



## Council Tax 2010/11

This note contains key statistics on council tax levels in 2010/11 and a limited amount of analysis is provided. The main purpose of this note is to act as a reference document although more detailed analysis is available on request.

On 24 March 2010 the Department for Communities and Local Government (DCLG) released a comprehensive list of the levels of council tax charged by each local authority in England for 2010/11.

The Welsh Assembly Government released similar information for Wales the following day. As of yet the Scottish Executive has not published its council tax data, although it is known that all Scottish local authorities are freezing their council tax for 2010/11.

## 1 Introduction

The council tax was introduced as the primary source of collecting income from local residents by local authorities in England, Wales and Scotland in April 1993. This system replaced the Community Charge, which had in turn replaced Domestic Rating in April 1990.

There are 380 billing authorities in Great Britain responsible for collecting council tax to meet their own demands and the precepts levied by the lower tier Parish or Community Councils and higher tier County Councils, Joint Boards, Police and Fire Authorities.

The number of billing authorities in 2010/11 is lower than the 408 in 2008/09 due to the reorganisation of local authorities. Nine new unitary authorities were established for 2009/10 replacing seven county and councils and 37 shire districts. A unitary authority was established for each of the five counties of Cornwall, Durham, Northumberland, Shropshire and Wiltshire, while two unitary authorities replaced the existing councils in Cheshire and two replaced those in Bedfordshire.

Under Part 4 of the Local Government (Structural Changes) (Finance) Regulations 2008<sup>1</sup> the new authorities were given the flexibility to set separate basic amounts of council tax in each of their predecessor areas (shire districts), under the following conditions:

- the unitary authority must ensure that the Band D amount is the same across the whole of its area no later than 1 April 2014.
- for each financial year, the difference between the highest Band D amount levied and the other levies in the area, must be less than the difference in the previous year;
- once an area's Band D amount equals that of the highest amount, no further divergence is allowed.

Central Bedfordshire, Shropshire and Wiltshire authorities decided to set the basic amount of council tax under Part 4 of the regulations, so as to equalise its council tax for all predecessor areas over more than one year.

The following table shows the property price range of each council tax band and the total number of chargeable dwellings in each band. There are eight valuation bands in England and Scotland and nine in Wales. Band I was introduced in Wales in April 2005 following the revaluation of domestic properties.

Local authorities set council tax levels by dividing the amount of money they aim to raise by the Band D equivalent taxbase. The taxbase is calculated by weighting the number of dwellings in each band by the ratio to Band D. The bills in each band are calculated according to a set ratio to band D.<sup>2</sup>

The average Band D level of council tax is usually used for comparisons of tax levels set. It is, according to the DCLG, a definition that is widely regarded as a benchmark when comparing council tax levels in different areas or over time.<sup>3</sup> It compares the level of tax paid by households in similarly valued properties.

As only a minority of properties in each local authority are in Band D, 15% in England, this measure does not show the average amounts of council tax payable by people in different areas. Figures showing the average council tax per dwelling in each LA are also published.

In different local authority areas the mix of dwellings may be significantly different to the national average giving rise to overall average bills which may vary considerably from the band D average. For example in Nottingham, where 92% of all chargeable dwellings were valued in bands A to C, the average band D bill was £1,562 compared with the average per dwelling of £991.

In general the council tax levels in this note include, where appropriate, the average of all the parish precepts levied across the entire area. In areas where parish precepts are levied the council tax levels are therefore not necessarily the actual levels that a household in that area will be billed.

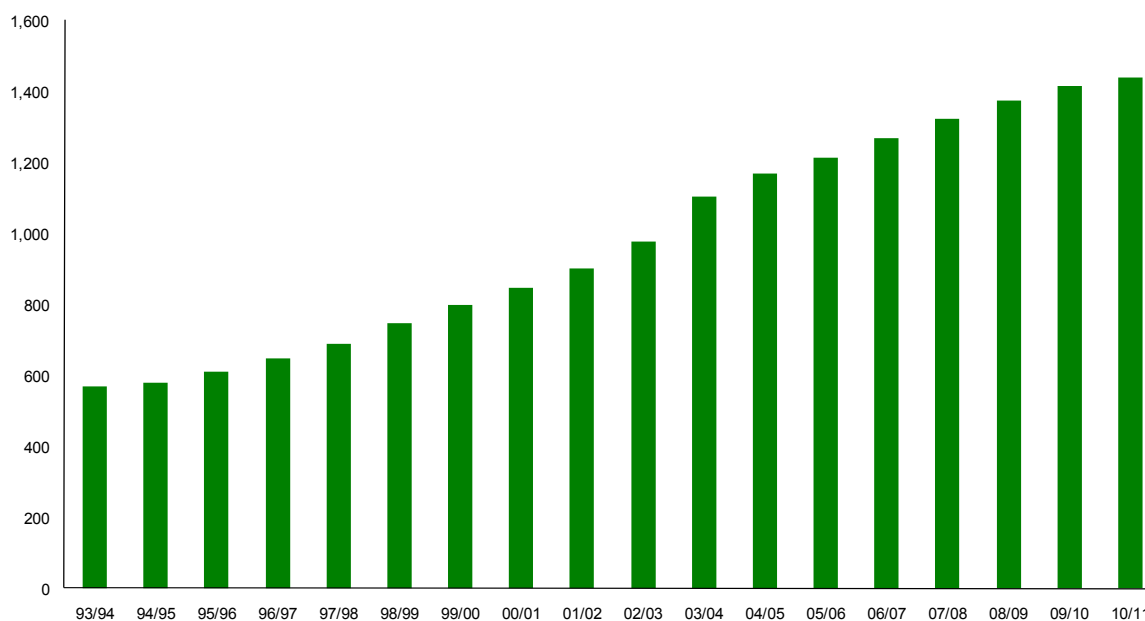

## 2 The national picture

### 2.1 England

The average council tax bill in England per dwelling was £1,195 in 2010/11 compared with £1,175 in 2009/10, an increase of 1.7%. Average council tax per dwelling was significantly less than the average for a band D dwelling as two-thirds of dwellings were in bands A-C. The average for a band D household was £1,439, compared with £1,414 in 2009/10, an average increase in council tax of 1.8%.

**Average band D Council Tax, England, £**



Average band D council taxes were £1,309 in London, £1,399 in other English metropolitan areas and £1,484 in English shire areas.

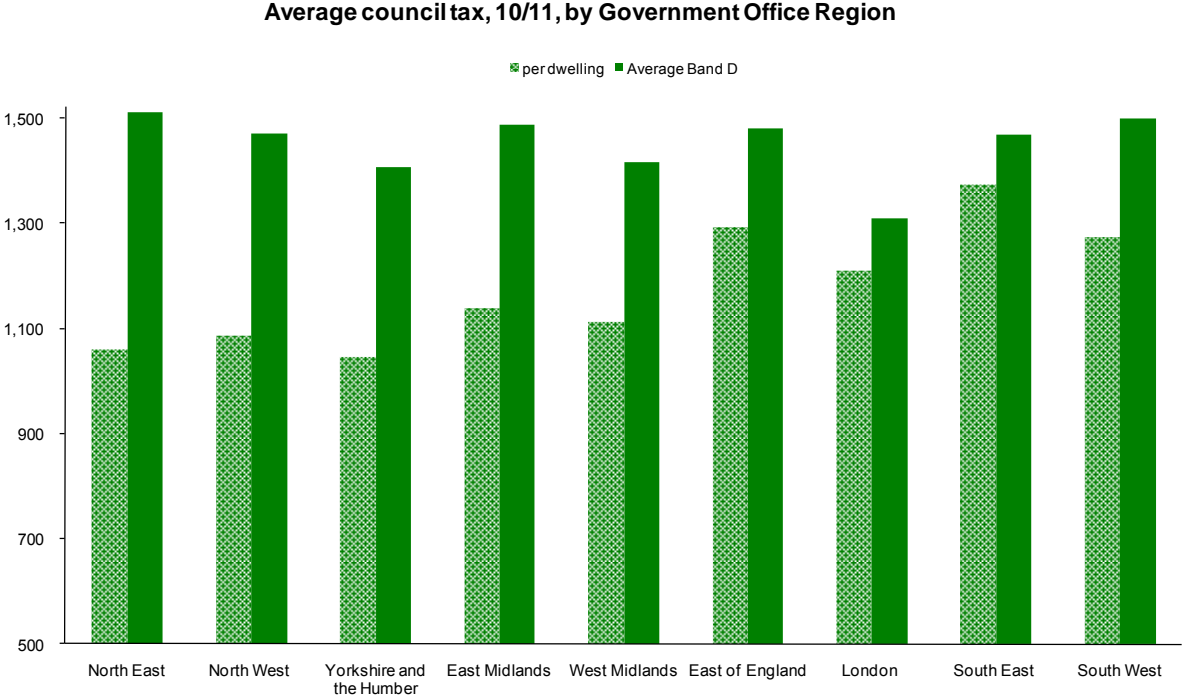

Council Tax Demands and Precepts Statistics, CIPFA

The average band D council tax in the North East (£1,511) was higher than in any other Government Office Region (GOR), while London had the lowest average Band D rate (£1,309). The average council tax per dwelling varied from £1,374 in the South East to £1,046 in Yorkshire and Humber. The following chart shows the average Band D and per dwelling council tax figures for each English GOR.



The following table shows the average Band D tax level by political control of authority. Political control is defined as a party having a majority of councillors after the local elections held in June 2009. In practice a party may control the LA with less than half of the councillors, as members from other parties may vote with the largest party. However for these purposes an authority where the largest party doesn't have a majority of councillors is considered to be under No Overall Control (NOC).

Due to the fact that some averages have been calculated from very few observations it is hard to draw firm conclusions, however the figures suggest:

- Amongst metropolitan districts, band D bills were highest in the average Lib Dem LA and lowest in NOC ones. The largest annual percentage increases occurred in the average Conservative LA.
- Average band D council tax bills in London were highest amongst Lib Dem LAs and lowest in Conservative run councils.
- The average Labour controlled council set the highest bills for unitary authorities. Similar levels were set by councils under Lib Dem control.
- Shire district bills were highest in NOC areas and lowest in Conservative controlled LAs.
- All but one county council is Conservative controlled.

The next table shows the average tax level per dwelling by political control of authority. In general terms Labour controlled LAs have lower bills per dwelling than those controlled by other parties.

- Amongst metropolitan districts, bills were lowest in the average Labour LA, with Conservative LAs charging the highest levels.
- Average council tax bills in London were highest amongst Lib Dem LAs and lowest in Labour run councils.
- The average Conservative controlled council set the highest bills for unitary authorities while the lowest were set by Labour run UAs.
- Shire district bills were higher in NOC, Lib Dem and Conservative controlled areas.



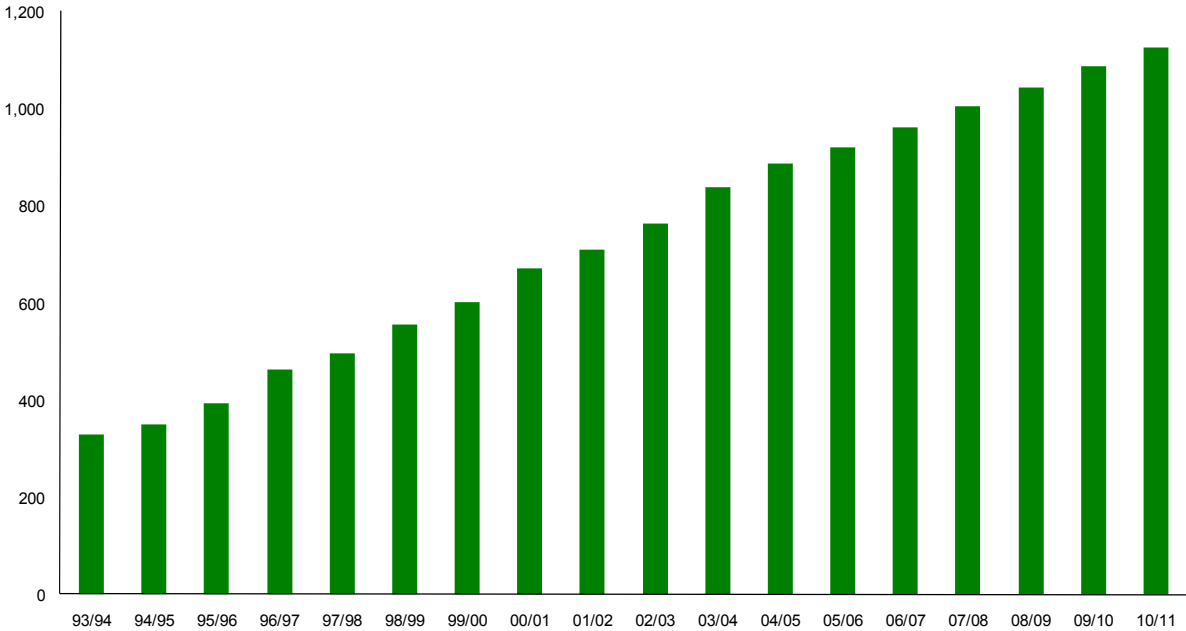
**2.2 Wales**

The 2005/06 council tax bills in Wales were the first to be issued since the revaluation of Welsh domestic properties by the Valuation Office Agency. The revised list of valuations came into force on 1 April 2005.

The issue of council tax revaluation in Wales is discussed in the Library note [Council tax revaluation in Scotland and Wales](#) (SN/PC/3659). The note includes reaction to the revaluation and an evaluation of its effects.

In Wales the average band D council tax for 2010/11 was £1,127. This included £927 for local services (county and community council precepts) and £175 for police authorities. The increase in average band D council tax was 3.6%.

**Average band D Council Tax, Wales, £**



Pembrokeshire authority billed the lowest band D council tax in 2010/11 (£895), this was followed by Newport (£957). The highest council tax was charged in Blaenau Gwent (£1,382) with Neath Port Talbot (£1,343) the next highest. 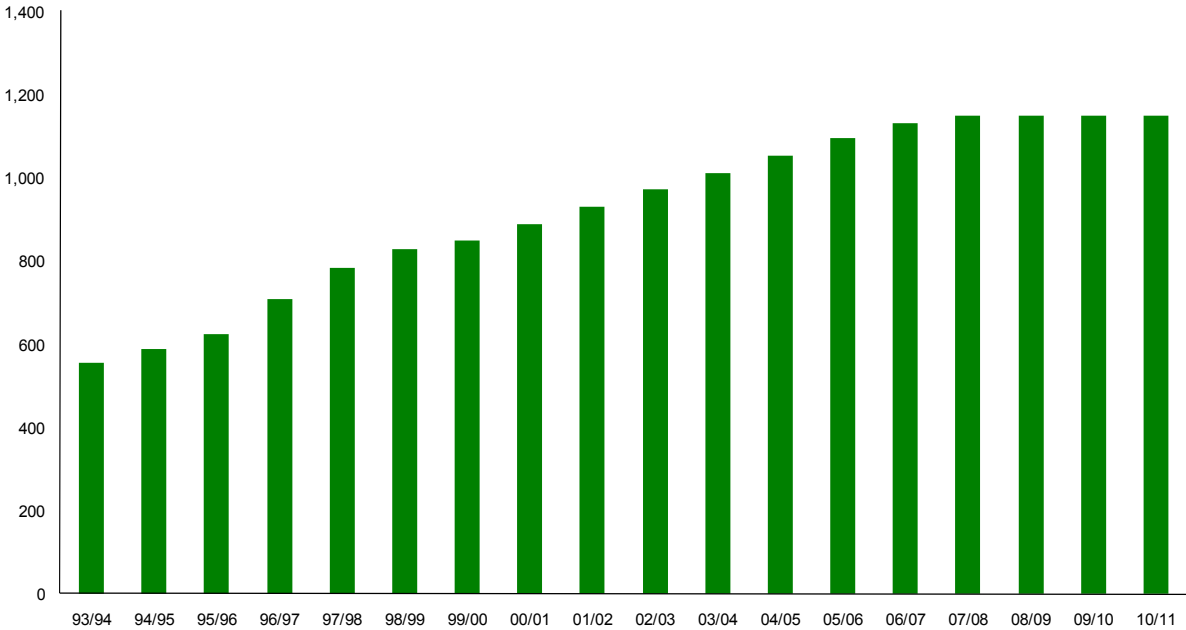
**2.3 Scotland**

Council tax levels in Scotland were frozen by all of the 32 councils in 2010/11.

In four local authority areas council tax levels have been unchanged since 2006/07: Angus, Midlothian, Dundee and Glasgow. In Glasgow council tax levels have not been changed since 2005/06.

The chart below shows the average level of band D council tax in Scotland in each year since the introduction of the system in 1993/94. The average band D council tax bill in Scotland was £1,149 in 2010/11 and the average per dwelling £987.

The highest level of band D council tax was charged in Aberdeen (£1,230) and the lowest billing authority was Eilean Siar (£1,024). See appendix 6 for historical information on the average Band D council tax levels of each billing local authority in Scotland.

### 3 The local picture in Great Britain

The following table shows the 20 billing authorities with the highest levels of average band D council tax in 2010/11. These are the levels billed by the authorities and include all precepts. Only six of the high-billing authorities were single-tier authorities with the remaining 14 two-tier shire authorities.

Rutland, (Conservative controlled unitary) had the highest levels of average band D council tax. Of these twenty billing authorities eight were Conservative controlled, six were NOC, three were Lib Dem, two were Labour and the remaining one was controlled by councillors with no links to the main political parties.

Five of the billing authorities in the list below are districts in Conservative controlled Nottinghamshire county council. The combined county council and fire authority precepts in Nottinghamshire were the highest amongst English shire counties.

The following table shows those billing authorities with the lowest levels of average band D council tax in 2010/11. These are the levels charged by the billing authorities and include all precepts.

Wandsworth and Westminster (both Con) had the lowest levels of average band D council tax. Of these twenty authorities, all single-tier, 11 were Scottish and six Welsh unitary authorities. Four of the authorities were Conservative controlled, one was Labour controlled and 9 had no overall control. The remaining six authorities were represented by councillors not affiliated to a mainstream political party.

The table below shows those billing authorities that had the highest increases in average band D council tax between 2009/10 and 2010/11.

The Labour controlled metropolitan district of Knowsley has seen the highest increases in average council tax levels. Of the 20 authorities where council tax levels have increased the most, five had NOC, four were Conservative controlled, three were Labour controlled and two were under Lib Dem control. The remaining six authorities were represented by councillors not affiliated to a mainstream political party. The Isles of Scilly is represented by councillors that had no political affiliation. 14 of the billing authorities with the highest increases were Welsh local authorities.

The following table shows those English and Welsh billing authorities that had no change or decreases in average band D council tax between 2009/10 and 2010/11. The Scottish authorities have been excluded from this table as all 32 froze their council tax at 2008/09 levels.

Council tax decreased in six authorities (four Conservative and two NOC), the greatest decrease being in Windsor & Maidenhead (-4.2%). London boroughs dominate the list below as the GLA precept has been frozen at the 2009/10 level.

## 4 Capping

Capping is a mechanism by which the Government may limit the budgets of councils and other local authorities (i.e. police authorities and fire and civil defence authorities). It works in most cases by specifying a maximum increase for an authority's budget where the authority is spending above the level specified by the Government. It does not simply specify a maximum increase or level of council tax, and where an authority is spending below its standard budget, a larger increase in council tax may be possible within the capping limits.

The Government can designate an authority – applying to the current year's budget – or nominate an authority for the following year.

Authorities that have been 'designated' for capping action are given a statutory period of 21 days to respond. The Government will then consider in the light of their responses whether to, for each authority:

- Confirm the designation and set a cap for 2010-11; and if so at what level.
- Withdraw the 'designation' and 'nominate' the authority instead; taking action either to cap them in advance for the following year (designation after nomination) or set a notional budget for the current year which restricts the scope for future increases.

In 2004/05 capping action was taken against fourteen authorities of whom six were designated and eight nominated. In 2005/06 action was taken against nine authorities and in 2006/07 against two authorities, all of whom were designated. The Government did not exercise its capping power in 2007/08. In 2008/09 capping action was taken against eight precepting authorities; one was designated, three designated after nomination and four nominated. In 2009/10 capping action was taken against two precepting authorities, one was designated and the other nominated after being designated.

The criteria used to decide which councils might be capped are the responsibility of the Secretary of State under the Local Government Act 1999.

The capping principles for 2010/11 were announced by the Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for Local Government in a statement to the House on 25 March 2010.<sup>4</sup> An authorities' 2010-11 budget requirement was deemed excessive if they set:

- a budget requirement increase of more than 3.5% between 2009/10 and 2010/11;
- and also; a Band D council tax increase of more than 4.5% over the same period.

Of the 421 precepting authorities in England subject to capping legislation 42 breached the budget requirement limit, six breached the council tax limit, of which two, Nottinghamshire and Greater Manchester police authorities breached both:

Two authorities - the police authorities of Greater Manchester and Nottinghamshire - have exceeded these principles.

The action the Government has decided to take against these authorities is to cap both in advance for 2011-12. The Government is minded to propose a maximum budget requirement ("a cap") for 2011-12 for each authority at a level which is

equivalent to a council tax increase of around 4.5 per cent for each of the financial years 2010-11 and 2011-12.

The statutory process involved is that at this stage the Secretary of State 'nominates' the authorities under section 52D of the Local Government Finance Act 1992 ("the Act") and decides whether to 'designate' them in advance for 2011-12 under section 52L of the Act. In due course, the Secretary of State will designate the authorities under section 52M of the Act and propose a cap for each authority for 2011-12.

This action means that the authorities will not need to undertake rebilling in 2010-11, but council taxpayers in those areas can be reassured that action is being taken to restrict these authorities' council tax increases in 2011-12.

My officials are writing to both authorities today to inform them of their nomination and of the Secretary of State's decision to designate them in advance for 2011-12.

However, the authorities will not be designated and informed of their proposed caps for 2011-12 until later in the year. This will be at around the same time as the provisional local government finance settlement for 2011-12 is announced. At that point, the authorities will have 21 days in which to challenge their proposed 2011-12 caps and raise any specific issues which they feel justify a different capping level. Any challenge will be carefully considered before a final decision is taken on the capping level for 2011-12.

If an authority accepts its proposed cap for 2011-12 without challenge, a notice can be issued to the authority confirming its cap. Otherwise, a draft order will be laid for the approval of the House before any 2011-12 cap can take effect.<sup>5</sup>
