## I Introduction

By the end of October 1998, the Department of Culture, Media and Sport's database of National Lottery Awards held information on some 31,693 awards made by the eleven National Lottery distributing bodies since January 1995. The total value of these awards was around £5.1 billion.

This paper looks at the distribution of awards by region and constituency using data supplied to the Department of Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS) by the eleven distributing bodies.

Awards made have been allocated to individual regions and constituencies mainly on the basis of the postal address of the recipient body. In some cases this does not correspond with the ultimate location of the project. Also, a number of awards are of benefit to a far wider area than the constituency and region to which they have been allocated. For example, awards to bodies based in London include many institutions that are considered of national importance and are of benefit to the country as a whole. The DCMS have in the past estimated that awards to these organisations account for around 60% of the total awarded to London.<sup>1</sup>

Over the entire period of the current lottery licence, around 28% of the value of ticket sales will be paid into the National Lottery Distribution Fund (NLDF). Until 8 October 1997, each of the five 'good causes'<sup>2</sup> received a fifth of all money raised. From 8 October 1997, a new 'good cause' was introduced, the New Opportunities Fund (NOF). This fund will receive  $13\frac{1}{3}$  per cent of the money allocated to the NLDF. Awards made from the NOF are not included in this paper. The Millennium Commission will still receive 20% and the other four original 'good causes' will receive  $16\frac{2}{3}$  per cent. The Millennium Commission will cease to be allocated money from the NLDF once its allocation has reached £2,017 million and its share will go to the New Opportunities Fund.<sup>3</sup>

Table 1 shows the number and value of awards by distributing body for awards on the Department's database at the end of October 1998.

Tables 2 to 6 show the number and value of awards broken down by 'good cause' and region. In terms of the number of awards allocated to UK regions, the North East, the South West, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland had a greater number per capita than the UK as a whole (Tables 2 and 5). The value of awards per capita in London was, at

£153.60, more than double that for the UK as a whole (Tables 3 and 6). The average value of award was also greatest in London (Table 4).

Tables 9 to 11 show the number and value of awards by constituency and good cause. Table 9 shows the 25 constituencies with the highest number and value of awards. Cities of London and Westminster has received both the highest number and highest value of awards with 301 awards worth £375.9 million. Billericay has received the lowest number of awards with just 5, while Upminster has received the lowest value of awards with £230,000 compared with a constituency average of £7.6 million. Tables 10 and 11 show the number and value of awards respectively for each constituency, along with a ranking.
