unemployment was 179,000 higher than the same period a year ago.³
- The **unemployment rate** – the percentage of economically active people who are unemployed – was 8.4% in October to December 2011, 0.1 percentage points higher than the last quarter and 0.5 percentage points higher than a year ago. It is at its highest level since 1995.

Measuring unemployment: two sets of statistics are used to measure unemployment:

The claimant count – the number of people claiming Jobseekers Allowance. This is the most up to date information and is available for local areas.

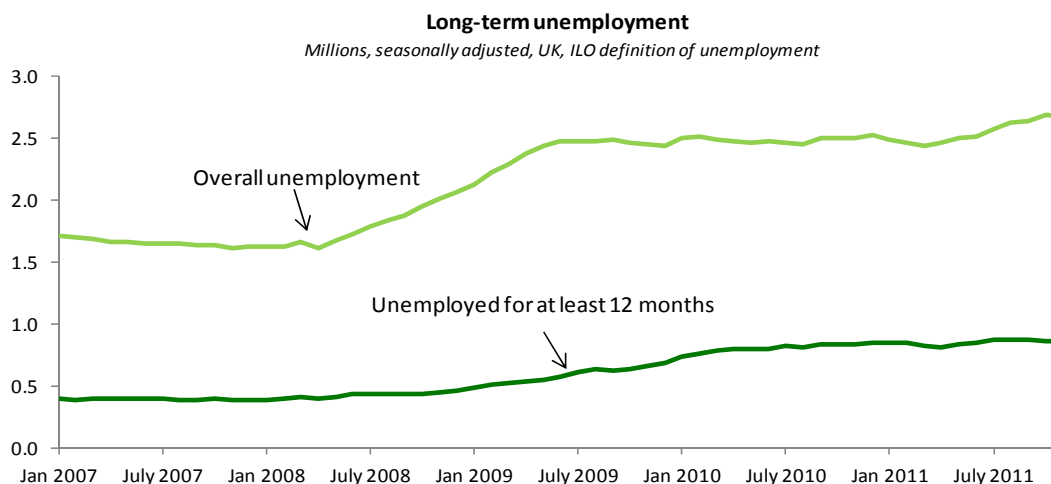
ILO unemployment – the standard international measure, which includes everyone looking for and available for work, whether or not they are claiming Jobseekers Allowance. This is measured using surveys; data for constituencies and local authorities have a time lag and are subject to more sampling variation.

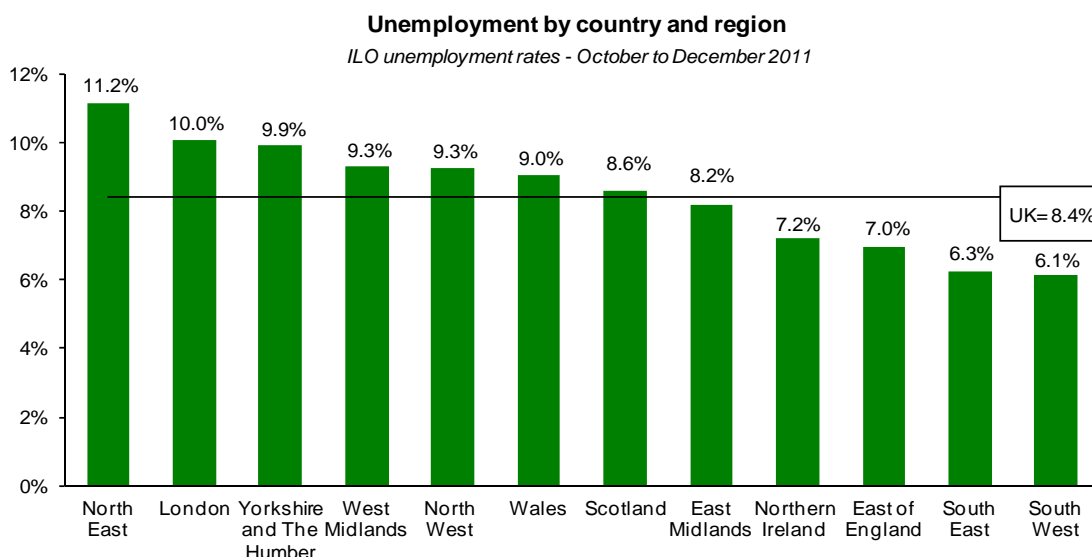
² For claimants aged 18+ and seasonally adjusted to remove the effects of changes to the claimant count that tend to happen every year. The JSA data for constituencies later in this paper are not seasonally adjusted. Section 2 looks in more detail at patterns and trends in the non-seasonally adjusted data for constituencies.

³ Much of the data in this section, such as ILO unemployment and employment, are based on estimates from the Labour Force Survey (LFS). As these are liable to sampling variability, small changes in the figures should be interpreted with caution as they may be a result of sampling error. - Unemployment rose for both **men** and **women** – for men it increased by 16,000 over the last quarter, and rose by 89,000 over the last year, reaching 1.55 million in October-December 2011. For women it increased by 32,000 over the last quarter and rose by 90,000 over the past year, reaching 1.12 million.
- In October-December 2011, 1.04 million **people aged 16-24** were unemployed, an increase of 22,000 on the previous quarter and a rise of 73,000 compared with the same quarter a year ago. The unemployment rate for those aged 16-24 is 22.2% of all economically active people in this age group – this is an increase of 0.3 percentage point on the previous quarter and a rise of 1.7 percentage points on the previous year.



- The number of people who have been **unemployed for longer than twelve months** fell by 8,000 over the last quarter and increased by 30,000 over the past year, to 860,000 in October-December 2011.



- On a **country and regional** basis the highest rates of unemployment were in the North East (11.2%) and London (10.0%) in October-December 2011. Over the last year the greatest rise in the ILO unemployment rate was in the North West (up 1.6 percentage points). Northern Ireland saw the largest year-on-year fall in the unemployment rate (down 0.8 percentage points).

Employment

- The **number of people in employment** increased by 60,000 over the last quarter and by 7,000 over the last year, to 29.13 million in October-December 2011. The **employment rate** for those aged 16-64 was 70.3%, up 0.1 percentage points from the last quarter and down 0.2 percentage points from a year ago.
- The number of **employees** increased by 65,000 in the last quarter but decreased by 79,000 over the last year, to 24.85 million in October-December 2011. The number of **self-employed** people decreased by 10,000 in the last quarter but rose by 101,000 in the last year to 4.08 million.
- Over the last quarter, **full-time employment** fell by 10,000 to 21.26 million in October-December 2011 and **part-time employment** increased by 71,000 to stand at 7.87 million. Compared to the same quarter one year ago, full-time employment rose by 52,000 while part-time employment decreased by 46,000. The number of people who are working **in part-time jobs because they could not find a full-time job** was 1.35 million – equal to 17.4% of all part-time workers – the highest level since the ONS's current series began in 1992.
- The number of people in **temporary employment** increased by 37,000 over the last quarter and by 8,000 over the last year, to reach 1.55 million or 6.2% of all employees in October-December 2011. 38.9% were doing temporary work because they could not find a permanent job.
- **Employment among UK nationals** fell by 166,000 over the last year, to 26.61m in October to December, while **employment among non-UK nationals** increased by 166,000, to 2.58m. Employment rates – the proportion of adults aged 16-64 who are employed – showed a slightly different picture, with the employment rates for UK nationals falling by 0.1 percentage points to 70.8%, while the employment rate for non-UK nationals fell by 0.5 percentage points to 67.4%. Note that, unlike the rest of the data in this section, the figures in this paragraph are not seasonally adjusted.

Inactivity

- In the period October-December 2011, 9.29 million (or 23.1% of) people aged 16-64 were **economically inactive**, a fall of 78,000 on the previous quarter and 73,000 compared with the same quarter a year ago. The quarterly fall was partly due to a change in the number of people who were inactive due to being long-term sick – currently 2.11m, the lowest figure since 1995.

Vacancies

- There were 476,000 job vacancies in the three months to January 2012, up 11,000 from the last quarter and down 21,000 from a year ago.

Earnings

- Average weekly **total pay** rose by 2.0% in the period October-December 2011 in Great Britain compared with the same period a year ago; bonus pay was up by 5.4%, while regular pay (which excludes bonuses) increased by 2.0%.
- Average weekly total **pay in the private sector** rose by 2.3% in the period October-December 2011, while average weekly total **pay in the public sector** excluding financial services rose by 1.1% compared with the same period a year ago and average weekly total pay in the public sector including financial services rose by 1.7%.

2 Analysis and maps of unemployment for constituencies

Statistics on Jobseekers Allowance (JSA) claimants are released monthly for each constituency. Unlike the national figures presented earlier in this paper, these figures are not seasonally adjusted and so show changes to the claimant count that tend to happen every year.

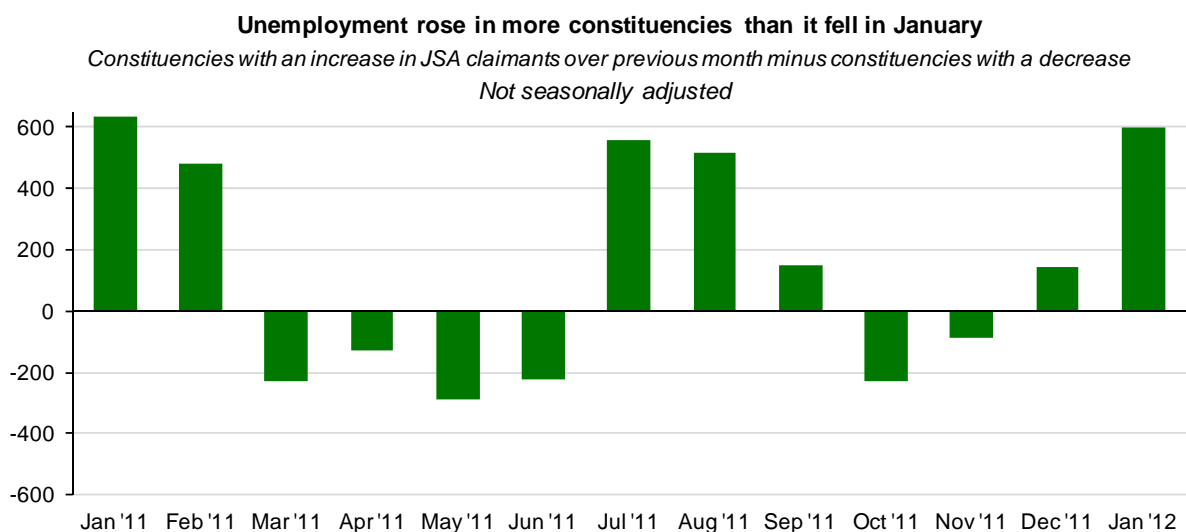
On this non-seasonally adjusted basis, the number of people in the UK claiming Jobseekers Allowance in January 2011 was up 5.1% on the previous month and up 9.6% on the previous year.⁴

The tables in Section 3 show figures for each constituency on this basis, along with figures for countries and regions (at the end of each of the tables).

Rises and falls for constituencies

Over the last year, between January 2011 and January 2012, 586 constituencies (90%) saw a rise in the claimant count level, while 63 (10%) recorded a fall. Over the last month, between December 2011 and January 2012, 625 constituencies (96%) recorded a rise; whereas 25 constituencies (4%) saw a fall.

The chart below shows the balance of constituencies that have experienced an increase or decrease in the claimant count over each month in the past year.



3 Maps

The following pages contain maps showing how the claimant count varies across the UK. The first map shows the areas which have the highest proportion of economically active people claiming Jobseekers Allowance – these include much of South Wales, east London, the North East and Northern Ireland.

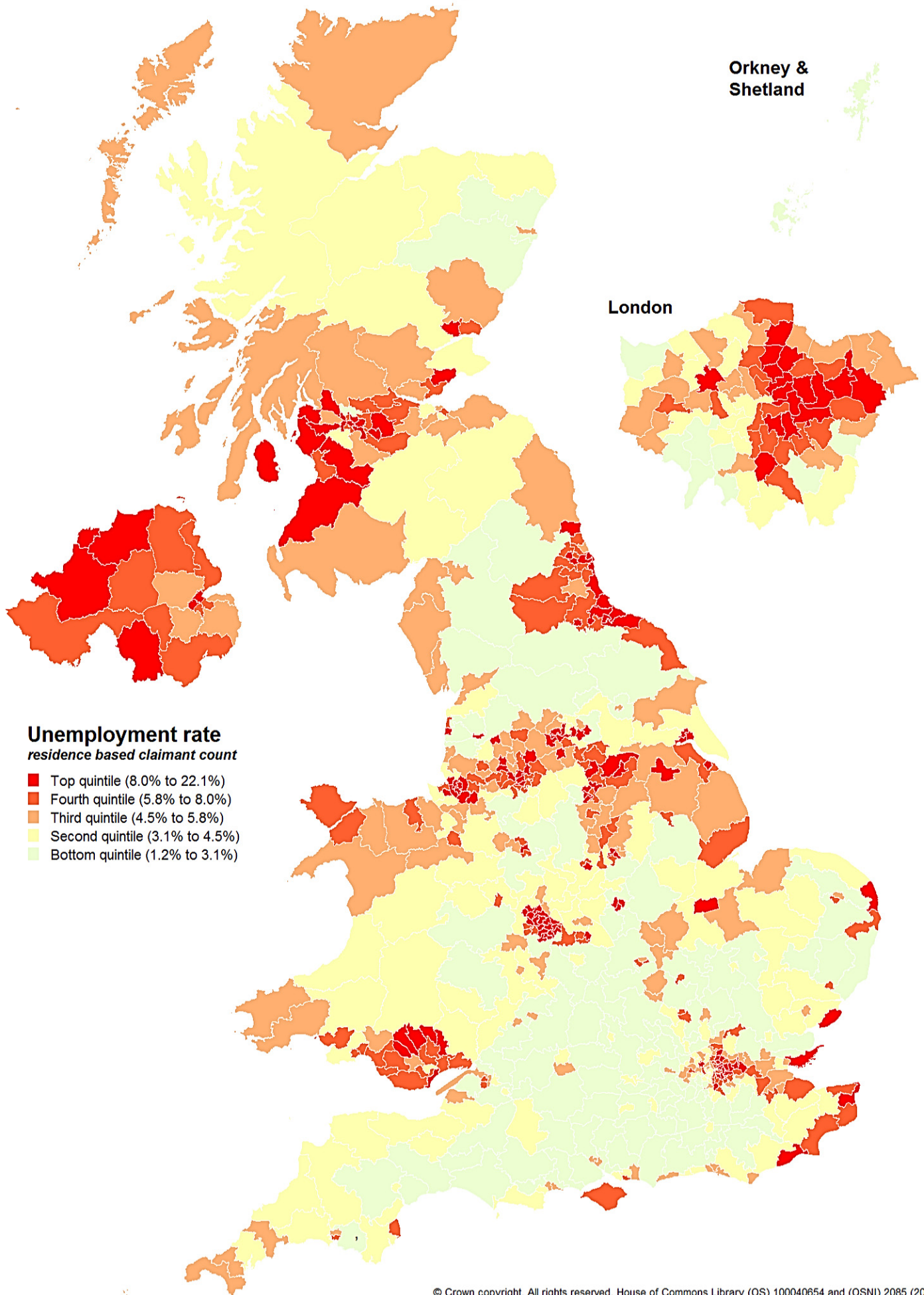
The second map of the UK shows how the number of people claiming Jobseekers Allowance in each constituency has changed over the last year. A large majority of constituencies have seen a rise over the past year. Areas with the smallest rises (or even falls) include Scotland, Northern Ireland and central parts of southern England. The areas with the largest rises are scattered across England and Wales.

Library residence-based claimant rate, expressed as quintile groups (20% bands)

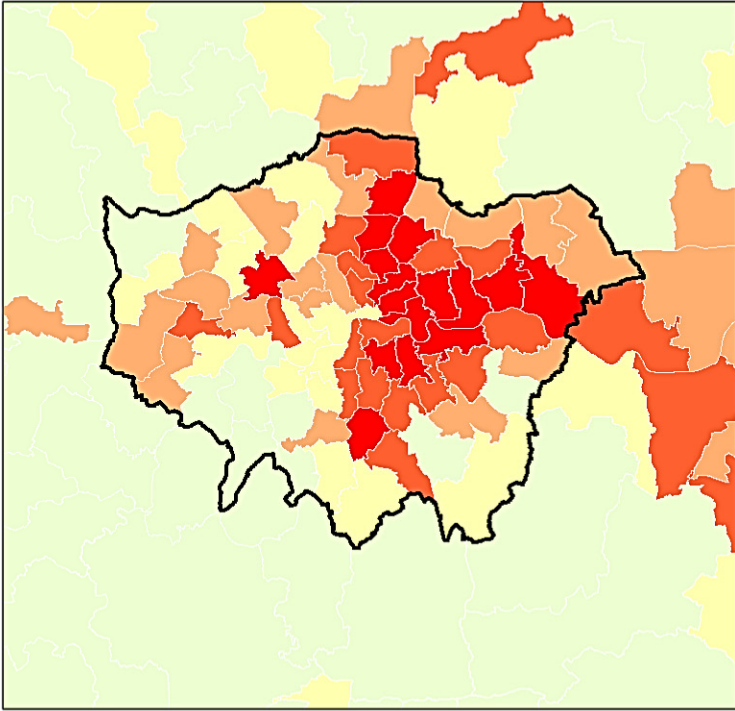


Unemployment by constituency in January 2012

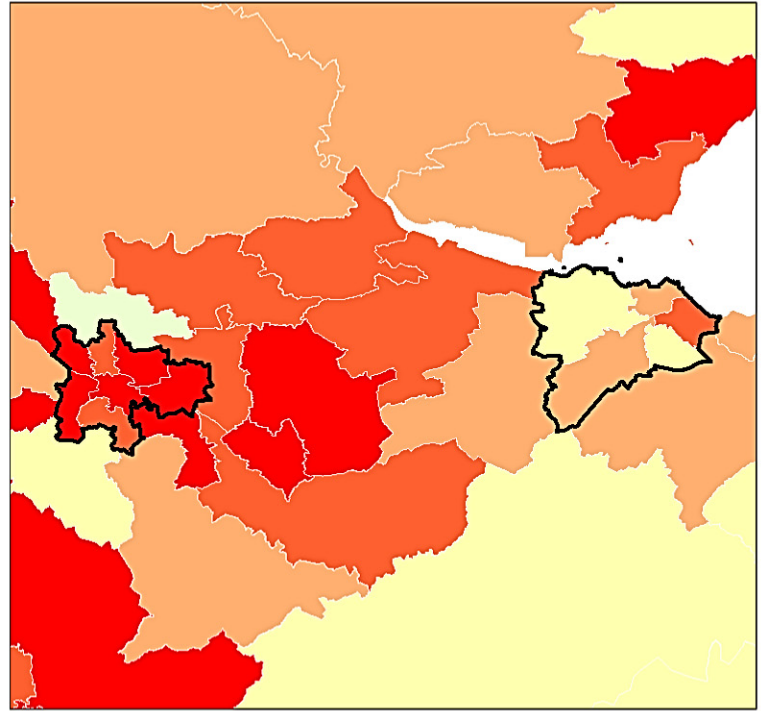

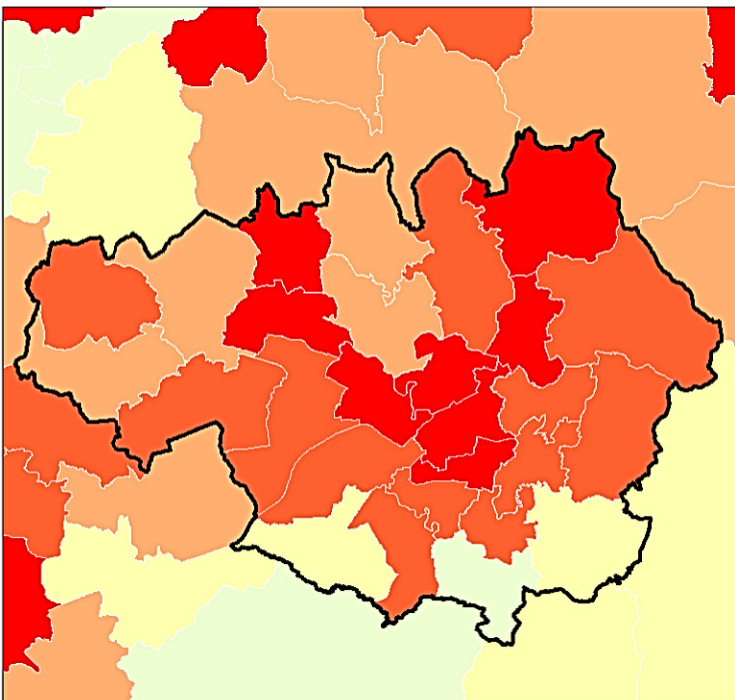

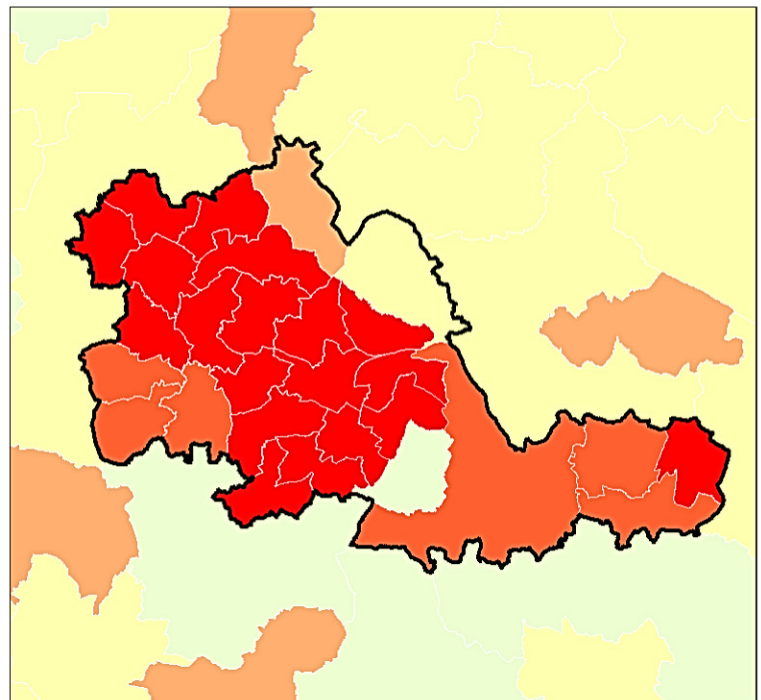

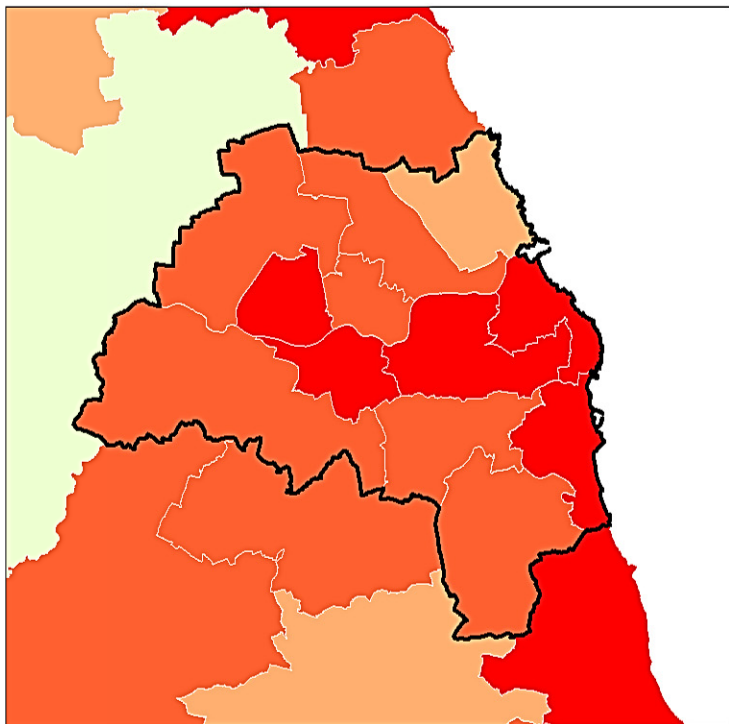


Unemployment by constituency in January 2012

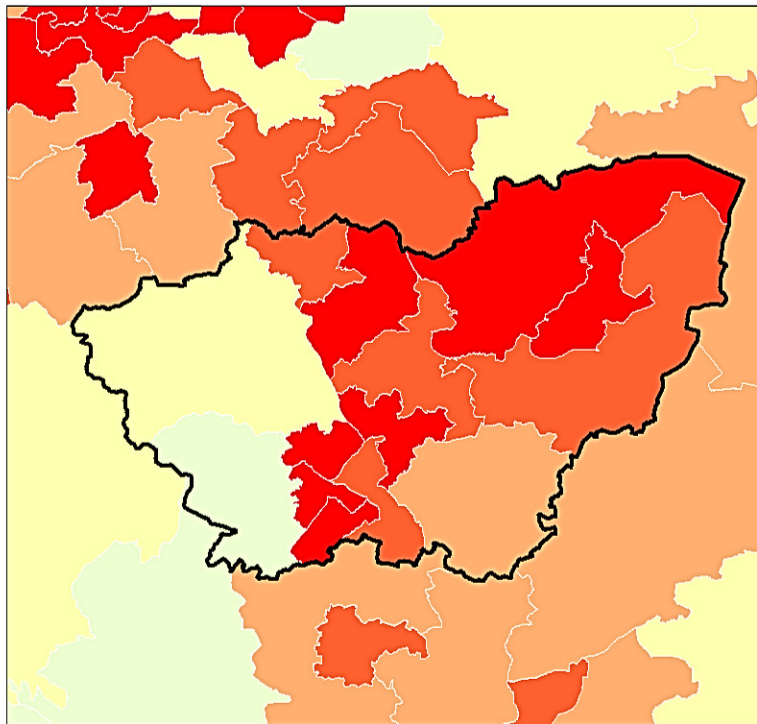

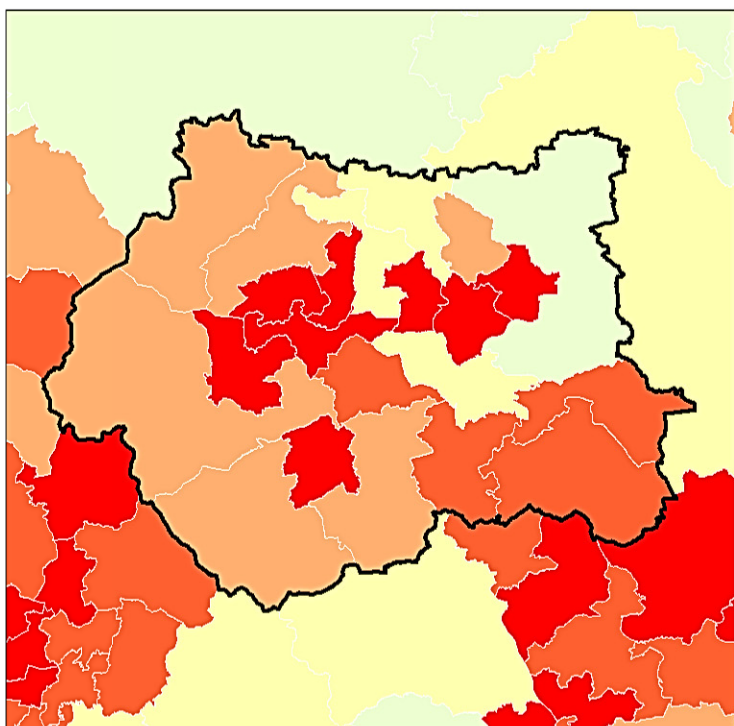

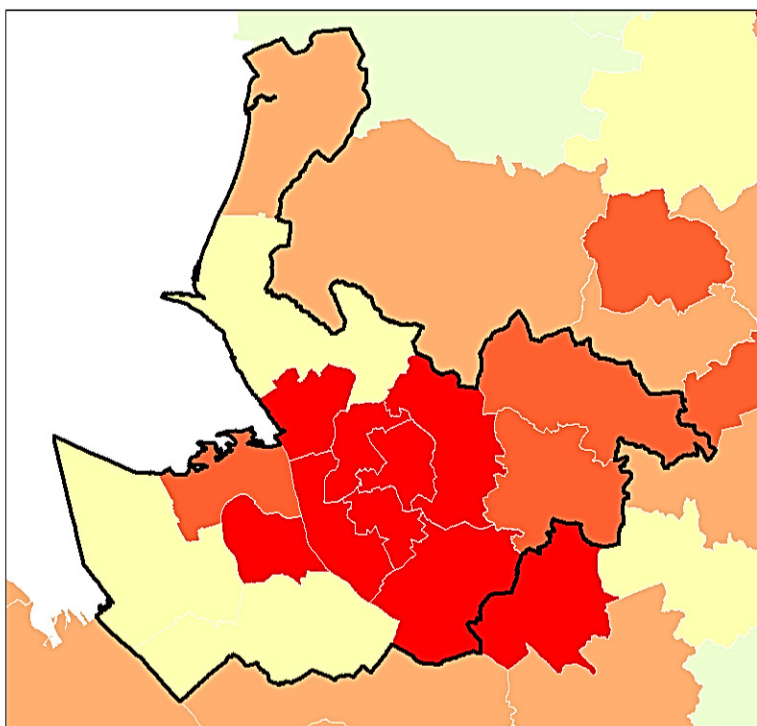

Percentage change in residence-based claimant count, expressed as quintile groups (20% bands)

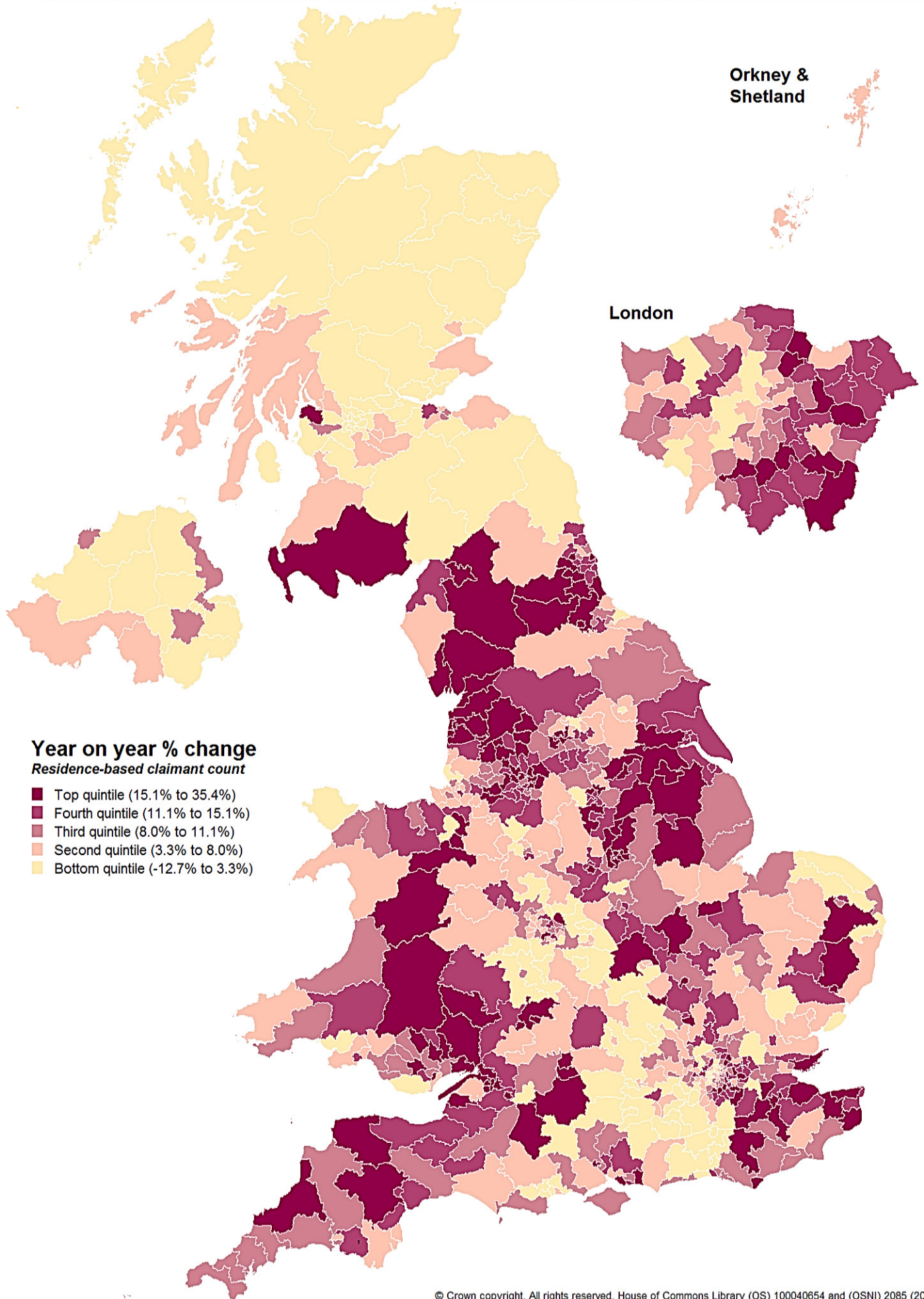

The original source for all data in this paper is the Office for National Statistics (ONS). Changes over time, rankings, the ratio of JSA claimants to vacancies and the 'Library rate' have been calculated by the Library. The specific source for data is shown below:

- JSA claimant count: non-seasonally adjusted data, downloaded from NOMIS: <https://www.nomisweb.co.uk/>. As unemployment has a seasonal pattern, comparisons should be made using the same month in each year. Data for constituencies is available from 2004 onwards.
- Library rate is based on the Library's estimate of the resident economically active population aged 16 to 64, as outlined in section 4.2. These rates are higher than the ONS rates because they are percentages of the *economically active* population in this age range rather than the whole population in the age range (as used by ONS).
- *ONS Rate* is based on the resident population aged 16 to 64 and published alongside JSA claimant count data on NOMIS.
- *Age and duration breakdowns for JSA claimants* are also available from NOMIS.
- *Employment Rate* is based on the Annual Population Survey (APS) by ONS and is available from their website.⁵ This is a survey-based estimate and subject to sampling variability.
- *Jobcentre Plus vacancies* are available from the NOMIS website. They relate to 'live unfilled vacancies', which are vacancies notified to Jobcentre Plus and currently thought to be unfilled. A large number of vacancies are not notified to Jobcentre Plus, and the rate of notification can depend on location, occupation and industry. Data for Lincoln is affected by armed forces recruitment.

Unavailable figures are denoted in the tables by a '..'.

Claimant rates and figures on JSA claimants per vacancy are rounded to one decimal place.

The denominators used in this paper are partly derived from the 2001 Census. Census data for England and Wales are published by the Office for National Statistics. Census data for Scotland are published by the General Register Office for Scotland. Census data for Northern Ireland are published by the Northern Ireland Statistics and Research Agency. Census data are © Crown copyright.

The source of the data on claimant count and population levels contained in this publication is National Statistics (NOMIS database) © Crown copyright.

4.2 Unemployment rate methodology

Two 'unemployment rates' are shown in this paper. The 'ONS' rate is that published by ONS with the data and is calculated using the resident population aged 16 to 64 in 2008. Rates included in PQ answers will be based on this rate. The 'Library' rate is calculated by the Library and shows the number of claimants as a proportion of the estimated economically active population aged 16 to 64 resident in each constituency in 2008.⁶ For an exposition of the methodology used, see Library Standard Note *Unemployment by Constituency: change in methodology*.⁷

This methodology was updated as of the August 2010 edition when ONS changed the definition of working age to take account of the change in the state pension age for women. For an explanation of the shift away from the working-age population to the population aged 16 to 64, see Library Standard Note *Unemployment by Constituency: changes to working-age rates*.⁸

The rates presented in this paper should be regarded more as a social measure of relative deprivation than as an economic measure of the mismatch between the supply of and demand for labour, as they take no account of people's ability to seek work outside the constituency in which they live.

While the Library rates are based on the latest population estimates at a constituency level, they are constrained by the use of the proportion of the population economically active in 2001. Where constituencies have seen major demographic shifts or socio-economic change since 2001 the methodology used to calculate the rates may be less accurate in fully reflecting current unemployment rates.

4.3 Notes and abbreviations

The following notes should be borne in mind when drawing conclusions from these maps:

- The maps on pages 9-11 show residence-based claimant count rates for January 2012 for constituencies in the United Kingdom, with an expanded view of constituencies in selected major conurbations and surrounding areas.
- The map on page 12 shows the percentage change in residence-based claimant count levels between January 2011 and January 2012 for constituencies in the United Kingdom.
- In both maps the constituencies in the United Kingdom have been divided into five equally sized bands, also known as 'quintile groups', each of which contain approximately 129 constituencies (20% of the total in the United Kingdom). The range in each group is shown on the map, but these ranges are not equal.
- Note also that constituencies with rates near the boundaries of these quintiles will be coloured differently even though their unemployment rates may only differ slightly from those in another, neighbouring quintile group.

⁶ The denominator for the rate is calculated using the proportion of the economically active population aged 16 to 64 in the 2001 census and the estimated resident population aged 16 to 64 in 2008. This means the rates take account of recent population change but not any changes in the economically active population. Between the first quarter of 2001 and the same period in 2008 the Labour Force Survey estimates that economic activity rose by around 0.5 percentage points for the UK overall.

- Considering the percentage change does not take account of the absolute level of claimants by constituency. Constituencies with relatively low absolute numbers of claimants could see high percentage changes and vice versa.
