



Unemployment by Constituency, April 2012

RESEARCH PAPER 12/17 18 April 2012

This paper contains labour market figures for parliamentary constituencies, as well as a summary of the latest national and regional statistics.

The latest data show:

- The number of people claiming Jobseekers Allowance increased by 3,600 between February and March 2012 to 1.61 million people aged 18 or over.
- The wider ILO measure of unemployment was 2.65 million in the period December-February 2012, a decrease of 35,000 from the last quarter – the first quarterly fall since the three months to May 2011.
- The number of people who have been unemployed for longer than twelve months increased by 26,000 over the last quarter, to 883,000 in December-February 2012 – this is the highest figure since 1996.

Unemployment by Constituency is published every month, on the same day that the Office for National Statistics publish new data on the labour market (a Wednesday in the middle of the month).

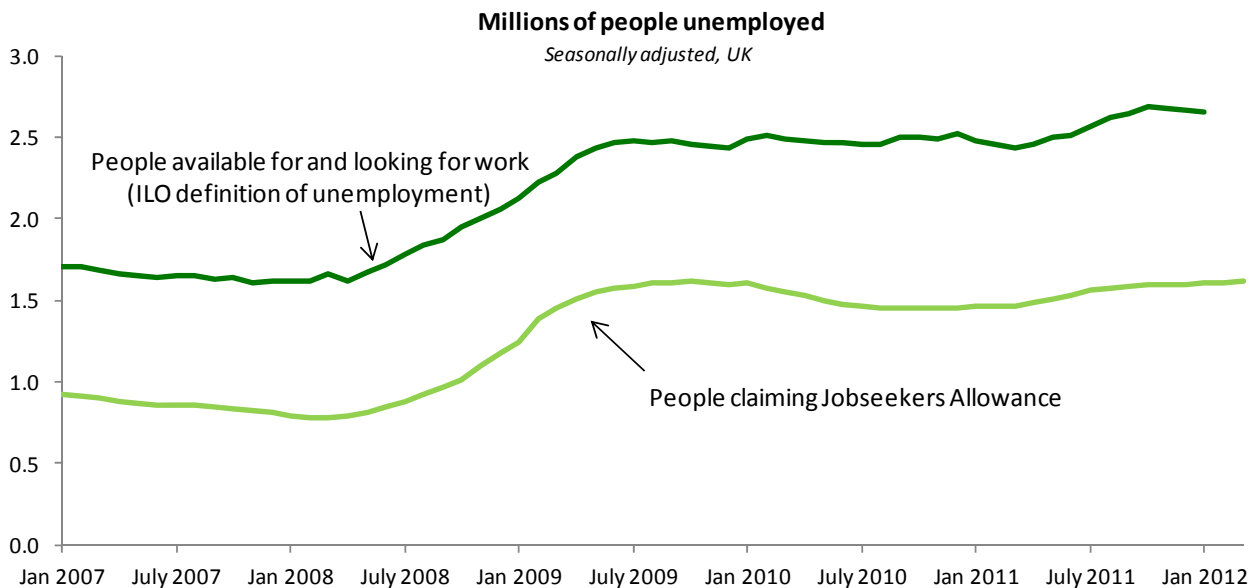

1 Employment and unemployment – national

Statistics on Jobseekers Allowance (JSA) claimants are one part of a large selection of labour market data released on a monthly basis.¹ This section highlights some of the key national figures in the latest labour market release.

Unemployment

- The **number of people claiming JSA** increased by 3,600 between February and March 2012 to 1.61 million people aged 18 or over.² It is 145,200 higher than in March 2011.
- The number of **men claiming JSA** increased by 4,000 between February and March 2012 to reach 1.08 million. The number of **women** claimants decreased by 400 to reach 529,400.



- The wider **ILO measure of unemployment** was 2.65 million in the period December-February 2012, a decrease of 35,000 from the last quarter, the first quarterly fall since the three months to May 2011. Unemployment was 172,000 higher than the same period a year ago.³
- The **unemployment rate** – the percentage of economically active people who are unemployed – was 8.3% in December-February 2012, 0.1 percentage points lower than the last quarter but 0.5 percentage points higher than a year ago.
- Unemployment fell for men by 43,000 over the last quarter, but rose by 72,000 over the last year, reaching 1.51 million in December-February 2012. For women it increased by 8,000 over the last quarter and rose by 100,000 over the past year, reaching 1.14 million.

Measuring unemployment: two sets of statistics are used to measure unemployment:

The claimant count – the number of people claiming Jobseekers Allowance. This is the most up to date information and is available for local areas.

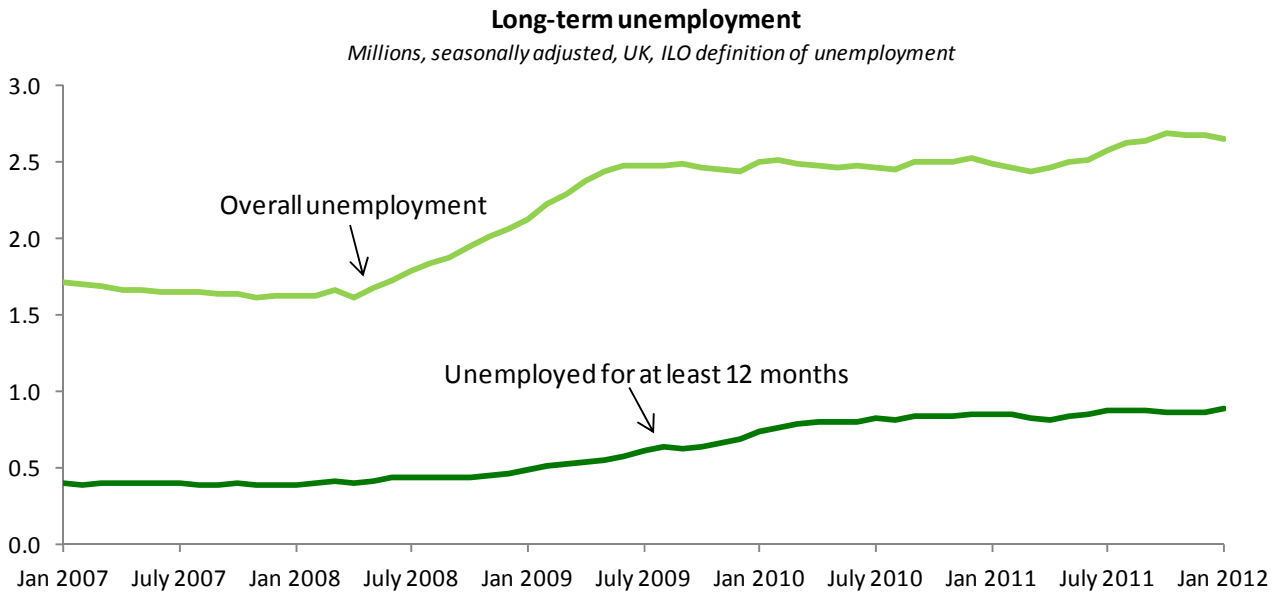
ILO unemployment – the standard international measure, which includes everyone looking for and available for work, whether or not they are claiming Jobseekers Allowance. This is measured using surveys; data for constituencies and local authorities have a time lag and are subject to more sampling variation.

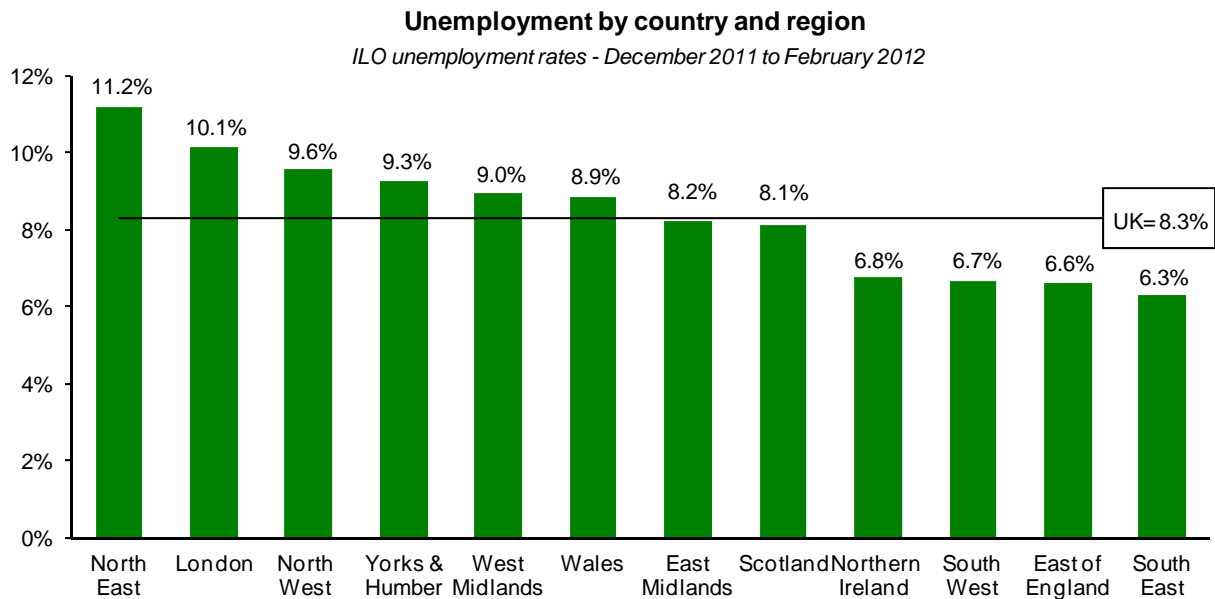
² For claimants aged 18+ and seasonally adjusted to remove the effects of changes to the claimant count that tend to happen every year. The JSA data for constituencies later in this paper are not seasonally adjusted. Section 2 looks in more detail at patterns and trends in the non-seasonally adjusted data for constituencies.

³ Much of the data in this section, such as ILO unemployment and employment, are based on estimates from the Labour Force Survey (LFS). As these are liable to sampling variability, small changes in the figures should be interpreted with caution as they may be a result of sampling error. - In December-February 2012, 1.03 million **people aged 16-24** were unemployed, a fall of 9,000 on the previous quarter but a rise of 74,000 compared with the same quarter a year ago. The unemployment rate for those aged 16-24 is 22.2% of all economically active people in this age group – this is a decrease of 0.1 percentage point on the previous quarter but an increase rise of 1.8 percentage points on the previous year.



- The number of people who have been **unemployed for longer than twelve months** increased by 26,000 over the last quarter and rose by 38,000 over the past year, to 883,000 in December-February 2012. This is the highest figure since 1996.



- On a **country and regional** basis the highest rates of unemployment were in the North East (11.2%) and London (10.1%) in December-February 2012. Over the last year the greatest rise in the ILO unemployment rate was in the North West (up 1.7 percentage points). The West Midlands saw the largest year-on-year fall in the unemployment rate (down 0.7 percentage points).

Employment

- The **number of people in employment** increased by 53,000 over the last quarter but fell by 57,000 over the last year, to 29.17 million in December-February 2012. The **employment rate** for those aged 16-64 was 70.4%, up 0.1 percentage points from the last quarter but down 0.3 percentage points from a year before.
- Over the last quarter, **full-time employment** fell by 27,000 to 21.23 million in December-February 2012 and **part-time employment** increased by 80,000 to stand at 7.94 million. Compared to the same quarter one year ago, full-time employment decreased by 68,000 while part-time employment increased by 11,000. The number of people who are working in **part-time jobs because they could not find a full-time job** was 1.40 million – equal to 18.0% of all part-time workers – the highest level since the ONS's current series began in 1992.
- Over the last quarter the number of **temporary employees** increased by 22,000, and over the last year it increased by 10,000, to reach 1.57 million in December-February 2012. Of these temporary employees, 627,000, or 39.8%, were **working in temporary posts because they could not find a permanent job** – the highest percentage since the beginning of 1997.

Inactivity

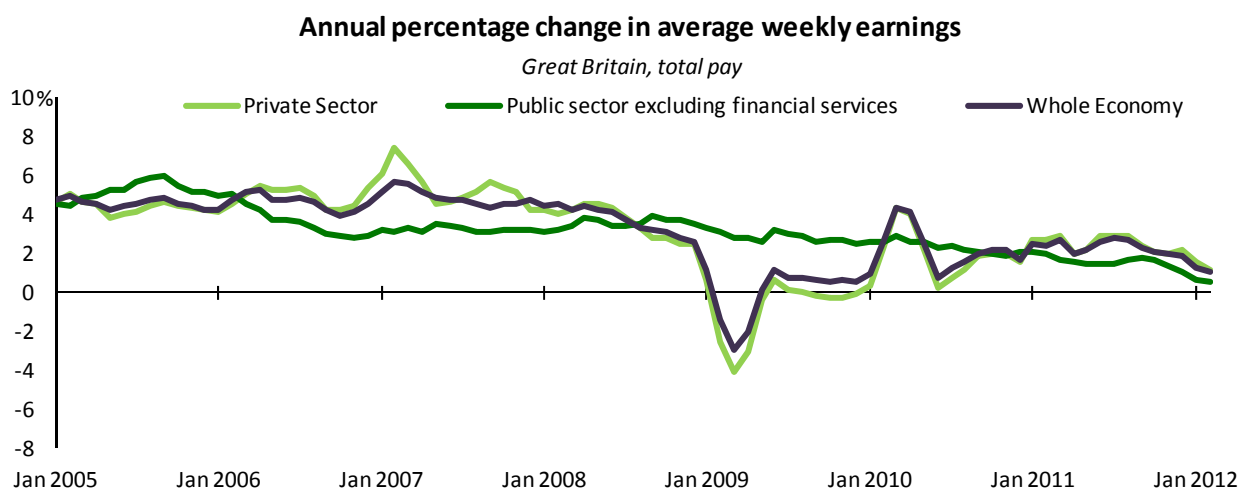
- In the period December-February 2012, 9.27 million (or 23.1% of) people aged 16-64 were **economically inactive**, a fall of 25,000 on the previous quarter and a fall of 29,000 compared with the same quarter a year ago.

Vacancies

- There were 464,000 job vacancies in the three months to March 2012, the same as the previous quarter but down 19,000 from a year before.

Earnings

- Average weekly **total pay** rose by 1.1% in the period December-February 2012 in Great Britain compared with the same period a year ago; bonus pay was down by 6.2%, while regular pay (which excludes bonuses) increased by 1.6%.
- Average weekly total **pay in the private sector** rose by 1.2% in the period December-February 2012 compared with the same period a year ago. In the **public sector excluding financial services** pay rose by 0.6%, while in the public sector including financial services it rose by 1.1% - both the smallest rates of increase since the series began in 2001.



2 Analysis and maps of unemployment for constituencies

Statistics on Jobseekers Allowance (JSA) claimants are released monthly for each constituency. Unlike the national figures presented earlier in this paper, these figures are not seasonally adjusted and so reflect changes to the claimant count that tend to happen every year.

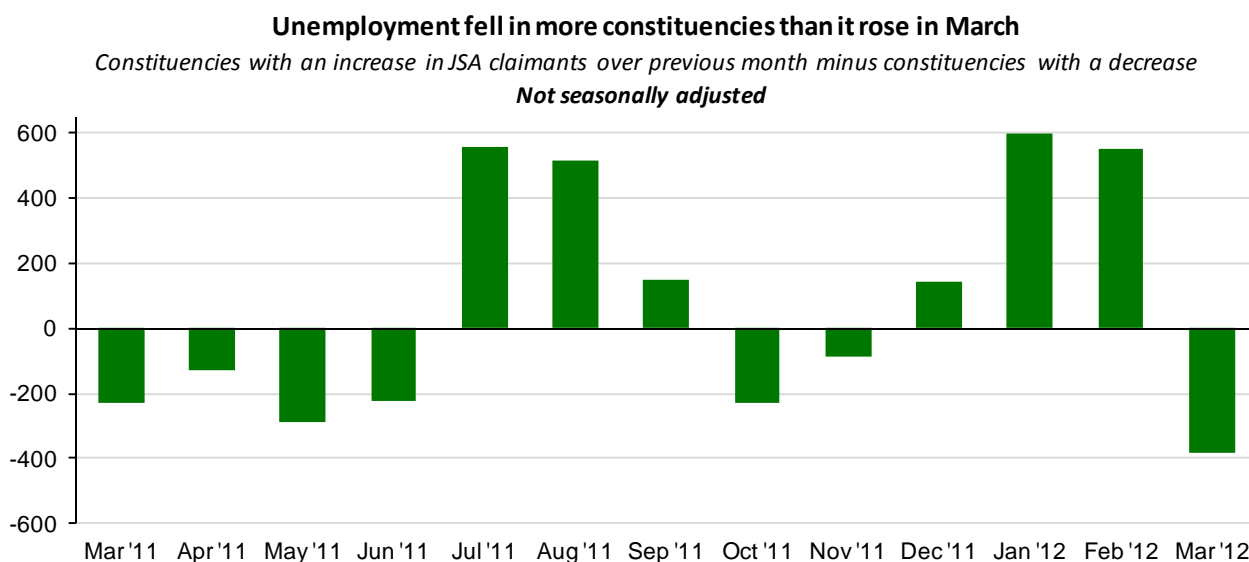
On this non-seasonally adjusted basis, the number of people in the UK claiming Jobseekers Allowance in March 2012 was down 1.1% on the previous month and up 9.2% on the previous year.⁴

The tables in Section 3 show figures for each constituency on this basis, along with figures for countries and regions (at the end of each of the tables).

Rises and falls for constituencies

Over the last year, between March 2011 and March 2012, 593 constituencies (91%) saw a rise in the claimant count level, while 55 (8%) recorded a fall. Over the last month, between February and March 2012, 123 constituencies (20%) recorded a rise; whereas 515 constituencies (79%) saw a fall.

The chart below shows the balance of constituencies that have experienced an increase or decrease in the claimant count over each month in the past year.



3 Maps

The following pages contain maps showing how the claimant count varies across the UK. The first map shows the areas which have the highest proportion of economically active people claiming Jobseekers Allowance – these include parts of the north of England, Birmingham, east London and Northern Ireland.

The second map of the UK shows how the number of people claiming Jobseekers Allowance in each constituency has changed over the last year. Most of the constituencies with the highest rises are scattered across England and Wales.
