The purpose of this Standard Note is to list, by series, and in chronological order within each series, all pre-1995 House of Commons Library Research briefings. Many of them are not available electronically. About 2,000 documents fall into this category.

The series [in chronological order of establishment] are: Library Bibliographies, Research Division Miscellaneous Papers, Research Division Statistical Papers, Research Division Statistical Memoranda, Library Memoranda, House of Commons Library Documents, Reference Sheets, Background Papers, Research Notes and Research Papers. One document, published in 1991, is described as a 'Standard Note', but is not part of the current series with that title. All Research Papers published from 1995 are available online at <http://www.parliament.uk/> and, for those with access to the Parliamentary network, this paper is on the Parliamentary Intranet at <http://intranet.parliament.uk/briefing-papers/SN06143>.

**Library Bibliographies** are bibliographical lists of publications relevant to major Government legislation or to other subjects of topical interest to Members. 89 of them were published between 1946 and 1960. Subjects range from *The British coal industry* [1946], through *India – constitutional reform* and *Palestine* [both 1947] to *Korea* [1950] and *The licensing laws* [1960].

**Research Division Miscellaneous Papers** are a series of 10 documents on a wide range of subjects, published occasionally between 1947 and 1976. These include *The fuel emergency* [1947], *A seventeenth century view of the House of Commons* [1948], *University representation 1603-1945* [1948] and *Erskine May's Private Journal 1857-1882* [1957; subsequently also published as a Library Document in 1972].

**Research Division Statistical Papers** are a short series of 6 documents produced by the Statistical Section and giving figures on a number of very specific topics. They were published between 1947 and 1949, and the subjects covered include *Imports of motor spirit* [1947] and *Proposed allocations under the Marshall Plan* [1948]. Originally unnumbered, they have been given a number and included in this Standard Note.

**Research Division Statistical Memoranda** are a more substantive and longer series of research papers, providing statistical background information relevant to major legislative proposals. 48 Memoranda were published, in two sequences, between 1947 and 1965. Individual subjects covered range from *The Marshall Plan* [1948], through *The dollar deficit* [1949] to *British Railways* [1964]. Regular subjects covered within the series include Budgets and Parliamentary by-elections.

**Library Memoranda** are a series of more in-depth research papers on specific subjects relevant to legislation or other topics of interest to Members. Published between 1948 and 1960, they cover subjects like *The Falkland Islands and their Dependencies* [1948], *China* [1949], *Boundary Commissions for Parliamentary constituencies* [1954] and *House of Commons accommodation* [1960].

**House of Commons Library Documents** are a series, formally published by HMSO and its successor, on a variety of specific topics relating to Parliament, past or present. Individual authors include senior officials in other Departments of the House, as well as in the Library. Subjects covered include *Official dress worn in the House of Commons* [1960], *The Journal of the House of Commons* [1971], *Chaplain to Mr Speaker* [1991] and *The House of Commons Library – a history* [also 1991]. 21 were published between 1955 and 1991 and this series continues to be published, on an occasional basis.

**Reference Sheets** are a series of selective lists of references on specific Bills and other subjects of interest to Members. As well as being available in their own right, they are also kept in a series of green boxes, together with many of the documents to which they refer. 717 of them were published between 1958 and 1992.

**Background Papers** are more in-depth publications, offering detailed research on a variety of broad subjects. 305 of them were published between 1968 and 1992.

**Research Notes** are a series of 739 papers, published between 1977 and 1992, on a range of narrower topics, some of them statistical and some related to specific legislation. There were two numerical sequences: 1 - 494 were published between 1977 and 1989 [with the exception of 197 and 491, which were not printed], while those published in 1990, 1991 and 1992 appear in separate sequences within each year [90/1-68, 91/1-70 and 92/1-110, with the exception of 92/49, which was not printed].

**Research Papers** were first published in 1993 and continue to be published today. They are the contemporary form of the most in-depth Library research product and cover a wide range of legislative and other topics. 255 were published in 1993 and 1994.
